





- 3 storefront permit opportunities extended to next RFQ awardees
 - May 23, 2025 → May 23, 2030
- OCM sponsored opportunities – Hall of Flowers
 - A survey to gain interest and readiness of CORE operators interested in exhibiting at industry events
 - Survey closes on: **July 28, 2025**

- All Agreements have been routed through Adobe and payments will be issued as soon as all City management staff have signed.






