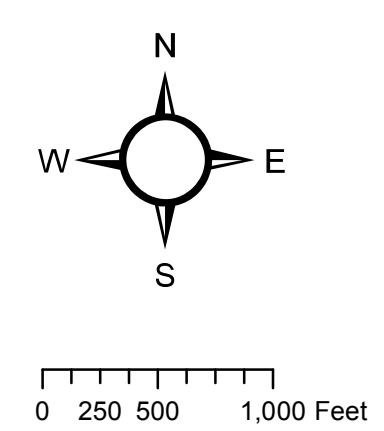


Project Limits



Flood Zone Definitions

ZONE A: No base flood elevations determined.

ZONE AE: Base flood elevations determined.

ZONE AH: Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually areas of ponding); base flood elevations determined.

ZONE AD: Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined. For areas of alluvial fan flooding; velocities also determined.

ZONE A99: Area to be protected from 1% annual chance flood by a Federal flood protection system under construction; no Base Flood elevations determined.

ZONE X: Areas of 0.2% annual chance flood; areas of 1% annual chance flood with average depths of less than 1 foot or with drainage areas less than 1 square mile; and areas protected by levees from 1% annual chance flood.

ZONE X: Areas determined to be outside 0.2% annual chance floodplain.
