## **CORE Participant Cannabis Pre-Application Meeting Request**

A CORE Participant Pre-Application Meeting is a free service for CORE participants, intended to help determine if a potential site is suitable for cannabis business activities. The primary focus of the meeting will be the Conditional Use Permit process; however, city staff involved in subsequent regulatory review steps (e.g., building permit, business operating permit) will participate as well. An overarching goal is to provide early input to reduce the risk (i.e., time and money) involved in the discretionary permit review process.

	Cannabis Cultivation - Any activity involving the planting, growing, harvesting, drying, curing, grading, o trimming of cannabis.			
	Cannabis Distribution - The procurement, sale, and transport of cannabis and cannabis products between cannabis businesses.			
	Cannabis Manufacturing - The production, preparation, propagation, and compounding of cannabis and cannabis products. Cannabis manufacturing includes the extraction process, the infusion or mixture of cannabis into another substance, the preparation of an edible item that contains cannabis, and the packaging and labeling of cannabis or cannabis products. This use can include volatile or non-volatile manufacturing.			
	Cannabis Testing – Performing scientific analysis of cannabis or cannabis products to determine its chemical profile, the presence of contaminants, or other similar data.			
	Cannabis Dispensary - Includes both storefront cannabis dispensary and delivery-only cannabis dispensary, as defined in <a href="Chapter 5.150">Chapter 5.150</a> of the Sacramento City Code.			
	Microbusiness – A vertically-integrated cannabis business in which at least three of the four following activities take place in one facility: cultivation up to 10,000 sq. ft; pon-volatile manufacturing; retail			

(storefront and delivery-only dispensary); distribution. Select all uses above which apply.

Submittal Requirements  Please provide as much information as possible to assist staff during the pre-application meeting process. At a minimum, a project narrative (below) is required; however, providing additional information will allow for more specific feedback about a project site. Additional information can include a preliminary site plan showing the location of a building on a site relative to other nearby buildings and streets, a floor plan showing the size and location of business activities, a map of surrounding uses, questions regarding the use permit process, etc.
