Permits Update

- Conditional Use Permits (CUPs)
 - Approved: 191

- Business Operating Permits (BOPs)
 - Submitted: 380; Approved: 69(29 Operational, 40 Non-Ops)

Policy Update

Volatile Manufacturing

- Proposed zones: all zones where non-volatile manufacturing is allowed, except for C2
- Proposed distance requirements: same as non-volatile manufacturing, plus 600 ft. from residential zones/use for ZA approval. Over 600 ft. require Planning and Design Commission approval
- Planning and Design Commission and Law and Legislation Committee in June 2019; Council in July 2019

Policy Update (cont.)

■ Title 5 Cleanup

- Delete sections pertaining to collectives and cooperatives
- Requirement to immediately notify City of any actions on State license,
- Keeping patient's medical records (i.e. doctor's recommendation)
 will no longer be required
- Sellers Permit and Price Lists will no longer be required.
- Waste management destruction must take place on site
- Expand the grounds of denial, suspension, revocation, including:
- Immediate suspension or revocation (instead of 15 days grace period) for all offenses related to a minor and operation of the business poses an immediate threat to public health, safety or welfare.

Armed Guard BOT Pickup Service

- Scheduled armored pickup and transport of monthly BOTs from cannabis businesses to City Hall
- Counting, verification to take place on site
- Reduces risk involved in carrying large amounts of cash during BOT payment due date
- Fees- TBD; More information to follow

Study on Economic Impacts of Cannabis in Sacramento

- UC Davis Graduate School of Management is conducting the research
- Will be contacting Sacramento businesses to participate in the study and request tour of facilities
- Research will cover the journey to legalization, experience in the regulated market, etc.
- Will formulate future policy recommendations based on findings.

Industry Survey

- Survey went out by April 23, 2019 by Office of Cannabis Policy & Enforcement (thru GovDelivery) to all permit holders and applicants
- Separate from UC Davis' Research
- Focus on ownership diversity, financial health, public safety issues impacting business
- Survey will close May 15, 2019; respond ASAP

Local Authorization for State Annual Licenses

■ Requirements:

- Have an Operational BOP, Certificate of Occupancy, Temporary Certificate of Occupancy, or have had final inspection by Building Department and Fire Department, OR
- Building Permit has been issued, AND
- Not on Fire Watch or have any outstanding Fire issues

Final Walk-Thru for BOP

- What is Evaluated During Final Walk-Thru?
 - Compliance with Title 5 (operations, premises, security requirements)
 - Surveillance systems, alarms, computers installed and operational
- When to Schedule:
 - After (or around the same time as) Building and Fire Department's Final Inspections

Final Walk-Thru for BOP (cont.)

■ When to Schedule:

- After (or around the same time as) Building and Fire
 Department's Final Inspections; 2-3 weeks lead time is ideal
- If building has a CofO and no tenant improvements are needed,
 call for a Fire Department walk-thru
