### Incident Summary

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On 7/28/2018, at 1845 hrs, Officer Phelan and Officer Cunningham were dispatched to a call regarding prostitution. See attached reports.

I reviewed the reports and the video recordings of the incident. It is my opinion, that the use of force applied by Officer Cunningham was justified and within policy.

In comparing the carotid control manual with the training we received this year at CPT, I noted that there was a distinct difference as to when you could use the carotid control hold. Due to the conflicting information, I emailed one of the use of force instructors at CPT, K9 Officer Yasonia, and asked for his clarification. He reiterated what had been taught at cpt, that if the resistance was reaching a level where it could turn violent, the officers could apply the carotid control to prevent the incident from becoming violent. This event, falls within those parameters. Officer Yasonia advised that the Carotid Control was currently being updated.

When we discussed the incident, it is clear that officer Cunningham felt the resistance and non compliance more than a person viewing the body cam images could see. He was actually pulled down on top of the suspect, by the suspect, which also was not clear on the ICC. The body was not placed in a position of recovery, but the suspect was still actively resisting and it wasn't even clear whether or not the suspect actually lost consciousness. Later, while the officers were with the suspect at the hospital, the suspect did admit that he did lose consciousness briefly.

[REDACTED] could not sit still, his speech was slurred repetitive and he could not stop talking throughout the rest of our contact. His eyes were bloodshot and watery. I suspected that [REDACTED] was under the influence of Narcotics and alcohol.

Officer Anderson contacted [REDACTED] and obtained her witness statement (see supplemental report for further detail). [REDACTED] refused to provide a statement.

Officer Goetting and Officer Thrall conducted a neighborhood canvass for additional witnesses (see supplemental report for further detail).

Sacramento Fire Department Personnel responded to the scene and conducted a precautionary exam on [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] sustained a scrape above his left eye, some minor bruising to his knees and shins, and some redness to his right shoulder from the incident.

CSI responded to the scene and photographed [REDACTED]'s injuries and Officer Cunningham.

Web KPF indicated that [REDACTED] was still on Felony Formal Searchable probation until 12-26-20 for Burglary and possession of methamphetamines (Case File [REDACTED]) and that he had a no bail misdemeanor warrant for his arrest (Warrant # [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] was in violation of the terms of his probation (OBEY ALL LAWS).

[REDACTED] was transported to Sutter General Medical Facility (2801 L St) where he was declared medically fit for incarceration by Medical staff.

I transported [REDACTED] to the Sacramento Main county Jail where he was booked for 148(a)(1) PC (resisting arrest), 1203.2 PC (felony probation violation) and his no bail warrant.
