

## Owner-Builder Housing Impact Fee Waiver Form

### Housing Impact Fee Overview

The Housing Impact Fee is a citywide fee on all new residential units, as established in the Mixed Income Housing Ordinance (17.712 of City Code). A nexus study was performed, which demonstrates how new market rate housing creates a need for more workforce affordable housing.

Funds collected are transferred to the Housing Trust Fund, which is administered by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA). SHRA uses the funds to assist in the development of affordable workforce housing.

### Owner-Builder Exemption Criteria

Housing Impact Fee exemptions for owner-Builders are listed in section **17.712.040.C** of the Mixed Income Housing Ordinance as follows:

#### A new single-unit dwelling built by an Owner-Builder on his or her property if:

1. The owner does not intend to sell the dwelling within two years of completion of construction, and
2. The owner has not utilized this exemption set forth in this subsection on another dwelling within two years of applying for a building permit for the new dwelling, and
3. The owner personally performs the work, or the owner directly contracts with a contractor to perform the work.
