Incident Summary

On 6/22/2018, at 2136 hrs, Officer Phelan and Officer Brownridge attempted to place suspect [REDACTED] under arrest for 243e1 PC.

Officer Phelan used hand strikes and a carotid control hold during the arrest. Please see the attached reports.

Officer Phelan had some abrasions on his knee and complaint of pain to his right hand. Suspec [REDACTED] was transported to the hospital where he was thoroughly examined and determined to be fit for incarceration. [REDACTED] had a small laceration on his forehead.

Based on my review of the body worn camera and the reports, it is my opinion the use of force was justified and within policy.

Officer Phelan admitted he forgot to immediately place the suspect into a position of recovery after he was handcuffed. He did immediately request emergency medical and saw that the suspect was breathing and moving.

On 6-22-2018 at approx 2117 hours, while on patrol in a marked police vehicle and in full police uniform, Officer Brownridge #268, and I, Officer Phelan #927, were dispatched to a domestic violence in progress call at [REDACTED] Lampasas Ave # [REDACTED]. Per the text of the call the female half advised that her boyfriend had assaulted her and then quickly hung up the phone after frantically stating "He is coming". I arrived on scene at approx 2126 hours. I observed the following in summary:

Upon my arrival I contacted [REDACTED] (suspect) in the living room of apartment # [REDACTED] and obtained his preliminary statement (see suspect statement). While obtaining [REDACTED]'s statement he repeatedly attempted to turn around and talk to [REDACTED]. He repeated her name several times. [REDACTED]'s eyes were bloodshot and watery, but he advised he had not been drinking.

Officer Brownridge contacted [REDACTED] (victim) in the bedroom and obtained her preliminary victim statement (see Officer Brownridge's supplemental report for further detail).

After contacting the victim, Officer Brownridge advised that [REDACTED] was arrestable for domestic violence.

I asked [REDACTED] to stand up and place his hands behind his back. [REDACTED] complied at first, but as soon as I grabbed his hands he immediately began to tense up. I asked Officer Brownridge to grab [REDACTED]'s right arm so to assist me in placing handcuffs on [REDACTED].

When Officer Brownridge grabbed [REDACTED]'s right arm [REDACTED] immediately began to pull away. [REDACTED] was thrashing his arms about, pulling away from me and began to scream [REDACTED]'s name repeatedly while looking at her.

I continually attempted to maintain control of [REDACTED]'s left arm and was able to get one handcuff around [REDACTED]'s left wrist. I ordered [REDACTED] to stop resisting and to give me his hands both in English and in Spanish multiple times. I could hear Officer Brownridge order [REDACTED] to "Stop" multiple times.

[REDACTED] then forcefully pulled Officer Brownridge and I to the ground

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through the bedroom door. At this time I struck my left knee on the ground and sustained three small abrasions (each approx the size of a dime) on my left knee. I accessed my radio and broadcasted that I was fighting with a subject.

I ordered [REDACTED] to stop again but he did not comply with my commands. He continued to crawl toward [REDACTED] and scream her name while looking at her. [REDACTED] was backed into the corner of the bedroom.

I attempted to maintain control of the one cuff that I had on [REDACTED]'s left arm, but he pulled it away from my grasp.

I was in fear that if [REDACTED] was not immediately taken into custody he would get away from officers and continue to assault [REDACTED] or use the handcuff on his wrist as a weapon against her, Officer Brownridge, or myself.

At this time I delivered three pugilistic hand strikes on or about the left facial or head area of [REDACTED]'s person while ordering him to stop resisting. [REDACTED] continued to pull away from Officer Brownridge toward [REDACTED]. It did not appear that the hand strikes I delivered to [REDACTED] were going to end his pursuit toward [REDACTED].

I could feel myself begin to run out of breath and fatigue began to set into my forearms from struggling to maintain control of [REDACTED].

I then applied a rear carotid control hold to [REDACTED]'s person and rendered him unconscious. I immediately handcuffed [REDACTED] and requested that fire respond to my location code 3. [REDACTED] regained consciousness approx 7 seconds after he was rendered unconscious.

With the assistance of other officers [REDACTED] was removed from the bedroom. I told [REDACTED] that I did not want him to fight anymore. [REDACTED] continued to call out [REDACTED]'s name.

Officer Patterson #943 contacted [REDACTED] (who witnessed the altercation while taking [REDACTED] into custody) and obtained a secondary statement from her (see Officer Patterson's supplemental report for further detail).

I observed that [REDACTED] had suffered a small laceration above his left eye (approx .5" in length) and swelling around his left eye and on the left side of his forehead.

Sacramento Fire Department Medic 20 responded to the scene and transported



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██████ to Sutter General Medical facility for his injuries. Sutter General Medical staff performed a CAT Scan and X-rays to ██████'s person and advised that he did not suffer any fractures or broken bones and they did not observe any internal injuries about his facial or neck area.

A web KPF search revealed that ██████ had an active misdemeanor DUI warrant for his arrest (SA# ██████).

After being declared fit for incarceration by Sutter General Medical staff, ██████ was transported to the Sacramento Main county Jail by Officer Eckert #1001 where he was booked for 243(e)(1) PC (domestic violence), 591.5 PC (taking of a cellular device to prevent police contact), 69 PC (resisting executive officers) and his active arrest warrant.

SGT Griffin (3SM2) was on scene and aware of the details of the call.

All officers had their body worn cameras activated and recording during this investigation.

Officer Phelan knocked on the door and a male subject (later identified as S-██████████) answered the door. S-██████████ then sat on the couch in the living room with V-██████████

I asked to speak with V-██████████ in the bedroom that was just off of the living room. V-██████████ provided me with a statement (see victim statement).

Based on the statement provided by V-██████████ it was determined that V-██████████ was the victim of a misdemeanor domestic violence [243(e)(1) PC]. V-██████████ also stated that she believed that S-██████████ may be on some sort of narcotic.

While trying to obtain a statement from V-██████████ S-██████████ kept tilting his body and looking into the room, he would then call out V-██████████ name. S-██████████ did this several times and had to be told every time to stop.

Officer Phelan asked S-██████████ to stand up in Spanish (this was the only language that S-██████████ spoke). S-██████████ turned around and Officer Phelan had both of his hands behind his back. Officer Phelan then asked me to grab one of S-██████████ arms. As I walked from the front of S-██████████ body to the back to grab onto S-██████████ right arm I saw that Officer Phelan appeared to be struggling to keep S-██████████ hands behind his back. I grabbed onto S-██████████ right arm and could feel that he was tensing his muscles.

S- [REDACTED] began to resist and would not let Officer Phelan and myself get his hands behind his back. Officer Phelan had already put a handcuff onto S- [REDACTED] left wrist at this time.

Fearing that S- [REDACTED] was trying to break free and that he may try to harm Officer Phelan, myself, or V- [REDACTED] who was standing in the next room I began to push S- [REDACTED] head to the ground while keeping his right arm extended into an arm bar for leverage. On Friday (06/22/18) at approximately 2117 hours I, (CSO Davis #8135) and OFC Brownridge #268 were dispatched to (Lampasas Ave #) in regards to a domestic violence call. While on the call OFC's had to use force in order to detain the suspect. I observed the following:

OFC Phelan #927 was in the process of detaining S- and asked for OFC Brownridge to assist him in holding his arms in place. Once OFC Brownridge grabbed S- hand he started to approach V- in the other room.

OFC Phelan and OFC Brownridge took S- down to the ground while OFC Phelan gave multiple commands in both english and spanish to "stop".

S- was not complying with any of the given commands and was still being uncooperative and still trying to approach V-

Due to S- continuously being uncooperative OFC Phelan hit S- approximately twice in the head with the palm of his hand to try and gain compliance from S- The hits to the head were ineffective and S- was still uncooperative and still trying to approach V- while still attempting to be detained.

OFC Phelan then put S- [REDACTED] in a carotid choke hold in order to gain control of him in order to fully detain him. Once the carotid choke hold became affective S- [REDACTED] was out for approximately 3 seconds and then regained consciousness.
