Incident Summary

The following account describes a use of force, police K9 and CED deployments. Information for this summary was generated from prepared police reports, statements from officers on scene, witness statements, neighborhood canvas and review of all available ICC footage/audio. All officers were wearing full police uniforms and riding in fully marked patrol vehicles equipped with functioning in-car-camera (ICC) systems. I (Sergeant Justin Brown #3129) was working as the District 6 patrol supervisor (1SM6).

On 9/22/16 (Thursday) at approximately 0028 hours, K9 Officer Dustin Henderson #0343 (K94) was working in the area of Florin Road/Franklin Boulevard when he received an SPD POD hit related to an armed vehicle (LIC # [REDACTED] - Silver Toyota Camry. Wanted suspects associated with the car were named: Trevonn and [REDACTED] both suspects were wanted for a 211, 245, 215, 236, and 422 PC case out of Citrus Heights (CHPD 16-08179). Officer Henderson did not immediately locate the vehicle.

Officer Michael Bradley #0545 also responded to search for the suspect vehicle. Upon checking the area, he located the vehicle near 24th Street/Gardendale Road and followed it to the area of [REDACTED] Nedra Court. At this location, the solo driver (later confirmed as Trevonn Tyler XREF [REDACTED]) came to a stop and Officer Bradley conducted a felony vehicle stop (emergency equipment activated) with the assistance of Officer Henderson and Lieutenant Paul Freeman (LN12 #4008). Prior to the stop, the suspect drove around Nedra Court multiple times.

During the stop, suspect Tyler was given verbal commands to exit the passenger side of the vehicle, but he did not comply. Instead, he exited the driver's side, removed a portion of his clothing as he walked to the rear of his car, and began yell at the officers. Tyler was given multiple commands to "turn around," "get your hands out of your pockets," and "Get down on your knees," but he refused to comply. Instead, he advanced (walked) towards officers in a hostile manner with his hands in his pockets. At that moment, Officer Bradley and Lieutenant Freeman deployed C.E.D's, which were evidently ineffective. Neither C.E.D penetrated the suspect's skin.

Officer Henderson sent his police service K9 (Ike) to apprehend suspect Tyler based on the following facts known at the time of the event:

- 1) Suspect Trevonn Tyler was a named suspect on the violent crimes of 211, 245, 215, 236, and 422 PC charges out of Citrus Heights (CHPD 16-08179) and officers were attempting to arrest him on those charges.
- 2) The suspect clearly refused to comply with any repeated commands given to him by multiple officers on scene, in violation of 148(a)(1) P.C. (Resisting, delaying, obstructing arrest).
- 3) The suspect had not been searched for weapons and it was unknown if he was armed with a weapon that could be utilized against officers attempting to effect his arrest. In addition to the suspect, the vehicle had not been searched for any potential weapons. In addition, the DOJ hit advised that the suspects were possibly armed with firearms.
- 4) Suspect Tyler continued to ignore commands to keep his hands out of his pocket. The fact that he continued to place his left hand in his pocket made Officer Henderson fearful for his safety, the safety of other officers, and the safety of the public around them.
- 5) Two C.E.D.'s were deployed with no visible effect on suspect Tyler.
- 6) Officer Henderson was concerned that suspect may flee into the dense residential complex if not taken into custody, posing a greater risk to the public if not immediately apprehended.

Following the K9 deployment/apprehension, Officer Henderson ordered K9 Ike to release the suspect and the suspect was handcuffed / detained.

Sacramento Fire/Medical personnel (Engine 56) arrived at the scene and provided medical care for suspect Johnson (sustained puncture, avulsion, rake wounds to his right forearm).

Prior to being booked into jail (148 PC/other felony offenses), suspect Tyler received further medical care at Kaiser South Hospital (medical clearance). CSI (Jason Noulete #0837) responded to photograph Tyler's injuries as well as the scene. No officers were injured during the incident. A canvas was completed for witness statements and possible video surveillance of the incident (no video available). I responded and took control of the scene.

The Citrus Heights Police Department later responded to the hospital to take custody of suspect Tyler.

I conducted C.E.D downloads for Officer Bradley and Lieutenant Freeman. I learned the following:

- 1) Officer Bradley's device is approximately 25 minutes behind and was discharged once for four seconds at the time of the described incident.
- 2) Lieutenant Freeman's device is approximately 16 minutes ahead and was discharged once for five seconds at the time of the described incident.

Upon review of this incident, it is my belief that the uses of force (canine and C.E.D deployments) were within the Sacramento Police Department's policy. I viewed all available ICC footage of involved officers and observed the following issue:

1) During the felony stop, Officer Bradley (Primary) appears to leave his position of cover behind his patrol vehicle and move approximately 15 feet in front of his patrol car (no cover) with his handgun pointed (with TAC light) at the suspect vehicle. 1A44 (Officer Lilia Alonso #0505) was on scene assisting with the stop at the time. The officer appears to pie the suspect vehicle until he reached the driver's side where he gained visual of the suspect. Officer Bradley remained in this inherently dangerous position for approximately 5 to 8 seconds before he retreated back to his original position of cover.

This issue was addressed by Lieutenant Freeman. I did not observe any other issues following a review of this incident.

On 09/22/2016 at approximately 0029 hours, I Ofc.Bradley #545, responded to the area of 24th Street and Florin Road regarding a wanted felony vehicle in the area. Per the broadcast by dispatch, the vehicle was a gray Toyota Camry with a license plate of [REDACTED]. Trevon Tyler [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were listed as the wanted suspects involved in the following crimes per Citrus Heights PD report #16-08179: 211 PC, 236 PC, 245 PC, 422 PC and 215 PC. The vehicle was listed as armed and dangerous.

While parked at the Petro Star gas station located at the intersection of 24th Street and Florin Road, I observed a gray Toyota Camry traveling west bound on Florin Road. The vehicle turned south onto 24th Street and I began to follow it. As I got behind the vehicle, I confirmed the license plate of [REDACTED]

The vehicle then signaled to make a right hand turn and proceeded west into Nedra Court. The driver maneuvered around the complex several times and then suddenly turned into a field located on the south side of the housing complex before coming to a stop. I activated my overhead lights and directed my spotlight into the vehicle. Additional units arrived on scene and a felony vehicle stop was conducted. Lieutenant Freeman (LN12) and K9 Ofc.Henderson (K94) were standing to my left.

I gave the driver (later identified as Trevon Tyler) several verbal commands to show me his hands. He began asking why he was being pulled over. I ordered him to turn off the vehicle and throw the keys out of the window. He ignored my commands and stated he would not comply until he knew why he was being stopped.

I then ordered Tyler to slowly exit the vehicle through the passenger side door of the vehicle several times. Tyler instead exited the drivers side and began to remove his clothing. He was told no less than 5 times to turn around and place his hands behind his head. Tyler continued to removed articles of clothing and began to walk towards my patrol car ignoring all commands given by Officers.

As Tyler was walking towards the patrol car, he reached into his left front pants pocket several times. Myself, along with K9 Ofc. Henderson and Lt. Freeman, gave him multiple verbal commands to stop and place his hands in the air. He refused saying, "I don't have a fucking gun, fuck that." As Tyler began to get within a few feet of us, I drew my taser and aimed it at his chest.

Tyler began to reach into his left pocket again. I heard Lt.Freeman deploy his taser which appeared to be ineffective. I then deployed my taser which also

had no effect on Tyler who was still standing. K9 Ofc.Henderson then deployed his dog which bit Tyler's right arm and pulled him to the ground (See Ofc.Henderson' Supp).

Lt. Freeman and I approached Tyler and placed him in handcuffs. I conducted a search of his person incident to arrest but did not locate any contraband. A medic was requested for Tyler's injuries. Engine 16 arrived on scene and transported Tyler to Kaiser South Hospital. Ofc. Vito escorted Tyler to the hospital.

I contacted Citrus Heights PD who advised me that they would be sending their own tow truck to evidence impound the vehicle. Golden State Tow arrived on scene and took possession of the vehicle.

The taser cartridges were collected and booked as evidence by Ofc.Alonso at JERPF. A neighborhood canvass was conducted by additional officers (See Supplements).

CSI responded for photos of the scene. CSI also responded to Kaiser South for photos of Tyler and his injuries.

I responded to Kaiser South to meet with Citrus Heights PD officers who were going to take custody of Tyler. Tyler had a severe laceration to his right arm caused by the dog bite but refused any type of medical attention from doctors who advised Tyler that he needed surgery. No puncture wounds from either taser were observed by medical staff.

Detective Herman of Citrus Heights PD arrived at the hospital and took custody of Tyler. I advised Detective Herman of the additional 148 PC charge which he stated he would add to Tyler's existing charges.

Initially when the man got out of the car he did have his hands up and he had his keys in his hands. Once he was taking off his clothes and walking out away from his car he started moving his hands around and again was a dummy and reached with his hands down into his pockets. I heard a noise that sounded sort of like something was thrown, but I did not see him or anyone throw anything. I am not sure, but it just looked like I saw something small and black fly. I am not familiar with tasers but it could have been that. That is when the K9 officer let his dog go and gave it some sort of command and the dog went and bit the man. It seemed like they let

The dispatchers confirmed the want on the vehicle, advising over the radio that it was wanted out of the City of Citrus Heights regarding 211PC, 236PC, 245PC, 422PC and 215PC charges. I recalled an All Units broadcast the night before regarding the above vehicle and the named suspects who were known to carry weapons.

Officer Bradley advised over the radio that he was behind the above vehicle at the intersection of Florin Road and 24th Avenue.

I responded to his location from Freeport Blvd and 43rd Avenue while driving Code 3.

Officer Bradley advised that the vehicle was traveling southbound 24th Avenue and that it was making a westbound turn onto Nedra Court. The driver drove around Nedra Court for several minutes while Officer Bradley followed behind.

I was the first unit on scene to assist Officer Bradley, the above vehicle was traveling southbound near the southwest corner of the complex, it then traveled westbound along the south alley of the complex. The driver stopped the vehicle near an empty field facing south toward Meadowview Road.

Officer Bradley activated his overhead lights and instructed the male driver and sole occupant of the vehicle to turn off his vehicle and exit via the front passenger door.

As I exited my patrol vehicle, I saw a female walking toward the above vehicle. She stated the driver was her boyfriend and asked why he had been pulled over. She tried to walk up to the vehicle to make contact with the driver. I told her I was concerned for her safety while we dealt with the driver and placed her in the back-seat of my patrol vehicle to keep her out of harms way.

The driver turned the vehicle off, held a set of keys up high so we could see them but then proceeded to step out of the vehicle via the driver's door and not the passenger door as instructed by officers.

Officer Bradley gave him a set of instructions which he ignored, instead decided to take his sweater off, pull his shirt up so we could see his waist-band and said "I'm not armed."

The male placed his right hand inside his front right pant's pocket multiple times, even though he was told to keep his hands up and to get down on the ground.

The male started walking toward the front of Officer Bradley's patrol vehicle, heading toward the driver's door. Lt. Freeman, K9 Officer Hendricks and Officer Bradley were all near the driver's door.

The male continued to approach the officers while placing his right hand inside his pant's pocket and also intermittently placing his hands in the air but still refusing to follow officer's instructions.

I heard two CEDs deployed and then heard the K9 handler sic the K9 dog on the male. The male tried to pull away from the dog as it bit him on his right upper arm.

Lt. Freeman, K9 Officer Hendricks and Officer Bradley all handcuffed the male, this occurred out of my view as I then continued monitoring the vehicle in case there were more occupants.

Officer Hasegawa and I cleared the vehicle and make sure there were no other occupants.

The male verbally identified himself as Trevon Tyler with a partial date of birth of 12-01.

I contacted the female in the back-seat of my patrol vehicle, she verbally identified herself as [REDACTED]. She asked why she was under arrest, I explained that she was not under arrest and that the reason she was in the back-seat of the patrol vehicle was to prevent her from interfering with our investigation and to keep her out of harms way.

I walked [REDACTED] back to her apartment because she stated she had two small kids and was concerned for their welfare.

Tyler was transported to Kaiser South by SFD to be treated for the injuries to his right arm.

I collected two spent CED cartridges (Taser brand, Serial #REV C3100546X and Serial #REV C3100PRYH), four probes and multiple AFIDs from near the area where Tyler was taken into custody. I booked all items as evidence at JERPF.

On 09-22-2016, at approximately 0028 hours, I was working full uniformed patrol in the City of Sacramento. I was driving a fully marked Sacramento Police Department "K9" patrol vehicle. I observed the following in summary:

I received a Sacramento Police POD hit on a wanted suspect's vehicle that had just traveled westbound on Florin Rd through the intersection of Franklin Blvd. The vehicle CA LIC [REDACTED] (silver Toyota Camry), was listed as a felony vehicle and per the records hits suspects Trevon Tyler and [REDACTED] were both wanted on 211, 245, 215, 236, and 422 PC charges out of Citrus Heights (CHPD 16-08179). I broadcasted the information to dispatch and our south area patrol units.

I conducted a records check on Trevon Tyler (DOB:12-01-1992) through the Sacramento Sheriff's known person finder and observed a prior booking photograph of him dated 08-10-2016. (S) Tyler was named as one of the suspects and per the DOJ hit he may be armed and dangerous and that he was known to carry firearms.

I started responding to the area to check for the felony vehicle. At approximately 0031 hours, SPD Officer Bradley located the suspect vehicle as it was traveling southbound on 24th St near Gardendale Rd. Additional units started responding to his area.

Officer Bradley followed the suspect vehicle as it pulled into the Nedra Ct residential complex off of 24th St. As I was responding Officer Bradley broadcasted that the suspect vehicle was driving around the Nedra Ct residential complex multiple times. Based on my prior training and experience suspect's who start traveling in circles have used this tactic prior to resisting, fleeing, or delaying law enforcement actions.

Officer Bradley followed the suspect vehicle until he became committed to stopping it in the south alleyway of Nedra Ct near [REDACTED] Nedra Ct. I arrived on scene at approximately 0037 hours.

I got out and deployed my police service canine "Ike". As I walked up to Officer Bradley's patrol vehicle I observed a single occupant inside of the suspect vehicle. I gave the occupant a verbal K9 announcement not to run or I would send my K9 and he would get bit.

Officer Bradley was attempting to give the suspect verbal commands with negative results.

Officers gave the suspect commands to exit the vehicle out of the passenger

side. The suspect refused and instead got out of the drivers side door, which we did not have a clear view of. The suspect then walked to the rear of the Toyota and started taking off his sweatshirt and vest without being instructed to do so while yelling at officers. At this point, I observed that it was in fact (S) Trevon Tyler based on the prior booking photograph I had just viewed of him minutes before. He was given multiple commands to, "Turn around" and "Get down onto your knees". He refused to obey any of our verbal commands and then reached his left hand into his front left pants pocket. I was concerned that he might be reaching for a weapon based on his actions, the probable cause warrant, and the armed and dangerous DOJ hit that was on the vehicle. Officers ordered him to "Get your hands out of your pocket!" (S) Tyler pulled his left hand back out and then again put it back in his front pants pocket.

(S) Tyler was completely uncooperative with any of our commands for him to get onto the ground or keep his hands out of his pocket.

(S) Tyler then walked towards our position at the front driver side door of Officer Bradley's patrol vehicle with his hand still inside of his front left pants pocket. He stopped approximately 10-15 feet away and continued to be verbally hostile to us. He again removed his hand from his pocket for a few seconds and then put it back in his front left pocket.

Again for the fifth time he reached down as if he was reaching for his front waist band or front pocket. At this time due to the fact (S) Tyler was non-compliant with any commands, the fact he was closing the distance towards police officers, and that he was unsearched for weapons officers deployed their C.E.D.'s in attempt to subdue (S) Tyler and gain compliance from him. The C.E.D.'s were ineffective on (S) Tyler. At this time, I sent my police service K9 to apprehend (S) Tyler based on the following facts known at the time of the event:

1) (S) Trevon Tyler was a named suspect on the violent crimes of 211, 245, 215, 236, and 422 PC charges out of Citrus Heights (CHPD 16-08179) and officers were attempting to arrest him on those charges.

2) The suspect clearly refused to comply with any repeated commands given to him by multiple officers on scene, in violation of 148(a)(1) P.C. (Resisting, delaying, obstructing arrest).

3) (S) Tyler had not been searched for weapons and it was unknown if he was armed with a weapon that could be utilized against officers attempting to effect his arrest. In addition to the suspect, the vehicle had not been searched for any potential weapons. In addition to the DOJ hit advised that the suspect's were possibly armed with firearms.

4) (S) Tyler continued to ignore commands to keep his hands out of his pocket. The fact that he continued to place his left hand in his pocket made me fearful for my safety and the safety of other officers and the public

around us.

5) The two C.E.D.'s that were deployed had no visible effect on (S) Tyler.

6) I was concerned that (S) Tyler might flee into the dense residential complex if not taken into custody, posing a greater risk to the public if he was not immediately apprehended.

K9 Ike ran up to (S) Tyler and contacted him on his right forearm causing him to turn around. We continued to order (S) Tyler to "Get on the ground!"

(S) Tyler then got onto the ground facing away from us. Our contact team then approached him. I observed that he had his two arms over his head with one of his hands holding his other wrist. I pulled his left arm away in order to break his grasp and place his hand behind his back. Once I got his hand behind his back Lt. Freeman took control of his left hand and I got up. I ordered K9 Ike to release his hold and to come back to me. He complied. Other officers were then able to control his other arm and place him into handcuffs.

I immediately requested code-3 fire/medical units to the scene for a K9 apprehension and C.E.D. deployment.

I observed that (S) Tyler had punctures, rakes, and avulsions to his right forearm from the K9 contact.

Sacramento Fire personnel arrived on scene and transported (S) Tyler to Kaiser South Hospital. CSI was requested to photograph the scene and (S) Tyler.

Officers were assigned to conduct a neighborhood canvas around the arrest area for witness statements.

Citrus Heights PD later responded and took custody of the suspect for their investigation.

On 09-22-16/0028 hrs, I was working uniform patrol in an unmarked black Ford Crown Victoria patrol vehicle. I was working as the Watch Commander for Districts 4, 5, and 6.

I copied radio traffic of a TAS Alert regarding a Felony Vehicle which passed through the POD at w/b Florin Road @ Franklin Blvd. within the last minute. Patrol units responded to check the area for the vehicle, which was wanted by Citrus Heights PD in relation to a robbery, carjacking, terrorist threats, and assault with a deadly weapon. Additional notes in the felony hit stated that the wanted subjects associated with the vehicle were Trevon Tyler and [REDACTED]. Lastly, the notes stated that both subjects were possibly armed with handguns and were anti-police.

At 0032 hrs, I copied that Off. Bradley had located the vehicle and was following it in the area of Gardendale/24th St. I started towards the area. Off. Bradley followed the vehicle into the Nedra Court area and proceeded in circles around the complex while following the vehicle at low speed.

I arrived on-scene with Off. Bradley at 0038 hours. The suspect vehicle had parked of its own volition and Off. Bradley had turned on his overhead red/blue lightbar by the time I arrived.

The suspect vehicle was parked somewhat perpendicular to our patrol cars, so we had a fairly clear view into it via the open front passenger window. Off Bradley, K9 Off. Henderson, Off. Alonso and I agreed to call out the sole occupant through the passenger front door since that allowed us the best visibility and tactical advantage.

Off. Bradley was in a position of cover behind his driver door and had his shotgun trained on the suspect vehicle. I was standing slightly behind Off. Bradley with my handgun drawn at the low ready position. K9 Off. Henderson was next to him with his police service dog.

We gave very loud, repeated instruction to the occupant to come out of the vehicle through the front passenger door, but he came out the driver's door instead. The occupant, later identified as Trevon Tyler, was vocally belligerent with us, continually questioned why we were stopping him, and kept moving around despite our continued instructions to him to stop moving around and lay down on the ground.

Because Tyler had exited from the driver's door, his car was now between him and us, and that obstructed our line of sight. Tyler held his hands up high as he walked to the rear of his car. Once there, he continued to be

verbally belligerent and would not lay down. He dropped his hands several times, then took off his sweatshirt and outer layers against our instruction.

Although he did not obey our instructions, I could now see that he had no obviously visible weapons around his waistband or upper torso area. Tyler continued to disobey our directions to him. I, along with K9 Off. Henderson, told Tyler several times that we would deploy the K9 on him if he did not obey our direction.

While Tyler was shedding his outer layers, and raising his hands up, I saw that he appeared to have gray duct tape wrapped around one of his arms. That struck me as odd, and I believed that he might have proactively wrapped his arm in an attempt to defeat the effects of a dog bite.

Tyler continued to ignore our directions to him to stop and lay down on the ground. Additionally, Tyler then started putting his hands into his pants pockets. I could not tell if he had any weapon in his pants pocket. While he did this, he kept moving from the rear of his car towards our position of cover at Off. Bradley's patrol vehicle. The distance between Tyler at the rear of his car to us was about 25 feet.

As Tyler continued to slowly move towards us, he was still putting his hands in his pockets and disobeying our directions to him to stop and lay down on the ground. Overall, he was acting in a very agitated manner. At one point, I directed K9 Off. Henderson to deploy his police service dog, but I do not think he heard me.

When Tyler bridged the gap between us to about 12-13 feet, I transitioned from my handgun to my CED and brought my red targeting dot to Tyler's torso. I yelled to Tyler that I was going to use my Taser on him if he didn't stop. Off. Bradley also transitioned from his shotgun to his CED.

Tyler kept slowly moving towards our position of cover, so I discharged my CED for one 5 second cycle. Off. Bradley discharged his CED shortly after I did. It appeared that neither CED had any incapacitating effect on Tyler as he remained standing and continued to disobey our directions to him.

K9 Off. Henderson then deployed his police service dog, which bit the duct taped arm of Tyler. Despite the dog biting one of his arms, Tyler clasped his hands together and tried to keep them up over his head in an apparent attempt to overcome the dog bite.

Shortly after, Tyler submitted and went down to the ground. I assisted in forcing Tyler's clasped hands apart, and handcuffed him with my handcuffs.

Throughout this episode, Tyler continued to be belligerent and question everything we were doing. He did not appear to have a rational thought process, but just appeared very agitated.
