## DEFICIT UPDATE



Chan has asked each department head to submit suggestions for **cost reductions**. Chan will then present a **proposed balanced budget in late April**. Councilmembers will have **budget hearings in May** and they **must pass a balance budget by June 30**.

City leaders say they want to hear from the public. They'll be announcing a series of community meetings, to be held in March. They want to hear the public's priorities and ideas about possible cuts.

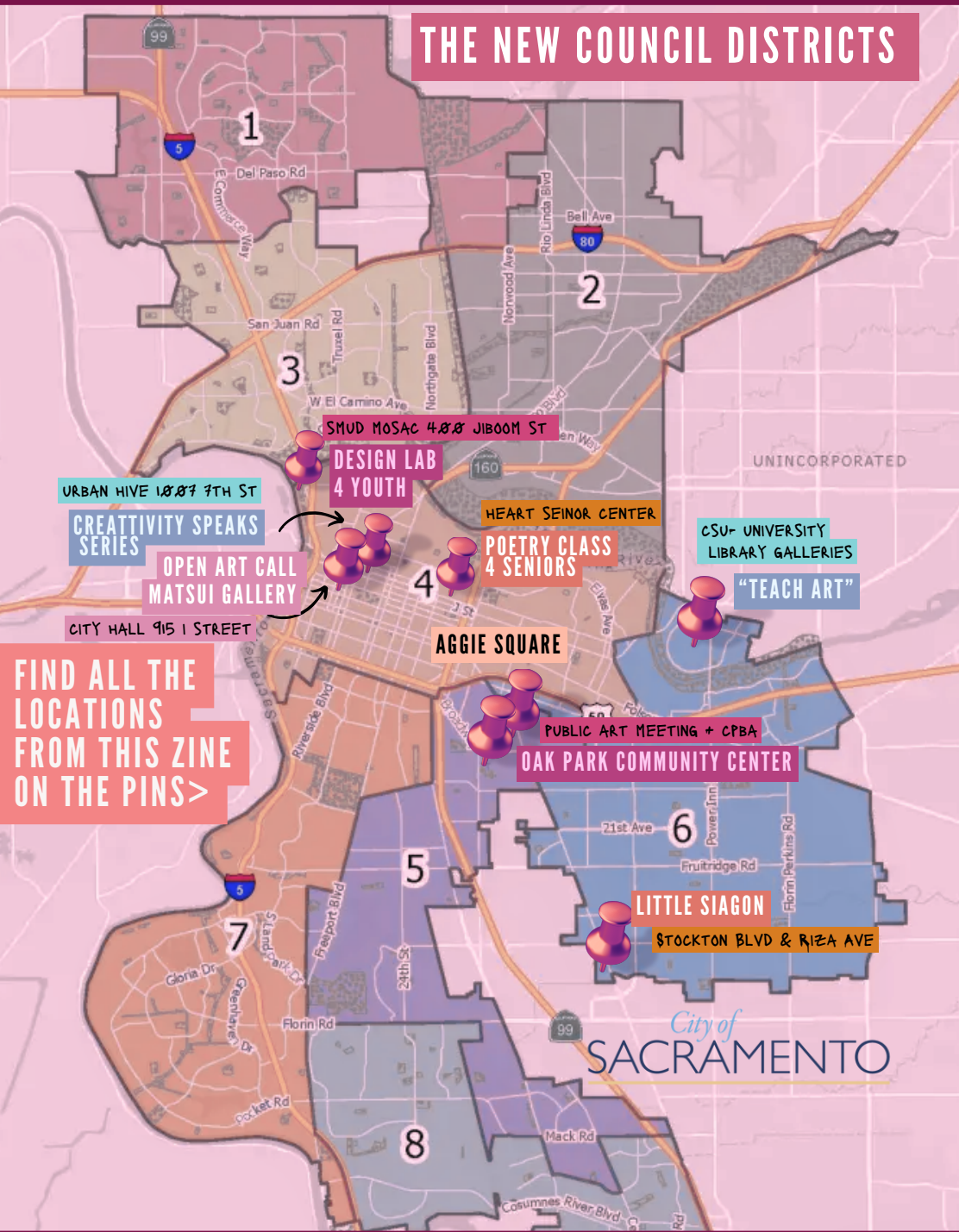
