


Keep our Waters Clean is a public education program that promotes protection of water quality at Folsom Lake and the Lower American and Sacramento Rivers.



The water in our rivers begins in the mountains. It flows into creeks and streams that eventually become rivers and lakes.


Water continues to flow downstream and supplies us with a valuable resource. You use the fresh water here while you and your family work and play. It is also home to many plants and animals, like me.


Together we can help protect our source of drinking water by keeping our lakes and rivers clean!




When visiting our lakes and rivers,

our waters clean!






WHAT WOULD YOU DO?


For each task, circle the person who is trying to help keep our waterways clean.



Remember, trash near our waterways can hurt wildlife. Leave nothing behind, only tracks.




Remember to find a pumpout station to empty out bathroom waste from your boat. Keeping the water clean is good for animals and our drinking water



Remember to always use public restrooms when you have to go to the bathroom.


WATERWAYS MAZE
