

Business Operations Tax: Rental of Nonresidential (Commercial) Property

A commercial rental is defined as any nonresidential real property for lease or rent by the owner – whether it is currently occupied or not.

Your tax is based on the gross rent received in the prior year, or an estimate of the upcoming year's gross rent on the property listed at the bottom of your annual notice. If the rental property information is incorrect, please recalculate your tax on the notice, note any changes, and return the entire notice with your remittance. If your business is located in a Business Improvement Area (BIA), the BIA fees are in addition to your tax.

Any tax not paid last year will be reflected on your notice as "Amount Due-Prior Year (s)," and should be included as part of your total remittance to the City of Sacramento. Any credit amount indicated on your notice can be applied to this year's amount due.
