

When to See the Veterinarian

If your foster has any of the following symptoms, they should be seen:

Within the hour

1. Bleeding badly
2. Hit by a car recently (in the last several hours)
3. Unable to stand or walk
4. Seizures
5. Eye injuries
6. Wounds where dog is unable to eat or drink
7. Suspect parvo, or distemper
8. Abnormal mentation (ie: confused, weaving, coma, abnormal eye movements, dazed)
9. Bloating

8-12 Hours

1. Limping animals
2. Small wounds
3. Eye infections
4. Vomiting (unless associated with lethargy)
5. Swelling on body or extremities
6. Possible fractures, if animal can walk, eat and drink
7. Not eating
8. Diarrhea

12-48 Hours

1. Skin problems
2. Abnormal gait
