PROJECT: **TWO RIVERS TRAIL PHASE II PROJECT (K15125000)**

The City of Sacramento, Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services has completed preparation of a Draft Focused Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (Draft SEIR) for the Two Rivers Trail Phase II project.

The Draft SEIR is now available for a 45-day public review and comment period. **The comment period is from July 30, 2025 to September 15, 2025.**

In December 2022, the City approved the Final EIR for the Two Rivers Trail Phase II Project which will construct approximately 3.4 miles of Class I bicycle and pedestrian trail primarily along the south bank of the American River from Sutter's Landing Regional Park to the Sacramento Northern Bikeway Trail at North 18th Street, and east from the eastern terminus of Sutter's Landing Regional Park to the H Street Bridge. Since then, the Project design footprint for the westerly trail segment has been modified to include an interim loop trail around the landfill east of the UPRR tracks and an interim trail west of the UPRR tracks from the Sacramento Northern Bikeway to North 12th Street, connecting to the Two Rivers Phase I Trail. Further, the project has been expanded to include an overcrossing of the UPRR right of way, another connection to the Sacramento Northern Bikeway, and an undercrossing of the State Route 160 bridges. Due to the substantial project description change that now includes an elevated pedestrian bridge structure over UPRR and an underpass, both adjacent to a wild and scenic river, a Focused Subsequent EIR has been prepared. This Focused Subsequent EIR will tier from the certified 2022 FEIR and will evaluate whether the proposed new alignment and design features for the trail would result in new or substantially more severe significant impacts than the impacts disclosed in the 2022 FEIR.

The City will hold a public meeting to present the results of the Draft Focused SEIR and provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the SEIR at the following time and location:
