#### UPDATE ON CORE APPLICATIONS

- Individuals have graduated from the program = 159
- Graduates who have submitted BOP applications = 37
- Graduates without applications = 122
- # of CORE BOP applications submitted = 53
- # of approved/operating CORE BOP applications = 13
- # of pending CORE BOP applications = 40

### UPDATE ON REIMBURSEMENTS (BCC GRANT)

- Total funds available: \$1,077,407
- 22 reimbursement requests paid: \$520,824
- 5 Reimbursement requests pending: \$106,137
- 22 requests under eligibility review: \$505,845
- ❖Total if all requests paid: \$1,132,806
- Deficit: -\$55,399

#### UPDATE ON LOAN PROGRAM (GO-BIZ GRANT)

- CORE Capital = 6-year interest free loan to:
  Classification 1, 2 or 3
- Available in 3 Phases:
  - Phase 1
    - ✓ Securing and maintaining a business location
    - Submitting a CUP application and completing all required documents
    - ✓ Submitting a BOP and/or state cannabis license application

## UPDATE ON LOAN PROGRAM (GO-BIZ GRANT)

#### Phase 2

- ✓ Obtain a Certificate of Occupancy
- ✓ Obtain a BOP
- ✓ Obtain a state license
- ✓Open for business
- Phase 3 Require matching funds
  - Expanding/sustaining a permitted and operating business
  - ✓ Supporting operational needs
