Call 311 or 264-5011 to set up an appointment.** When filling out this application please type or print clearly in ink, then mail completed application and original cash register receipt and/or plumber's invoice to the water provider listed below. Use one application per property location. Residential, commercial, industrial institutional and multi-family applicants are eligible. The number of rebates is dependent upon the availability of program funds. All information on this application form is considered confidential to the extent allowed under California law. Applications are processed in the order received. Funding is limited, therefore, rebates are not guaranteed.

***To qualify for this rebate an inspection is required BEFORE you remove your old (PRE-1992) toilet to verify that it qualifies. Please call 311 or 916-264-5011 to schedule an inspection.**

How to get your high efficiency toilet (HET) rebate.

1. You must first call the City of Sacramento at 311 or 264-5011 to see if rebates are available.
2. To obtain a rebate, customers are **required to complete a pre-inspection before the old (PRE-1992) toilet is removed**. This service is at no direct cost to the customer.
3. Purchase and install the new toilet(s). You must be replacing a toilet using 3.5 gallons per flush (gpf) or greater (a non-ULFT) to be eligible. The toilet to be replaced must have been installed prior to 1992.
4. You may install the toilet(s) yourself or you may also hire a licensed contractor.
5. Return the original dated receipt and/or plumber's invoice with the price, model and brand of each toilet listed individually, and the completed application. Keep a copy for your records.
6. Submitting a signed application represents agreement to have the City of Sacramento verify installation of the toilet, with your accompaniment. City of Sacramento will schedule an inspection.
7. Rebates are up to \$125 for Residential HET, up to \$150 for Commercial Gravity style and \$250 for Commercial flushometer type toilets. Total rebate amount will not exceed money spent. Eligible expenses include tank, bowl and tax. For commercial installations, both the tank (when applicable) bowl and flushometer must be replaced.
8. A **HET** uses 1.28 gallons per flush or less. A **Dual Flush Toilet** has two ways to flush (example 1.6 gpf/.8gpf)
9. The City of Sacramento will issue rebate checks within 90 days of receipt of your completed application materials.
- 1 The City of Sacramento is required to send IRS form 1099 to the customer and the IRS when rebates total \$600 or more.

Qualifications

1. Purchase of material must occur within the 12 months prior to the application date.
2. The location of installation must be served by the City of Sacramento.

3. Residential, commercial, industrial, institutional and multi- family applicants are eligible.
4. Replacement of an Ultra Low Flush Toilet with an HET is not eligible for rebate under this program; neither is replacement of an HET with an HET eligible.
5. New construction is not eligible for rebate under this program.
6. Eligible expenses include tank, bowl, and tax. Installation and items needed for installation are not eligible expenses.

Permitting

Building permits are not required when a residential customer simply removes and installs a toilet on existing plumbing. A permit is required when a plumbing fixture will be relocated or you are a business customer.

The number of rebates is dependent upon the availability of program funds. Applications will be processed when all required information is provided by the applicant; on a first-come, first- served basis.
