

BOP/Renewal Review Process

- Entire approval process now done through Accela BOP Online Portal
- Automated email sent from Accela for missing/outstanding documents (instead of OCM staff). Email goes to all contacts on the application
- Renewals with outstanding BOTs don't move through the approval process
- Renewals and supporting documentation not complete by expiration date result in a late fee and 30 days to submit all documentation
- If application not complete 30 days after expiration, business will have to cease operation and a new BOP applied for to operate in the future
- Please submit your complete renewal documentation and fee as early as possible!






Policy Update: Onsite Consumption

Scheduled before Law and Legislation Committee – Sep 2023



Onsite Consumption: Findings from Other Jurisdictions

- Licenses can only be issued to a retail licensee.
 - No standalone lounge-only licenses for nonretail businesses.
- Different business models, unique features and best practices to help address concerns previously raised by committee, such as overconsumption, violent behavior, driving under the influence, exposure of employees to smoke

Onsite Consumption: Next Steps

Options to be presented to L&L Committee for discussion at September meeting:

- Recommend that Council consider a pilot program to allow a set number of cannabis events in a venue other than Cal Expo
- Recommend that Council authorize creation of an onsite consumption facility permitting program
 - Pilot vs permanent program?
 - New dispensary permits vs allowed activity for dispensary permit holders?
 - CORE only vs non-exclusive to CORE?
 - Separate out smoking area from drinking/edibles area?
 - Zoning?

- Scheduled for Racial Equity Committee August 22nd at 10am
- Status Update on the Equity Study and CORE Program
 - Attend in-person or virtually and let the Committee know that CORE is an important resource for the City
- Full study to be presented at future stakeholder meeting and to the Racial Equity Committee

Policy Update: Taxation of Cannabis Businesses

- Scheduled for Law and Legislation Committee

 Sep 2023
- Taxation models presented will include an across-the-board reduction, a CORE-only phased tax, and a tiered tax based on gross receipts
- Models will show impacts on business, the City's general fund, and Measure L funding



American River College Cannabis Small Business Education Modules

- Free, online, asynchronous course
- Covers a wide range of important topics in the cannabis industry, including industry overview, navigating regulations, customer value proposition, and essential business skills like accounting, marketing, and business communications
- 16-week program divided into 4 modules
- 26 students signed up for the first cohort
- Module 3 starting soon

CORE Verification Services

- 2 Request for Proposals were posted applicants didn't meet the City's budget requirements
- OCM is reaching out to CBOs directly to negotiate a contract
- If you're waiting to be verified, please be patient and we'll let you know as soon as we have a contractor in place



CORE Grants: Tiered

2023-Tiered Grant

- City awarded approximately \$1.5 million for grants
- Noncompetitive format, similar to last year
- The amount of grant funding awarded per person will be based on the number of people who apply, both in total and for each tier, and meet the qualifications
- A progress report request was sent out to previous grantees
 - Due 7/31/23
- Application form will be available soon



CORE Grants: Competitive

Competitive Grant

- Lager CORE-benefiting projects associated with multiple activities/permits needing a larger amount of funding
- Looking for proposal reviewers/scorers
- Timeline: coming later
