When speaking, please state your name and your mailing address. Any documents to be presented to the hearing examiner shall be sent to the secretary prior to the hearing to be marked as evidence.

**General Conduct for the Public Attending the Hearings**

- Members of the public attending hearings shall observe the same rules and decorum as noted in Chapter 5 of Council Rules of Procedure.
- Electronic devices shall be turned to the off or silent mode.
- The hearings are electronically recorded, and copies of the recording can be made available by submitting a Public Records Act request. Cameras and recording equipment can only be used with the permission of the hearing examiner.
- Members of the public shall not approach the dais without the consent of the hearing examiner.
- Stamping of feet, whistles, yells or shouting, physically threatening conduct, and/or similar demonstrations are unacceptable public behavior and will be prohibited by the hearing examiner and those persons shall be removed from the chamber.
