1. Course Title: Department Use of Force Policies and Procedures

Course Description: To provide a comprehensive review of Sacramento Police Department Policies and Procedures related to Use of Force to include, but not limited to:

- 522.02 – Emergency care for individuals under police care or control
- 580.01 – Use of Force Review Board
- 580.02 – Use of Force
- 580.03 – Use of Force Reporting
- 580.06 – De-escalation and planned response
- 580.07 – Duty to intercede
- 580.10 – Conducted Energy Device
- 580.12 – Less Lethal Weapon Systems
- 580.13 – Foot Pursuit
- 580.14 – Use of Canines

Course Objectives: Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

- Understand and demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of policies related to use of force, de-escalation, duty to intercede, and emergency care.
- Review the constitutional and state standards of use of force and how these standards are incorporated into Sacramento Police Department Policies.
- What “discretionary time” is and how it could be used as a tool in attempt to de-escalate a situation and reduce the likelihood of using force.
- Proportionality
- Totality of circumstances analysis of a critical incident involving use of force
- Use of force report writing
- Use of Force Review Board process
