Incident Summary

On 7/28/2018, at 1845 hrs, Officer Phelan and Officer Cunningham were dispatched to a call regarding prostitution. See attached reports.

I reviewed the reports and the video recordings of the incident. It is my opinion, that the use of force applied by Officer Cunningham was justified and within policy.

In comparing the carotid control manual with the training we received this year at CPT, I noted that there was a distinct difference as to when you could use the carotid control hold. Due to the conflicting information, I emailed one of the use of force instructors at CPT, K9 Officer Yasonia, and asked for his clarification. He reiterated what had been taught at cpt, that if the resistance was reaching a level where it could turn violent, the officers could apply the carotid control to prevent the incident from becoming violent. This event, falls within those parameters. Officer Yasonia advised that the Carotid Control was currently being updated.

When we discussed the incident, it is clear that officer Cunningham felt the resistance and non compliance more than a person viewing the body cam images could see. He was actually pulled down on top of the suspect, by the suspect, which also was not clear on the ICC. The body was not placed in a position of recovery, but the suspect was still actively resisting and it wasn't even clear whether or not the suspect actually lost consciousness. Later, while the officers were with the suspect at the hospital, the suspect did admit that he did lose consciousness briefly.

On 7-28-2018 at approx 1840 hours, while on patrol in a marked police vehicle and in full police uniform, Officer Cunningham #971, and I, Officer Phelan #927, were dispatched to Boxwood St regarding a report of prostitution activity. Per the text of the call the complainant (unidentified/requested no contact) advised there was a white car with the plate of (white Lexus) parked out front of the location and he could hear subjects in the car negotiating a prostitution deal. I am familiar with this house and have been dispatched to this location several times. Boxwood St is currently an active admin penalty POP location for high calls for service including but not limited to drug use, squatting, and unsafe living activity. I arrived on scene at approx 1845 hours. I observed the following in summary:
Upon my arrival I located the Lexus () on scene. I observed a male Hispanic adult later identified as (suspect) standing on the sidewalk leaning into the front passenger window of the vehicle. I have personally arrested at this location before on 1-27-2018 for a no bail warrant, possession of methampetamines, and a felony probation violation (SPD call #18-27150).
I immediately noticed that had an open Bud Light glass beer bottle in his hand. When noticed that I was pulling over to the sidewalk to make contact with him, he immediately began to walk into the front yard of Boxwood St. I exited my patrol vehicle and made contact with told to stop and put his hands up multiple times but he refused to obey my commands.


