CUP and BOP UPDATES

CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS (CUPs)

Approved - 211

BUSINESS OPERATING PERMITS (BOPs)

Submitted - 364

Issued – 95; (65 Operating; 30 Non-Ops)

Pending: 271

Denied – 23



JANUARY 31, 2020 DEADLINE

- All registered cultivators and operating businesses must have BOP by deadline
- No BOP – must cease and desist and wait for BOP issuance before starting to operate



BCC EQUITY GRANT FUNDS

- City of Sacramento awarded \$1,197,119.34
- Resolution to accept the grant – 11/19 Council meeting
- Details on proposed use of funds - to follow



POLICY UPDATE

➤ **Manufacturing**

➤ Small Manufacturing

- Held small manufacturers stakeholder meeting 10/14/19. Outstanding topics:
- Comparison – other types of food manufacturing vs cannabis manufacturing
- Price increase for anything cannabis in past 2 years (i.e. multiple labels, packaging)



POLICY UPDATE

- **Manufacturing (cont.)**
 - Volatile Manufacturing
 - Still waiting for Council direction on when to put item back on agenda



POLICY UPDATE

➤ **Hemp**

- Extension of moratorium on cultivation to another 10 months, 15 days (expiring 9/20/20)
- 45-day moratorium on manufacturing (expiring 12/20/19); will extend after 45 days



POLICY UPDATE

- **Storefront Dispensary Ownership**
 - Will add definition for “transfer”
 - Emergency ordinance limiting ownership; will apply to future ownerships

POLICY UPDATE

➤ **Proposed Lottery Procedures**

- When a lottery permit becomes available, OCM will hold a lottery. OCM will advertise; invite interested parties to apply; application period – 60 days
- At the lottery drawing, participants drew a number, which will be the order of priority that the applicants will be considered.
- Two lists will be established: 1) CORE applicants; 2) General applicants




POLICY UPDATE

- **Proposed Lottery Procedures (cont.)**
 - CORE list will be considered first. If applicant is not able to continue, applicant with highest order of priority will be considered; until CORE list is exhausted. Then general list will be considered.

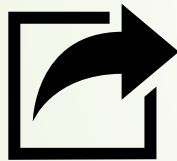
