### Incident Summary

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On January 11, 2015 at approximately 1606 hours, Officer Catricala was hailed by a security guard at 1580 W. El Camino Ave. This address is a Taco Bell restaurant. It was reported to him that there was a drunk male inside the store sleeping and refusing to leave.

Officer Catricala went inside of the store and contacted the subject, who was identified as [REDACTED] asleep on a bench. Officer Catricala attempted to wake up [REDACTED] by tapping him on his shoulder and calling out to him with negative results. Officer Catricala eventually had to sit [REDACTED] up by lifting on the sleeve of his right arm.

Officer Catricala immediately could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from [REDACTED]. He also saw that [REDACTED] had urinated on himself and on the bench.

[REDACTED] was less than cooperative and eventually had to be helped outside by Officer Catricala. Once outside, [REDACTED]'s legs went limp and he pulled his right arm away from Officer Catricala and stumbled to the ground.

Officer Catricala tried to handcuff [REDACTED] as he sat on the ground [REDACTED] began to resist and tuck his hands into his body and lay on them. Officer Catricala used a rear wrist lock on [REDACTED]'s left arm in an attempt to gain compliance [REDACTED] clenched his right arm tight by his chest/neck area and would not allow Officer Catricala to place him into handcuffs. Officer Catricala advised [REDACTED] to stop resisting and to get onto his stomach to no avail.

Officer Catricala tightened up the rear wrist lock in a further attempt to gain compliance. As he did this, he heard a "pop" come from [REDACTED]'s left arm [REDACTED] finally complied and slowly rolled onto his stomach. Ofc. Catricala was able to get [REDACTED] handcuffed.

Medical attention was summoned due to [REDACTED]'s level of intoxication and possible arm injury [REDACTED] was transported to Sutter General.

It was later learned via Officer Tiner that [REDACTED] sustained an acute fracture of his upper left arm. He was placed into a soft cast and splint. Ofc. Tiner attempted to get a statement from [REDACTED] but he had been discharged and left the hospital.

Witness [REDACTED] was contacted on scene. He told Officer Cook and Officer Kroupa that he saw everything. He was in his vehicle in the parking lot at the front entrance of Taco Bell (1580 W El Camino Ave.) He saw [REDACTED] in Taco Bell and Officer Catricala pull up in his patrol vehicle. He thought it would be best for him to stay in his vehicle. He saw Catricala enter Taco Bell and contact [REDACTED]. He said [REDACTED] was actively resisting Officer Catricala. Officer Catricala assisted [REDACTED] outside [REDACTED] was having a hard time maintaining his balance. Once outside [REDACTED] began to fall. Officer Catricala intervened and prevented [REDACTED] from hitting his head on the ground. At this point [REDACTED] was still resisting. He would not put his hands behind his back. He had his hands tucked under his chin. Officer Catricala grabbed his right hand and brought it to his back. When Officer Catricala did this he heard a loud pop [REDACTED] said Officer Catricala barely put his hand on [REDACTED]'s right arm when he was attempting to bring it to his back [REDACTED] said Officer Catricala used no force. Note [REDACTED] statement varies in the fact that Officer Catricala said the "pop" came from [REDACTED]'s left arm and [REDACTED] said that it came from his right arm.

Taco Bell employee [REDACTED] was contacted. She said she saw Officer Catricala come in the store and deal with [REDACTED]. Once Officer Catricala and [REDACTED] were outside, she saw Officer Catricala trying to handcuff [REDACTED]. She said it looked like a struggle for the officer to handcuff [REDACTED]. She could not hear what was being said during the struggle outside as she was behind the food counter.

Taco Bell employee [REDACTED] was contacted. She saw Officer Catricala talking with [REDACTED] inside of the store but could not hear what was being said. She saw Officer Catricala walk [REDACTED] outside. She did not see what happened from that point on.

The security guard (W [REDACTED]) who hailed Officer Catricala told me that he witnessed some of the incident. He saw [REDACTED] walk out of Taco Bell with Officer Catricala then collapse to the ground. He said [REDACTED] curled up and put his hands underneath himself. He heard Officer Catricala telling [REDACTED] "stop resisting" several times. He did not see when the injury occurred.

I did not locate surveillance cameras on the outside of the shopping center. Taco Bell does have surveillance cameras on the inside of the store. Their camera #2 captured what happened in the store but did not capture any outside footage. I looked at their other cameras and did not see any pertinent footage related to this incident. Mike Baker was notified to retrieve the footage as the employees did not know how to download it for me.

There is no ICC footage of this incident.

After reviewing all of the above information, it is my opinion that Officer Catricala used the appropriate level of force. Ofc. Catricala was a solo officer dealing with a resistive drunk subject. He used an academy trained control hold to overcome the resistance tha [REDACTED] was providing.

On 01/11/15, at 1606 hours, I, Officer Catricala #379 (1C17) was on routine patrol wearing full police uniform and driving a fully marked patrol vehicle when I was hailed by a security guard at 1580 W. El Camino Ave (Taco Bell) regarding a drunk male, later identified as [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]), who had been sleeping inside of the Taco Bell since 1000 hours. I observed the following in summary:

I observed [REDACTED] asleep on a bench inside of the Taco Bell. I attempted to wake [REDACTED] up, by tapping him on the shoulder and calling out to him with negative results. Again I tried to call out to [REDACTED] but I got no response. I lifted [REDACTED] up by the sleeve of his right arm and sat him up.

Immediately, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath and body. It was also at this time that I noticed that [REDACTED] had urinated on himself. His shorts were soaked. There was also urine on the bench and ground by his feet.

[REDACTED] asked, "What's your problem man?".

I advised him to grab his belongings and to get out of the Taco Bell.

[REDACTED] said, "You don't want to mess with me man!".

Again, I asked him to grab his things and to leave the Taco Bell. [REDACTED] did not comply.

I moved [REDACTED]'s backpack and guitar case outside and one last time advised him to grab his belongings and to leave.

[REDACTED] said, "Okay I will go," but then crossed his legs and resumed sitting on the bench,

I grabbed [REDACTED] by the right arm and lifted him up. I walked him to the door and outside. Once outside, his legs went limp and he pulled his right arm away from me and stumbled to the ground.

Once on the ground I stood over him and attempted to grab [REDACTED]'s hands to put him in handcuffs, but he began to resist and tuck his hands into his body and lay on them.

I grabbed [REDACTED]'s left arm and put it in a rear wrist lock behind his back. I advised [REDACTED] to stop resisting and to get on his stomach, but he did not comply. [REDACTED] clenched his right arm tight by his chest/neck area and would

not allow me to grab it to place him in handcuffs. I advised [REDACTED] to give me his right hand and to get on his stomach a final time, but he did not comply.

I tightened up the rear wrist lock on [REDACTED]'s left arm in an attempt to get [REDACTED] to comply at which point I heard a loud "pop" and felt his left arm go limp.

[REDACTED] finally complied and slowly rolled on his stomach. I placed both of his arms behind his back and his hands in handcuffs.

I requested medical attention for [REDACTED] Sac FD Engine #4 and Medic #4 arrived on scene at approx. 1618 hours. I did not observe any visible injury to [REDACTED]'s left arm or body as a result of the incident.

Due to the circumstances of [REDACTED] being extremely intoxicated and possibly having injured his left arm internally while resisting, He was transported by Medic #4 to Sutter General Hospital.

Officers Kroupa #265 and Cook #707 arrived on scene and obtained a witness statement (SEE OFFICER COOK SUPPLEMENT).

Sgt. Kirtlan was advised of the incident.

I completed a City of Sacramento Red Border Form to document the injury to Stame.

I cleared the scene.

I am Mike Baker (VH-1), Media Production Specialist II, badge number 6511, employed with the Sacramento Police Department. I'm permanently assigned to the Digital Forensics Unit (DFU), Forensic Video, in the Office of Investigations.

On 1/14/2015, at approximately 09:11 hrs, I was contacted by Sgt. Josh Kirtlan, # 3122 who requested I respond to Taco Bell, 1580 West El Camino Avenue in Sacramento, to collect (download) Close Circuit Television (CCTV) video footage and images, and audio data from the CCTV system's hard drive (HDD) for a Casualty Report investigation, report number 15-9436. The requested time frame of interest was approximately 1/11/2015 - 16:00 hrs, Sacramento Police Department 'Computer Aided Dispatch' time (SPD CAD time).

On 1/21/2015, at approximately 13:10 hrs, I arrived at Taco Bell, 1580 West El Camino Avenue. Upon arrival, I made contacted with employee Ms. (REDACTED).

I authenticated the CCTV system date and time stamp by comparing the difference between the current CCTV date and time stamp displayed on the CCTV monitor with the Sacramento Police Department, Computer Aided Dispatch time (SPD CAD time). SPD CAD time was documented as 1/21/2015 - 13:21 hours, while at the same time, the CCTV date and time stamp was displaying 1/21/2015 - 13:20:55 hours. The authenticated CCTV date and time stamp off set is approximately - :05 seconds difference from SPD CAD time.

The camera system consists of eight (8) cameras out of a total capacity of eight (8) cameras. Both the DVR's 'motion sensor' and 'continuous record' modes were set to 'Enabled'. No microphones or audio of any kind was recorded on the CCTV system.

Relevant camera angles include: 1, 2, 3, and 4

I downloaded four hundred eighty two (482) native / proprietary data files with their viewer application from the native DVR to a 16 GB USB 2.0 flash drive, establishing evidence specimen #01.

I departed the location at approximately 14:41 hrs.

Back at the SPD Forensic Multimedia Lab (SPD FML), at approximately 16:19 hrs, I secured and stored evidence specimen 01 in the Video Lab Locker (SPD VLL).

On 1/22/15, at approximately 08:08 hrs, I removed evidence specimen 01 from the SPD VLL and I calculated a hash value and copied verbatim CCTV data from the 16 GB USB 2.0 flash drive to 2 of 2 DVD-R's, establishing master evidence specimen # 01. I compared the specimen's calculated hash values and checked the copied data for consistency with file size, content and footage accuracy. Both specimens are confirmed to be identical. I utilized the hash calculation software ExactFile, by Studylab Software LLC, 2009, version 1.0.0.15 Beta to calculate hash values.

At approximately 09:01 hrs, I calculated a hash value and copied verbatim CCTV data from the 16 GB USB 2.0 flash drive to the Forensic Multimedia Depository Archive (FMDA) digital case file, establishing a working copy of specimen # 01 (WC 01). I compared the specimen's calculated hash values and checked

the copied data for consistency with file size, content and footage accuracy. Both specimens are confirmed to be identical. I utilized the hash calculation software ForensicCopy, Sanderson Forensics Ltd. 2007, version 1.0.0 (c) to calculate hash values.

At approximately 09:34 hrs, I booked master evidence specimen 01 into the Versadex evidence management system, establishing SPD PR # 852811-1, and deposited that DVD-R into a sealed SPD evidence envelope intact, and in original condition. I deposited the evidence envelope into the Hall Of Justice, Property Section Drop Box (P-HOJ), in the Public Safety Center - Hall Of Justice, at 5770 Freeport Blvd., suite 100.

I purged the CCTV data from the 16 GB USB 2.0 flash drive for its future re-use.
