Incident Summary

On 6-7-13 at approx. 0213hrs., Officer Dahl and Officer Yang were working in full SPD uniform, in a marked SPD vehicle. They were teamed up using the identifier 2A35. Officer Dahl was driving and Officer Yang was the passenger officer.

Officers Dahl and Yang were in the area of Safeway (1814 19th st) handling a call for service (call #13-148891). As they were clearing off of this call, they observed a subject (later identified as Daniel Moore) riding his bicycle eastbound on R st. Moore's bicycle was not equipped with a bike light in violation of 21201(d)cvc. Officer Dahl illuminated Moore with his spotlight as Officer Yang instructed Moore to stop. Moore asked "What did I do?" Officer Yang told Moore that they wanted to talk to him about his bike light. Moore stated that someone stole his light and then began to flee on his bicycle. Officer Dahl immediately activated his overhead emergency lights which activated their vehicle's ICC. The officers advised dispatch that they had a subject who was attempting to flee.

Moore fled on his bicycle as Officers Dahl and Yang began to pursue him in their squad car. Moore who was peddling at a rapid pace, obviously attempting to get away from the officers rode through 19th st off of the roadway along the nearby train tracks. Moore crossed Q st, continuing along a gravel road near the train tracks. The officers followed Moore with their emergency lights activated.

Officer Dahl was able to pull up alongside Moore who was obviously trying to evade them. Moore continued as Officer Dahl drove alongside him. Officer Dahl instructed Moore to stop. Moore did not stop. He continued at a rapid pace northbound. Moore then turned eastbound onto O st as the officers continued to pursue him.

Moore then turned northbound 20th st. He dismounted his bicycle in front of 1418 20th st. He attempted to climb a tall fence, still attempting to flee. Moore then dropped off of the fence.

Officer Dahl stopped his patrol. The officers exited the vehicle. Officer Dahl lost sight of Moore momentarily due to a parked car blocking his view. When Officer Dahl ran around the car, he expected to see Moore fleeing on foot or trying to climb the fence again, however Moore dropped to the ground on his stomach in the prone position.

Officer Dahl was in close proximity to Moore as Moore went to the prone position. Officer Dahl, who's momentum was still going forward got on top of Moore, and placed his right knee on Moore's left midsection to prevent him from pushing up. At this time, Officer Yang arrived and both Officer Dahl and Yang handcuffed Moore, taking him into custody.

Officer Dahl lifted Moore up and began walking him towards his squad car. Moore dropped his body weight and was not walking with Officer Dahl. Officer Dahl lifted Moore up by his left arm and walked him to his squad car. At this time, Officer Farrales arrived on scene from the north with his ICC activated. Officer Dahl walked/ carried Moore to the squad car where he pushed him up against the hood of the squad car to facilitate a search for weapons/ contraband. During the search, Officer Dahl removed an uncapped syringe from his back pocket. Moore was then placed in the back of Officer Dahl and Yang's squad car.

Additional officers arrived on scene and subsequently cleared. Officers Clatterbuck and Meier conducted a neighborhood canvass. No witnesses were contacted during the canvass.

Records checks initially revealed Moore to be a parolee at large, but subsequent checks later revealed he is not a parolee at large. Moore advised he had absconded, which is the reason he fled. Records checks later revealed that Moore was no longer on parole and not wanted by CDCR.

Officer Dahl discovered that at some point, most likely while Moore was being taken into custody, he broke/

ripped a fingernail on his right hand. He was initially unsure if the injury was caused by the syringe, however he was later advised by medical staff that the syringe had not yet been used and his injury was likely not caused by the syringe.

Moore complained of pain advising that Dahl had put his body weight on him. Although it was initially suspected that Moore was fabricating an injury to avoid going to jail, Moore was transported to Sutter General Hospital.

Upon arrival at Sutter General Hospital, after waiting in the triage area, it was determined that Moore had a collapsed lung due to a broken rib puncturing his lung. Officer Meyer was at the hospital on an unrelated matter. I (Sgt. Morris) instructed Officer Meyer to obtain a Mirandized statement from Moore since he was not involved in the incident. Officer Meyer Mirandized Moore however he was not able to obtain a statement because medical treatment was being started and Moore had sedated.

I spoke with Dr who was treating Moore. She advised that due to an pre-existing medical condition, Moore's bones were possibly not strong. She advised that this pre-existing medical condition could have contributed to the fractured rib.

Due to Moore being admitted into the hospital, he was released from custody on the 148(a)(1)pc charge via 849(b)pc.

Moore was later taken to UCDMC after it was discovered that Moore had multiple rib fractures, a punctured lung and a lacerated spleen.

On 6-7-13, I assisted Officers Dahl and Yang as they obtained an arrest warrant. A misdemeanor arrest warrant was issued for Moore's arrest for violation of 148(a)(1)pc.

I reviewed the ICC footage from this incident.

Officer Dahl and Yang's ICC captured the initial vehicle code violation and the subsequent pursuit of Moore. When Moore was taken into custody, this occurred out of view of the ICC.

Officer Farrales' ICC captured Officer Dahl walking/ carrying Moore to his patrol car.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, including the fact that Moore fled when ordered to stop by officers, his attempt to scale a fence onto private property after dismounting his bicycle, the fact that he had not yet been searched, Officer Dahl's expectation that Moore would either be on the fence or running after he momentarily lost sight of Moore, Officer Dahl's forward momentum when he placed his knee on Moore's midsection, Moore's pre-existing medical condition, and the fact that the entirety of this incident was rapidly evolving, I believe the use of force to be consistent with department policy.

On 06-07-13 at approx 0213 hours, Officer Yang #881 and I, Officer J.Dahl #817 (2A35) were on uniformed patrol, in a marked patrol unit, in the area of 1814 19th St (SAFEWAY). We observed the following in summary.

As we were leaving the SAFEWAY parking lot (W/B on R St), we observed a MWA (later identified as Daniel Moore 01-19-77) riding his bicycle E/B on R St without a bike light (in violation of 21201d cvc). I placed my spotlight on the S-Moore, and Officer Yang yelled out his passenger window for S-Moore to stop. S-Moore said, "What did I do?". Officer Yang advised him we just wanted to talk to him about having no bike light. S-Moore stated somebody had stolen it, and immediately began to flee at a much more rapid pace (E/B) through the SAFEWAY parking lot. We immediately turned our patrol car around, and turned on our overhead lights, which activated our ICC. We began to pursue S-Moore as he fled.

We observed S-Moore ride out onto 19th, and cross over. S-Moore continued E/B along the lightrail tracks. We drove N/B on 19th St, and as we turned E/B on Q St, we observed S-Moore riding N/B along the gravel road (which parallels the train tracks). S-Moore continued across Q St, and we were able to catch up S-Moore as he crossed Q St. We continued to pursue S-Moore as he rode N/B along the gravel road. We were able to get next to S-Moore, and yell at him to stop. S-Moore continued to peddle at a rapid pace, and cross over P St. S-Moore then turned E/B on O St as we continued to pursue. S-Moore then turned N/B onto 20th St (west side of the roadway; on the sidewalk). The total length of the pursuit was approx .5 miles.

We observed S-Moore stop in front of 1418 20th St, and grab a hold of an iron fence, and attempt to climb it. I observed him drop off the fence, and believed he was going to flee on foot. We exited our patrol vehicle, and I ran

towards S-Moore. As I was running towards him, I was expecting to see him fleeing on foot. As I approached S-Moore, he immediately dropped to the sidewalk, and lied on his stomach. At almost the same time, I caught up to S-Moore on foot. With most of my momentum still going forward, and kneeling down, I brought my right leg/knee

S-Moore began to complain about his ribs hurting, and was stating it was from us getting on top of him. We walked him to our patrol vehicle, and pushed him against the hood of our patrol car so he could be search for contraband/weapons. Officer Yang contacted parole who advised S-Moore had got off parole in March of this year. Due to the fact that S-Moore continued to complain of pain to his ribs, probability he wouldn't pass medical at Jail due to his complaint of pain, and the concern that I possibly got pricked by the hypodermic needle, we transported him to Sutter General.

It should also be noted, Officer Clatterbuck and Offier Meier (2W37) did a canvass of the neighborhood.

At the Hospital, staff advised S-Moore had a collapsed lung. S-Moore also had a small abrasion to the back of his left elbow that appeared to be a road rash. Medical staff observed the hypodermic needle and believed it to be un-used.

On 6-7-13 at approx. 0213hrs., I was working as in Downtown Sacramento in a marked police vehicle in full SPD uniform.

I heard a broadcast from 2A35 (Officers Dahl and Yang) advising that they were attempting to make a bike stop and the subject on the bike was fleeing near 1814 19th st. I immediately began responding to that location. After a few moments, Officer Dahl advised that the suspect was in custody. I arrived on scene in the area of 20th st/ N st., and observed multiple officers on scene. I advised dispatch of the final location of the stop.

I observed a subject (later identified as suspect Moore). He was leaning over the hood of a patrol car and an officer was searching his person.

I observed a syringe on the hood of the squad car. The needle was exposed and the syringe was bent.

One of the officers on scene asked if Officer Dahl had been stuck with the needle.

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Follow Up Report # SA 1

I immediately contacted Officer Dahl. He advised he did not think he had stuck himself with the syringe but stated he did rip/ break a fingernail on his right hand. I observed the fingernail on his right ring finger. It was cracked/ ripped at the end of the nail. Officer Dahl advised it had been bleeding but I did not observe any blood.

Officer Dahl advised that Moore had no other wants other than a fresh violation of 148(a)(1)pc. A few minutes later, Officer Yang advised that Moore was a parolee at large. It was later determined that Moore had discharged parole and was not a parolee at large.

I requested Officers Clatterbuck and Meier conduct a neighborhood canvass.

I spoke with Officer Dahl regarding the possibility that he was stuck with the syringe. He continued to advise he did not think he was stuck with the syringe but he was troubled about the ripped fingernail with the potential of the injury being caused by the syringe.

I noted Moore, who was in the backseat of the patrol vehicle, was repeatedly requesting medical attention. I suspected Moore was faking an injury in attempt to avoid incarceration due to his parolee at large status.

I determined that Moore, who was in custody for 148(a)(1)pc would not be cleared for incarceration by jail staff due to his complaint of pain to his chest. Moore was subsequently transported to Sutter General by Officers Dahl and Yang to be medically cleared for incarceration. I responded to Sutter General as well.

Upon arrival at Sutter General, we walked Moore into the triage area. Medical staff subsequently determined that Moore had a collapsed lung. They began medical treatment.

I spoke with Officer Meyer who was at the hospital on an unrelated matter. I requested he obtain a Mirandized statement from Moore since he was not involved in the arrest. Officer Meyer attempted to obtain a Mirandized statement (See Ofc. Meyer's supplement).

We were advised that Moore would be admitted into the hospital. On 06/07/13, at approximately 0325hrs, I, Ofc B Meyer#552 (1A31), was inside the Emergency Room at Sutter General Hospital (2801 L St). I had a subject in custody, pending clearance for incarceration, on an unrelated matter. I was contacted by Sqt J Morris#23 (1SM3), who directed me to a subject that was in the custody of Ofc Dahl#817 and Ofc Yang#881 (2A35). Sqt Morris told me that the subject's name was MOORE, Daniel (MWA 01/19/77) and that he wanted me to take his statement.

At approximately 0330hrs, I contacted MOORE, D. who was laying on an Emergency Room bed. MOORE was speaking in a low voice, identifying himself verbally to me. On 06-07-13, at approx. 0210 hours, I (Ofc. O'Shea #512) was investigating a call of subjects shooting people with an airsoft gun at 1814 19th St (Safeway). I was on scene with Ofc. J. Dahl and Ofc. B. Yang (unit 2A35).

Just as I was clearing the scene of the call I observed Ofc. Dahl and Ofc. Yang attempting to contact a male white adult who was riding a bicycle near the intersection of R St/18th St. The bicyclist refused to stop for the officers and increased his speed on his bicycle. He fled westbound through the Safeway parking lot. I attempted to stop the subject by backing my patrol car into his path but he evaded my maneuver.

Ofc Dahl and Yang followed the subject through the Safeway parking lot and I drove to the intersection of 19th St/S St. I observed Ofc. Dahl and Ofc. Yang drive north on 19th St. I drove to R St/20th St in order to cut the bicyclist off if he continued to flee in a westbound direction.

I then heard Ofc. Yang advise over the police radio that he and Ofc. Dahl had the subject detained near 20th St/O St. I arrived at their location approx. 1 minute later.
