Incident Summary

SGET officers located the vehicle (shortly after viewing the videos), which was mobile and occupied by 4 suspects, in the area of 34th St. / 21st Ave. in Oak Park. When SGET officers attempted a traffic stop 3 of the 4 suspects fled on foot. Two suspects (later ID'd a DOB fled n/b through residential yards. One suspect (later ID'd as DOB:

fled w/b on 21st Ave. and was apprehended. He was found to be in possession of a loaded handgun (which matched the description of one of the guns from the video) and controlled substances for the purpose of sales.

Officers were unable to locate the second firearm depicted in the above-described videos.

CHP Air21 was overhead and observed S and S continuing to flee through different residential yards for a few blocks and observed the suspects begin to remove clothing items to change their appearance. CHP Air21 was able to determine the suspects were in the back yard of 19th Ave., but then lost sight of them and were unable to determine where in the yard they were hiding. Other officers maintained a perimeter around the area.

Officer Henderson # 343 (K9-4) arrived on scene and was updated on the above-described situation. Based on those circumstances he contacted Sgt. Farnsworth (3SM6) and obtained approval to deploy the K9. An arrest team was created and they entered the back yard. Officer Henderson's K9 was deployed without a verbal warning (due to one firearm still outstanding) and located the two suspects hiding under a wooden deck that was approximately 1.5' - 2' above the ground. The K9 apprehended S and at that point both suspects complied with Officer Henderson's order to surrender. Once both suspects complied, crawled out from under the deck, and made their hands visible, Officer Henderson ordered his K9 to immediately release the suspect, which the K9 did.

Both suspects were handcuffed without incident and Fire was requested C3.

- S sustained the following injuries during the apprehension:
- Laceration to right side of scalp, near hair line.
- Punctures and lacerations to left arm near elbow.
- Punctures to right arm near elbow.
- Punctures and abrasions to left shoulder / upper back area.

He was transported to UCDMC where he received treatment. CSI responded to document the injuries. UCDMC decided to admit him overnight to be treated with additional anti-biotics. The suspect was released per 849(b) PC.

Based on the facts that the suspects were gang members, that they were illegally selling controlled substances, that they were armed (at least one known firearm had not been recovered at the time of the use

of force), that they were actively resisting (in fact going to such lengths as running over fences for multiple blocks and even changing clothing), refusing to voluntarily surrender, and then hiding themselves in such a manner that it would be unsafe for an officer to attempt to apprehend them, it is my opinion that this use of force was appropriate and lawful under the Sacrament Police Department General Orders, as well as the relevant case law and statutory laws.
