Incident Summary

See attached report.

I responded to the termination point of the pursuit and spoke with the officers involved on scene. I later reviewed the in car camera and body worn camera videos of the incident. I also reviewed the report, Cad call and audio of the incident.

Based on my review of ICC and BWC footage along with the crime report, I believe that this use of force by Officer Calabrese was justified and consistent with SPD policy.

Off. Novak advised me that he attempted to control the suspect by using the carotid control hold after Off. Calabrese had already used the hold because the subject awoke and began fighting again before being handcuffed. Off. Novak said he was not able to complete the hold because of his position on top of the suspect. I reminded Off. Novak that the carotid control hold should not be applied repeatedly and a suspect should not be rendered unconscious more than once per the carotid control hold manual (RM 580.09, Ch. 1 (A)(4)).

I noticed that Off. Novak's worn camera was not activated during the beginning of this incident. He explained that he forgot to turn the camera back on after leaving jail on a previous call prior to this incident. I, also noticed that Off. Powell's body worn camera was not activated at the beginning of this incident. She advised she was not sure whether or not it was on or off, or did not activate when the cars lights came on. I reviewed the body worn camera policy (525.07) with them and explained the extreme importance of having the body worn camera video not only for the evidentiary value, but for the transparency and trust expected of us by the public. (This issue was also noted in the pursuit blue team for this incident.)

I observed that Officers Calabrese and Novak did not broadcast that they were in foot pursuit or the number of suspects they were chasing. I reviewed our foot pursuit policy (580.13D.1.) with them. (This issue was also noted in the pursuit blue team for this incident.)

The above issues were handled on the watch level.

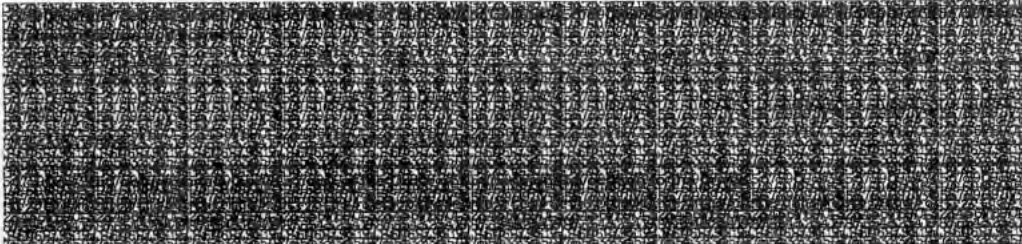

On 11/25/2018, at approximately 1619 hours, Officer Calabrese #1005 and I, Officer Novak #840, were on routine patrol in the area of S Land Park Dr and Florin Rd. We were in full police uniform, driving a fully marked police vehicle equipped with police lights and siren. Officer Calabrese and I had just returned to patrol from booking a subject into jail (SPD 18-375034) and I had not reactivated my body worn camera. It was not active for the beginning portion of this investigation. I recovered the camera from Officer Calabrese (who had activated the camera for me) after the arresting the driver (see below). I observed the following in summary:

Officer Calabrese and I observed a vehicle facing southbound at S Land Park Dr, waiting to turn eastbound onto Florin Rd. The vehicle did not have any working headlights in violation of 24400 VC. Officer Calabrese and I attempted to position ourselves in order to make an enforcement stop of the vehicle.

As we drove behind the vehicle, the light turned green and the vehicle turned eastbound on Florin Rd. I ran a records check of the vehicle (CA LIC [REDACTED]) and observed that it had been the suspect vehicle in a felony pursuit on 11/14/18. No suspect was arrested during that felony pursuit. Due to the recent felony violation that the vehicle was involved in, and the lack of headlights at nighttime hours, Officer Calabrese and I conducted a enforcement stop just east of the above intersection. We activated our overhead police red and blue lights to signal the driver to pull over.

The vehicle turned from eastbound Florin Rd into the Bel Air shopping center parking lot located at 1301 Florin Rd. The vehicle drove northbound through the parking lot, and then signaled to turn left to go westbound through the parking lot. The vehicle turned left, and still refused to pull over and stop despite multiple open parking spots to pull over into.

The vehicle drove to the west to the end of the parking lot and Officer Calabrese activated our police siren. At that moment, the the vehicle drove across S Land Park Dr, crossing the double yellow lines in violation of 21460 VC. I activated my spotlight to illuminate the vehicle and observed only one suspect (the driver) inside the car. The vehicle continued driving westbound through the parking lot of 1195 Florin Rd. I advised over the



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radio that we were in pursuit of the vehicle. The vehicle eventually stopped behind the buildings because there was no where else to drive too.

The suspect inside the vehicle put the car into park, facing northbound (the pursuit lasted .1 miles). I observed the male driver/solo occupant attempt to get out of the vehicle but he was stopped by his seat belt. He then sat back down, took off his seat belt, and then grabbed a blue backpack that was inside the vehicle next to him. The driver got out of the vehicle. I ordered the suspect to stay in the vehicle at gunpoint while Officer Calabrese also gave commands (see his observations for more details). The suspect disobeyed our commands and began running northbound through the parking lot. We began chasing the male suspect on foot. I visually cleared the vehicle seeing as there was no window tint and my close proximity to the vehicle.

Officer Calabrese was able to catch up the suspect before I did. I observed Officer Calabrese assist the suspect to the ground (see his observations for further details). Once the suspect was on the ground, I grabbed his right hand/arm, attempting to put his arm behind his back. He tensed what seemed like every muscle in his body in an effort to get away and resist our arrest. From where the three of us had landed, Officer Calabrese was behind the suspect, pinned underneath him, and I was holding onto his arm, trying to pull him off Officer Calabrese and push him towards the ground. I ordered the suspect to "stop resisting" and to "put your hands behind your back". The suspect refused to comply, instead tensing his muscles and resisting our physical attempts to place him under arrest. Officer Calabrese also issued commands (see his observations).

Officer Calabrese placed the suspect in the carotid control hold (see his observations for more details). After approximately five to ten seconds, I felt the suspect lose consciousness and his arms became less tense. Officer Calabrese informed me that he had lost consciousness by saying "he's out". We turned him over and attempted to place him into handcuffs.

I put the handcuffs on his left wrist and moved to put the other side on his right wrist. At that moment, after approximately ten seconds of being unconscious, the suspect awoke and immediately began tensing his muscles in an effort to fight us. The suspect began flailing his arms around, reaching for anything he could grab onto. Fearful that he was going to reach for something sharp or otherwise dangerous, and not having searched his person yet, I pushed the suspect onto the ground and mounted his back. I used all of my available body weight to keep the suspect on the ground. I tried wrestling with his right arm, attempting to move it behind his back.



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I was unable to move his arm behind his back due to my position. I transitioned my control from his arm to his neck/head area. Based on my training and experience, I know that controlling someone's head while wrestling is an affective means of controlling the other individual.

At this point, Officer Powell #532 had arrived to help us. She was on his leg area (see her observations for more details) and Officer Calabrese was on his right side and I was on his back. The suspect still refused to comply with our commands to stop resisting and was tensing his muscles trying to fight through us despite having three officers on top of him.

While the suspect was actively resisting us, I heard a loud female voice from behind us yelling to "stop". At one point I heard her say "Please stop" and then one of the other officers yelled at her that he was still fighting. At that point, she began yelling at the suspect individually, commanding him to stop. She yelled "stop fighting" and he yelled back at her "No"! She also yelled at us officers that he was "intoxicated".

Within a few more minutes, other officers arrived and assisted us by getting the suspect placed fully into handcuffs. In addition to the handcuffs, officers placed him in max restraints to control his feet from kicking anyone.

At this point, Officer Calabrese recovered my camera and returned it to me. He had activated it and it remained activated for the rest of my investigation.

Officer Calabrese conducted a search incident to arrest and located a wallet. He handed me the wallet. Inside the wallet I located an CA ID card for [REDACTED]. I conducted a records check of S-[REDACTED] and observed the following:

- F/S Probation for 25400(a) (1) PC until 03/05/2023 (Docket #: [REDACTED])
- 2 Felony warrants for his arrest (Warrant numbers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Docket numbers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED])
- A suspended driver's license for 20001 VC (authority 13350A1).
- Multiple gang related crimes in the past five years: SPD Report 18-[REDACTED] (PC 25400(A) (2)). SPD Report 18-[REDACTED] (PC 29815, PC 25850(C) (6)). [REDACTED]
- A CII records check showed that on 03/06/2018, S-[REDACTED] was convicted in Sacramento County ([REDACTED]) of 25400(a) (1) PC and spent 90 days in jail and 5 years on probation.

During the struggle with S-[REDACTED] I observed a strong odor of an



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alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. Based on his driving behavior, his flight on foot, the strong odor, I suspected that he had was driving under the influence of alcohol. I conducted a search incident to arrest of his vehicle and located several empty beer cans (two 16 oz Mickey and one 24 oz Tecate). I later booked those into evidence at JERPF. During the probation search I also located two [REDACTED] inside the vehicle. [REDACTED] shows affiliation as a [REDACTED] gang member.

I was unable to perform SFSTs due to S-[REDACTED] being a flight risk.

Once the scene was controlled (see Officer Calabrese's observations), it was determined that I would ride in the ambulance with him to the hospital. I rode with Medic 57 to [REDACTED] with S-[REDACTED]. At the hospital, S-[REDACTED] spontaneously stated that he wanted a lawyer.

Officer Calabrese requested the on call phlebotomist to respond to the hospital. Once she arrived, I completed a DUI blood draw box. Due to his searchable probation status, the phlebotomist drew his blood from his left hand at 7:40 PM.

Once S-[REDACTED] was medically cleared, he was transported to jail. Once there, I completed the DS367 and served S-[REDACTED] his copy of the paper work.

On 11/26/2018 at approx. 1819 hours Ofc. Novak #840 and I, Ofc. Calabrese #1005, were on routine patrol in full Police uniform, equipped with a body worn camera that was activated and recording during the incident. We were driving a marked Police vehicle in the area of Florin Rd and South Land Park Dr. I observed a vehicle with it's headlights off, in violation of CVC 24400, facing southbound on South Land Park Dr, waiting to make a east bound turn onto Florin rd. See Ofc. Novak's observations for information regarding the vehicle stop.

The vehicle stopped behind 1195 Florin Rd facing north. The suspect, and only occupant of the vehicle, attempted to get out of the vehicle, but appeared to get stuck on his seat belt. The suspect then grabbed a backpack from the front right passenger's seat and exited the driver's seat.

I opened my driver's side door and placed the suspect at gun point. I gave the subject the following commands: "Put your hands up! Put your hands up! Put your hands up!" in a loud authoritative voice to ensure the subject clearly heard the commands. While I gave the suspect commands, he began to run away northbound from Ofc. Novak and I.

Due to the vehicle's windows not having any tint and Ofc. Novak utilizing his spotlight to illuminate the interior of the vehicle I was able to visually clear the inside of the vehicle. I holstered my firearm and chased the suspect north through the parking lot.

I caught up with the suspect after approx. 3 seconds of him leaving his vehicle. I wrapped both of my arms around the suspect's torso and took him to the ground. As I took him to the ground my body worn camera fell off of my chest and onto the ground. The camera did not capture any more video of the incident, but was able to capture audio. When we landed on the ground, my arms were still wrapped around the suspect's torso, and my chest was against his back. I was laying with my back on the concrete and the suspect was laying on top of me. Ofc. Novak was on top of the suspect, pinning him onto me.

At this time I was unable to move from my position. I could feel the suspect tensing up and resisting Ofc. Novak and I in our attempt to place him under arrest. I gave the suspect the following commands, "Stop fighting, stop resisting, stop resisting, give me your hands". I felt the suspect's arms come loose from my grip and move toward his waist band.

Since the suspect had not been searched yet, I feared that he may have been reaching for a weapon concealed in his waist band. I transitioned my arms from around the suspect's torso to a carotid control hold around the suspect's neck. I applied pressure to the suspect's carotid arteries via the carotid control hold. I held the suspect in this position until I believed him to be unconscious. The suspect stopped actively resisting, was no longer tensed up, and began snoring. At this time I deemed the suspect to be unconscious and advised Ofc. Novak "He's out, he's out, he's out, handcuff him, handcuff him, roll him onto his side, roll him onto his side." Ofc. Novak attempted to handcuff the suspect, but he regained consciousness before both handcuffs were on (see Ofc. Novak observations).

At this point both the suspect and Ofc. Novak were on top of my leg and I was unable to move. Ofc. Powell arrived on scene and assisted in attempting to take the suspect into custody (see Ofc. Powell observations). I was able to remove my leg from underneath the suspect. I got up and observed that the suspect's hands were not handcuffed together, and that there was a pair of handcuffs attached to one of his wrists.

The suspect continued to actively resist Officers and ignored our commands for him to stop. I grabbed the suspect's right arm and placed it a twist lock in an attempt to immobilize the suspect. I placed my knee into the

back of the suspect's shoulder while keeping his arm in place with a twist lock. Ofc. Novak and Ofc. Powell each assisted in pinning the suspect to the ground (see their observations). We waited until we had additional Officers on scene and then placed the suspect into handcuffs. The suspect was placed in max restraint holds to prevent him from kicking Officers.

Once the suspect was in custody I observed that I had an approx. 1" x 3" abrasion to my left knee as a result of the struggle with the suspect.

3SM4 (Sgt. Morris) requested the Fire Department to respond to our location to evaluate the suspect for any injuries as well as for the use of the carotid control hold.

3SM4 (Sgt. Morris) requested CSI to respond to our location. CSI responded and took photographs of Officer and suspect injuries.

Other Officers arrived on scene and conducted a canvas, contacting several witnesses (see other Officer supplemental reports).

I conducted a search incident to arrest of the suspect. I did not find any contraband on his person. While searching the suspect I located his wallet and handed to Ofc. Novak. Ofc. Novak ran a records check of the suspect and positively identified him as [REDACTED] (see Ofc. Novak observations).

After taking S-[REDACTED] into custody I observed that the carotid control hold had been effective due to the fact that S-[REDACTED] defecated in his pants. Based upon my training and experience of the carotid control hold, I am aware that subjects placed in that control hold have the potential to lose control of their bowels.

I conducted a search incident to arrest of S-[REDACTED] backpack and located the following:

-Cobray M-11/9mm fully automatic pistol, serial # [REDACTED]. There was an approx 9" long Cobray extended magazine inserted into the magazine well of the pistol. The magazine was loaded with an unknown amount of live 9mm rounds. In order to preserve the evidence, I did not remove the rounds from the magazine to count them. Based on my training and experience I believed the magazine to be a 30 round magazine.

-Two spiral notebooks with gang indicia inside of them.

Ofc. Lansdale #926 requested a tow truck and towed S-[REDACTED] vehicle.

Throughout the investigation of S-[REDACTED] I observed several objective signs of him being a participant in a criminal street gang. S-[REDACTED] has been arrested in the last five years for multiple gang related crimes.

On Sunday, 11/25/2018, at approx. 1820 hrs, CSO Wibbenhorst (#8109) and I, Ofc. Powell (#532), were on routine patrol in the area of South Land Park Dr/Florin Rd. We were in a marked police car and I was in full police uniform. I observed the following in summary:

CSO Wibbenhorst and I were traveling westbound on Florin Rd, approaching the South Land Park intersection. I observed a patrol vehicle traveling eastbound on Florin Rd enact an enforcement stop on a small sedan. The small sedan made a left-hand (northbound) turn into the Bel Air's parking lot (1301 Florin Rd). I overheard on the radio that the vehicle may have been associated with a pursuit from earlier and the officers were asking for an additional unit. Shortly thereafter, officers advised that the vehicle was not yielding and they were in pursuit.

CSO Wibbenhorst stopped the car and I got into the driver's seat. We responded code 3 to cover the unit in pursuit of the sedan. Per the unit, the driver had pulled into the Goodwill parking lot across the street and ran into a dead-end behind the building. We pulled up to the stop and I observed both officers were not in their patrol car. The sedan that had

fled from them was stopped in front of their patrol car, appearing empty as well.

The small parking lot behind the Goodwill is known to have a number of transients that camp out at nighttime. This evening was no exception. There was a mini-van parked next to the sedan with a MBA inside of it. I heard yelling coming from in front of the stopped cars, north of the stop. As I responded to the source of the yelling, I observed a small group of subjects camped out behind the building. They were standing at a safe distance as officers grappled with a male on the ground (later positively identified as S- [REDACTED]), but yelling at both the officers and S- [REDACTED].

I immediately ran to the officers as they struggled to place S- [REDACTED] under arrest. S- [REDACTED] was actively flailing and kicking, attempting to get avoid arrest. Ofc. Calabrese's legs were trapped under S- [REDACTED] I sat across S- [REDACTED] legs and worked to control his left hand. Ofc. Calabrese was able to extract himself from underneath S- [REDACTED] On [REDACTED] left wrist, there was a handcuff attached, but not connected to his right wrist. It was at this point that I realized that my body camera was not turned on. I reached down and activated my body camera. I overheard one of the officers attempt to advise over the radio that we were fighting with one. I did not hear the traffic go out on my channel, so I repeated the traffic on my radio.

S- [REDACTED] continued to thrash underneath us as we attempted to properly handcuff him. Ofc. Novak placed S- [REDACTED] in a carotid hold, but S- [REDACTED] fought against the hold and did not fall unconscious, as he was actively yelling at officers and the bystanders during this ordeal.

Sgt. Morris arrived on scene and assisted with placing S- [REDACTED] hand behind his back. I was able to place S- [REDACTED] into handcuffs. Once S- [REDACTED] was handcuffed, he was placed in maximum restraints and searched incident to arrest.

The fire department was called to the scene to check S- [REDACTED] I observed what appeared to be minor abrasions and redness to S- [REDACTED] upper, left side of his forehead, his right cheek, elbows, and hands. S- [REDACTED] also had dried blood on his lips from an unknown injury. He appeared to have soiled his pants, too.
