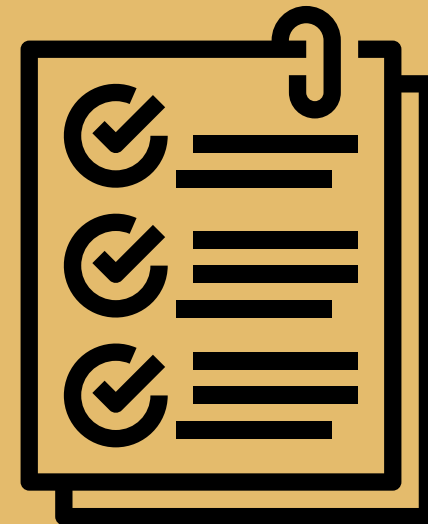

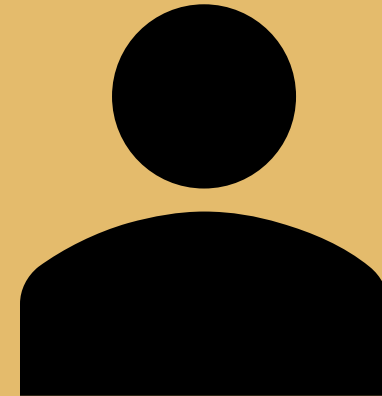

# CORE-Tiered Grant Survey

- 41 out of 401 CORE participants responded (10% of CORE Participants)
- Rate from 1 to 10 (1 = strongly disagree, 10 = strongly agree)

# CORE Tiered Grant New Requirements

- Spend 100% of grant funding and provide receipts
- Move to the next tier
- Submit a complete and correct grant application
- Those previously awarded at tier 5 will not be eligible to receive grant funding after this cycle
  - Applies to current and previous Tier 5 and 5B
