The City of Sacramento, Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services has completed preparation of a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Auburn Boulevard over Arcade Creek Bridge Replacement Project (24C0081) and intends to adopt the document as part of project review.

The document, and related project plans associated with the project entitlements, are now available for a 30-day public review and comment period. The comment period is from **September 4, 2020 to October 4, 2020**.

The proposed project site is located in the City of Sacramento where Aubum Boulevard crosses Arcade Creek, east of Winding Way and west of the intersection of Park Road and Aubum Boulevard. The proposed project consists of the replacement of the existing structurally deficient bridge with a new bridge that meets current structural and geometric design standards, improves hydraulic capacity, and provides traffic-rated barrier railings. The proposed bridge replacement would also enhance the Auburn Boulevard and Winding Way intersection by adding an additional left turn pocket from westbound Aubum Boulevard to Winding Way. The proposed replacement bridge would be a single span precast-prestressed concrete girder bridge, placed along the existing bridge alignment. The proposed bridge would be approximately 97 feet in width and would provide two 12-foot through lanes, two 11-foot through lanes, two 11-foot left turn lanes, and shoulders and sidewalks in each direction. The length of the proposed bridge would be approximately 89 feet to avoid the existing bridge foundations.

Written comments regarding the Mitigated Negative Declaration should be received by the Community Development Department, **NO LATER THAN 4:00 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2020** (NOTE: due to COVID 19, the Public Counter is CLOSED). All comments should be submitted via email or mailed to:
