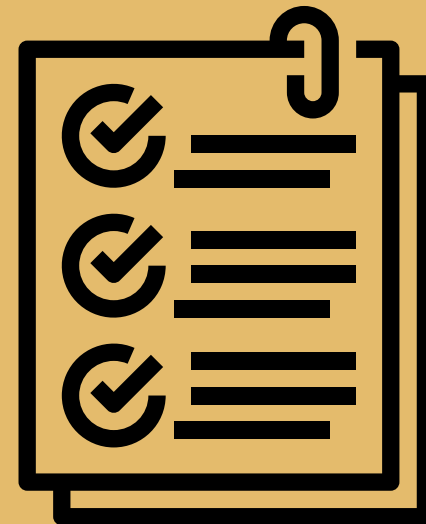

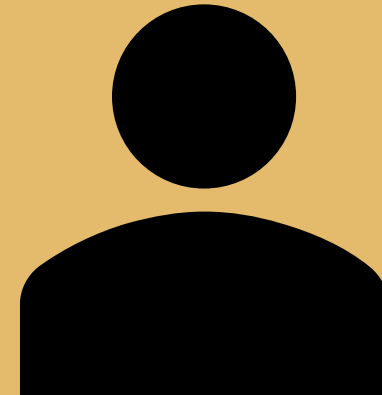

- Businesses may participate in the CORE Program under classification 3,4, or 5
- Do not need to complete educational modules to participate

CORE Tiered Grant New Requirements

- Spend 100% of grant funding and provide receipts
- Move to the next tier
- Submit a complete and correct grant application
- Those previously awarded at tier 5 will not be eligible to receive grant funding after this cycle
 - Applies to current and previous Tier 5 and 5B
