Incident Summary

On 7-7-16, at approx. 1318 hours, Officer B. Jensen and J. Jennings were working a two man car and were in full uniformed and marked vehicle. They were flagged down by a Regional Transient security guard whom stated a known subject was high on methamphetamine and acting strange. The officers saw subject Charles Reed dancing in the street on the light rail tracks. Officer Jensen noted that the subject was taking a fighting stance in the street and looked like he was threatening passersbys.

The subject walked to the sidewalk as officers drove towards him and walked towards him. The subject yelled "fuck this nigger and fuck all these niggers out here." The subject initially complied and sat on the sidewalk. Officers noticed the subject had an odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from him and combined with his actions concluded he was so drunk he could not care for himself.

Officer P. Diaz and Officer D. Walker arrived on scene to assist and the subject continued to verbally abusive and officers grabbed a hold of him to place him in cuffs and he began to attempt to pull away. Officer Jennings was putting the subjects left arm in a twist lock, Officer Jensen and Walker were controlling the subjects right arm and Officer Diaz began to pull the subject to the ground; in addition Officer Jennings swept the subjects legs. The other subject went to the ground an hit his forehead on a planter just to his right. The area above his head began to bleed and he sustained a 2" laceration. Officers requested code three medical and had to continue to hold the subject on the ground because he was attempting to get up. He was continuing to be verbally abusive. A spit mask was placed on the subject.

This incident was captured on R.T. surveillance. I reviewed the surveillance and saw that the subject was extremely agitated and appeared like he wanted to fist fight officers as he shifted his weight from foot to foot like a boxer. In addition, witness statements stated the subject was acting hostile, looked like he was on methamphetamine, yelling "nigger," trying to cause fights and that he appeared to want to fight the officers.

The subject had to be transported to the hospital for stitches/staples. Due to an extended ETA to have him medically cleared he was cited for 148 PC. I concluded this use of force was within policy based on the totality of the circumstances. The RT video of the incident was booked as evidence. Officers Jennings and Jensen did activate their ICC cameras after the subject was taken down. Officers Diaz and Walker activated their ICC camera before they contacted the subject.

I reviewed the ICC policy with Officers Jennings and Jensen, reminding them their ICC needed to be activated prior to contacting the subject.
