Use one application per property location. **This rebate is available only to residential customers (single-family and multi-family properties).** Rebates are offered while program funds are available. Applications are processed in the order received, and funding is limited—rebates are not guaranteed. All information provided on this application will be treated as confidential to the extent allowed under California law.

An application and inspection is required BEFORE you remove your pre-2014 toilet to verify it qualifies for this rebate. Call 916-808-5605 to schedule an inspection.

To be eligible, you must:

- Be receiving City of Sacramento water service at the property
- Be the property owner or bill-paying tenant with written consent from the property owner
- Be a customer of the Sacramento Area Sewer District

Rebate amounts:

- Maximum rebate amount for residential customers replacing a toilet manufactured before 1992 is \$175 per ultra-high-efficiency toilet
- Maximum rebate amount for residential customers replacing a toilet manufactured between 1992 and 2013 is \$50 per ultra-high-efficiency toilet
- Total rebate amount will not exceed money spent by the customer
- Eligible expenses include tank, bowl and tax
- Installation labor and additional materials (e.g., supply lines, toilet seats) are not eligible expenses
- New construction is not eligible for rebate under this program

Ultra-high-efficiency toilet (UHET) requirements:

- Must be a qualifying [Maximum Performance \(MaP\) Premium](#) toilet, which use no more than 1.1 gallons per flush on average
- Must replace an older, higher-flow toilet manufactured before 2014

Disclaimer:

The City of Sacramento, Regional Water Authority (RWA), and Sacramento Area Sewer District (SacSewer) reserve the right to deny an application of any participant who does not meet all requirements as outlined. The City of Sacramento, RWA and SacSewer reserve the right to change the terms of this program at their discretion. The City of Sacramento, RWA and SacSewer are not responsible for receipts or paperwork lost in the U.S. mail. The City of Sacramento, RWA and SacSewer cannot guarantee that the installation of the UHETs will result in lower water utility costs. The number of rebates is dependent upon the availability of program funds. Applications will be processed when all required information is provided by the applicant; on a first-come, first-served basis.

Steps to proceed:

1. Submit a completed application along with photos of your pre-2014 toilet(s) and gallons per flush (gpf) information*. Toilet(s) to be replaced must be either a pre-1992 model that uses 3.5 gpf or more (rebate up to \$175), or a 1992-2013 model that uses 1.6 gpf (rebate up to \$50).
2. You will be contacted by Water Conservation staff for pre-inspection/pre-approval.
3. Purchase and install your new Maximum Performance (MaP) Premium ultra-high-efficiency toilet(s). Toilets may be self-installed or installed by a plumber.
4. Email your receipts/invoices and photos of your newly installed toilet(s) to waterconservation@cityofsacramento.org. Receipts/invoices must include the price, model and brand for each toilet.
5. Receive your rebate check within 90 days after Water Conservation staff receive all required materials. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued to the customer (and to the IRS) if total rebates are \$2,000 or more in a calendar year.

*The manufacturer's name and a GPF label often appear right behind the seat hinge on the bowl. If you don't see a GPF label, lift the tank lid and check the inside back of the toilet tank for the manufacturer's date stamp—it is usually stamped directly into the porcelain.

NOTE: Building permits are not required when a residential customer simply removes and installs a toilet on existing plumbing. A permit is required when a plumbing fixture will be relocated.
