BOP UPDATE

- **Total Approved BOPs: 249**
 - Cultivation – 88
 - Manufacturing –26
 - Storefront – 30
 - Delivery-only -57
 - Testing –4
 - Distribution - 39
 - Microbusinesses - 5

STATE-RELATED UPDATES

- Upcoming merger of BCC, CDFA (cannabis) and CDPH (cannabis) into a unified state licensing agency.
 - All cannabis businesses will be under one single regulatory agency, instead of three.
 - Will resolve the overlap/conflicts in interpretations of regulations and hopefully streamline state permitting

STATE-RELATED UPDATES

- **Proposed:** State grants to local jurisdictions to help transition provisional licenses to annual licenses and new state-wide Deputy Director of Equity and Inclusion
 - Provisional licenses program to sunset January 2022
 - City of Sacramento may be eligible for up to \$5.7 million in grants

STATE-RELATED UPDATES

- BCC says authorization for storefront dispensary curbside pickup (part of COVID emergency relief) to continue past 6/15/21 on case-by-case basis.

POLICY UPDATE

➤ **Proposed Title 5 Cleanup**

- Purpose: Policy and technical amendments to the Code to create consistency with State law, remove sections that are obsolete, provide clarity and uniformity across different permit types and promote a more efficient regulatory and licensing process
- Target to L&L – Summer 2021

POLICY UPDATE

- Summary of proposed amendments to Title 5:
 - Codify security conditions currently on all BOPs, including specific security plan requirements and location safety measures for each business type
 - Interested parties:
 - Delete delivery and distribution drivers from definition
 - Add definition for employee managers

POLICY UPDATE

- Summary of proposed amendments (cont.) :
 - Vehicle age, product limit for delivery
 - Void applications inactive for 180 days
 - Streamlining of required documentation for renewals

BOP RENEWAL PAYMENT PLAN

- Temporary Covid-related relief allowing cannabis businesses to split their payments into four installments
- Will no longer be available to those whose BOP renewal dates begin 10/1/21 or later

SECURITY MEASURES FOR DELIVERY

- Surge of robberies of cannabis deliveries in last 2-3 weeks, using stolen identifications and pre-paid cell phones
- Cannabis delivery operators should be diligent in adhering to customer identification procedures and delivery protocols.
- Orders to non-confirmed customer addresses should prompt additional identity confirmation.
