Incident Summary

Officer Laird was stopped at a red light at the intersection of 12th/D St. He was riding his department issued police motorcycle. Longmire was walking on the west side of 12th street and crossed at D St against a red light and a red hand pedestrian signal. Officer Laird made contact with Longmire at the S/W corner of 12th/D St and advised him of the violation. Longmire continued to state he did nothing wrong and refused to produce identification or verbally identify himself. Officer Laird requested another unit and continued to gain Longmire's cooperation. Longmire began to back away and Officer Laird attempted to place him in a control hold. As Officer Laird took a hold of his right arm, Longmire pulled away and turned his back to Officer Laird. Officer Laird took hold of Longmire's upper body and took him to the ground to prevent escape. Once on the ground Longmire continued to resist and continually attempted to pry Officer Laird's arms off of him. Officer Laird continued his verbal commands to stop resisting. Officer Laird was in a position behind with his arm around the upper chest area of Longmire. Longmire's strength was matching Officer Laird's and he began to push up as if he was trying to get to his feet. From this position of advantage, Officer Laird obtain a carotid control hold and applied it. The department approved hold was effective and after a few seconds Longmire stopped resisting. officer laird quickly transitioned to handcuffing Longmire. Responding units arrived and after action care was provided to Longmire by the Sacramento Fire Department.

On 9-18-14 at approx 1301 hrs I, Ofc. Laird #459 (MTR61) was riding my marked Sac PD motorcycle in full uniform southbound on 12th St. approaching D St.

I was in the # 2 lane and approached D st. on a solid red light for our southbound traffic. I came to a stop at the limit line and observed a male cross the west side of the intersection southbound against a red hand pedestrian signal. Both the pedestrian signal and vehicle traffic signal were solid red prior to the male stepping off the curb on the northwest corner.

I began to maneuver my motorcycle in front of the vehicle in the # 3 lane and southbound traffic received a green light as the male stepped up onto the curb at the southwest corner of 12th/D st.

I rode my motorcycle onto the sidewalk and stopped while verbally telling the male to come to me. He stopped and asked why. I advised him I was stopping him for crossing on a red pedestrian signal and he stated "I didn't do anything."

I asked for ID and he stated again, "Why, I didn't do anything." After requesting at least 5 times with his response being the same I advised him that he was making a minor thing much bigger with his lack of cooperation. I requested another unit at this point. He again stated that he didn't do anything and began to back away from me.

I attempted to place a control hold on the male (Later ID'd as Nehemiah Longmire) by taking hold of his right arm. He pulled away from me and had his back to me at this point. I acquired a hold around his upper body and pulled him to the ground as he pulled his weight towards D st (away from me).

Once on the ground he was face down with me on his back. He began prying my arms off of his body with relative ease as I began to attempt to obtain control of him. I began telling him multiple times to stop resisting. I became concerned with his strength as pulled my arms from his body.

I attempted to call for cover on my radio but was not sure I got my radio traffic out. (S) Longmire was also pushing up on my body as if he was

trying to get up.

I obtained a carotid control hold with my right arm and applied it as he was attempting to continue prying my arms off of him. After a few moments I felt him stop prying my arm and I heard what sounded like snoring. I let go of the hold and grabbed his now limp left arm and cuffed it.

At this point DA investigator Wagstaff arrived and began controlling (S) Longmire's legs. (S) Longmire came back to and I was attempting to pull his right arm back. I ordered him to give me his arm. Longmire struggled briefly but I was able to pull his arm back and cuff him.

I immediately requested Code 3 Fire via radio and began after force care (ensure breathing, pulse, etc). (S) Longmire was looking around and was breathing. Responding officers and I sat him up on his rear end and waited for Fire. I observed a scrape on the right side of (S) Longmire's face and a scrape on his right elbow. CSI responded for photos.

Engine 2 arrived and (S) Longmire was checked out. Fire stated all vitals were normal.

Sgt. Vassallo responded to the scene and was updated.

A canvas of the area was completed by responding officers (see sups).

Ofc. Baker (1B35) transported (S) Longmire to Sac CO. Main Jail for me. Ofc. Baker also booked all of (S) Longmire's property (sleeping bag and duffel bag) for safekeeping.

Once at jail I mirandized (S) Longmire verbatim off my Sac PD 133 card (see attached statement).

Once I booked (S) Longmire, I cleared the call.

On 09-18-14 at approx 1301 hrs, Officer Ratcliffe and I, Officer Cook, responded to the area of 12th St/D St for an Officer Requesting code 3 cover. Upon arrival, The Officer already had a male subject detained, handcuffed.

I helped conduct a canvass of the area and did not locate any witnesses that saw the incident.

There were some exterior security cameras located on the corner building, 400 12th St. I contacted a female employee, working behind the register, and asked if she knew how the Security Cameras functioned and if they were operational. The female stated she did not know and provided me with the owner of the building's phone number and name. The owner's name was [REDACTED] and his phone number was [REDACTED].

I called the number and spoke to [REDACTED]. He explained that he was not sure if his surveillance cameras were functioning or not. [REDACTED] stated that he used to be able to pull up his security system on his phone and on his computer, but he cannot access it any more. He added that he believed the system was working and that he had a recorder and monitor upstairs of the store, but did not know how to view the footage.

OBSERVATIONS: J RATCLIFFE #224

On 9-18-2014, Ofc Cook #213 and I, Ofc Ratcliffe #224, were assigned as uniformed police officers in a marked black and white police vehicle in downtown Sacramento. At approx 1305 hrs, Ofc Cook and I responded to an emergency request for additional officers to assist at 12th St/D St. Ofc Cook and I responded with our emergency lights and siren activated. When we arrived, there were already several officers on scene. I assisted by canvassing the area for witnesses.

Across the street from the incident (northwest corner of 12th St/D St), I saw four FBA's and one MBA standing and watching the officers. I contacted the group to determine if there were any witnesses to the event. Ofc Tillotson came over to help me. Ofc Tillotson talked to a woman who gave a statement. I asked the MBA if he saw anything, but he gave me a blank look and walked away without saying anything to me.

I engaged the other three women in conversation about the event. One woman, who said she owned a shop up the street (on 12th St) said she didn't want to get involved and left. I spoke to the other two women about what they saw.

Both women said they were at the store up the street and saw (suspect Longmire) walk by the store. A short time later, they saw a motor officer ride by on a police motorcycle. Shortly after that, someone said the motor officer was fighting with someone down the street, which is when they came down to see what was happening.

The women said that they were unaware of why (suspect Longmire) was detained and did not see any of the initial interaction with the officer. The women said that their only concerns were that the officer appeared to have (Longmire) in a choke hold and wanted to know why so many officers responded. I spoke to them about arrest/control techniques and about radio broadcasts for assistance and they were satisfied with the explanation about police procedures. I asked them if they saw the officer conduct himself in any manner that was inappropriate and they said no. I asked them if the suspect was fighting with the officer and they said that (Longmire) was trying to get up from the ground after the officer had put him there. The women said once other officers arrived, the incident was quickly resolved.

I asked the women to identify themselves for the report and they refused. One woman walked away while the other woman continued talking to me. She said her son had recently been arrested for filming a fight at Arden Mall and had \$1 million dollar bail set by the court. I did not get any other identifying information about her.

I did not get close enough to notice if there was a scratch/abrasion there, or if the blood came from somewhere else.

I transported Susp-Longmier to the SCMJ. Officer Laird took custody of Susp-Longmier at the SCMJ and booked him for 148(a) PC/Resisting-Obstructing-Delaying a Peace Officer in the scope of duties.

As Susp-Longmier had personal property in excess of what could be booked at the SCMJ, I responded to 555 Sequoia Pacific, where I booked Susp-Longmier's personal property for safekeeping.

On September 18, 2014, at approximately 1303 hours, I (Officer D. Smart #0884) was working Unit XRY84 in uniform. I was doing surveillance related to suspended driver's licenses for drunk driving. I was driving a silver Ford Fusion unmarked police car.

I was driving from a location on Garden Highway to a location on P Street when I heard an officer needed assistance at 12th Street and D Street. I was in the number two lane passing that location southbound and saw an officer (later identified as Officer Laird) struggling with a subject on the sidewalk, on the southwest corner.

I made my way across two lanes of traffic and parked south of Officer Laird. I got out and saw that the male Black suspect was on his stomach, facing south. He was handcuffed and Officer Laird had him in a control hold. DA Investigator Wagstaff was assisting him by holding the suspect's legs down. I asked how I could help and Officer Laird advised me he needed a patrol car with a cage and the Fire Department for a carotid restraint. Officer Baker drove up and I advised her of what Officer Laird needed. She parked her car patrol car next to them and advised that Fire had been requested.
