

City of Sacramento – River Friendly Landscape Program: Very Low to Low Water-Use Plant List

Transform your lawn into a waterwise landscape using the City of Sacramento's River Friendly Plant List! This list is intended as a tool to aid program participants and provides an extensive database of water wise plants. This list is based off the findings put forth by the Regional Water Authority, Water Use Classification of Landscape Species (WUCOLS IV), and other California agencies that are showing success with similar programs.

The attached list includes the **Plant Coverage Area** in square feet for each plant at its *mature size*. Regardless of maturity at the time of post-inspection, the agency staff will determine the canopy coverage of the retrofitted landscape using the coverage value for a mature plant.

This list of recommended plants is meant to be a general guide—program participants may use other plants not on the list, but they must be submitted and approved by Water Conservation staff prior to the start of the project. *Plants must be **very low to low water-use** and the project needs to meet the 60 percent living plant coverage requirement for each distinct converted area.* Medium and high water use plants and turf grasses will not be eligible for a rebate and using them may void your entire rebate application.

Water Requirement

Plant water needs based on WUCOLS classifications for region 2, Central California.

VL – Very Low

L – Low

Water requirements listed are for established plants. For any other plant not found on this list, you must find this information using outside sources. Please consult a nursery/landscape professional, gardening reference book or other reliable resources to understand species requirements, length of the time plant needs to get established and the water each plant requires. Examine soil type, weather and site conditions to determine the frequency of supplemental irrigation during the dry non-rainy seasons. Typically, no extra water is required during the rainy seasons after the 1-2 year establishment period. Please direct any questions to the contact below.

Invasive Plants

Plants that are considered moderate to high invasives are not included in this list and will not be allowed for this rebate program. See <http://www.cal-ipc.org/> for a list of invasive species.

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Hydrozones

Hydrozoning is a key component of a water-efficient irrigation system. Factors that determine a hydrozone include infiltration rate of the soil, soil type, slope, sun exposure and water needs of the plants. A good hydrozone divides a landscape irrigation system based on individual plant requirements, plant height and planting density.

Select plant species with similar water requirements and group together within a hydrozone. Similarly, irrigation type should be uniform in each hydrozone and should be served by one valve. For example, plant material irrigated by multi-stream rotor nozzle should be on a separate schedule than plant material irrigated by drip.

Calculating Coverage Area for Plants Not on this List:

The calculations used to find Plant Coverage Area at maturity for plants not on this list are obtained by determining the area of a circle using the plant spread (width) as the diameter. To find the area of a circle, you must square the diameter and multiply by 0.7854. The values will always be rounded to the nearest full number (0.1-0.4 is rounded down and 0.5-0.9 is rounded up)

Diameter x Diameter x 0.7854 = Plant Coverage

Example: 5 x 5 x 0.7854 = 19.6 (rounded up to 20)
