### Incident Summary

#### Summary:

The following is a summary of events based on my review of the general offense report, viewing of the officer's Body Worn Cameras, In Car Camera and from the verbal face-to-face debrief that Officer Hur gave me at the scene. On Saturday January 20th, 2018 at approximately 1953 hours Officers Juan Rodarte and Daniel Tatenko (2C31) and Officer Drake Walker (1C32) were dispatched to a disturbance at D St / 8th St. The complainant advised that there was a female standing in front of his vehicle refusing to leave. Officers responded and arrived on-scene at approximately 2000 hours. Officer Hur (1C35) responded with the above units but was not initially placed on the call.

Officer Rodarte made contact with a male and female in the driveway of [REDACTED] 8th St (later identified by officers as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] began approaching the officers patrol vehicle at which time Officer Rodarte gave repeated commands for her to stand back from the vehicle while he conducted his records checks. [REDACTED] continued to disobey commands at which time she was detained in handcuffs by Officers Hur and Rodarte. (This initial encounter can be observed on Officer Walkers BWC) Both officers noted at this time objective signs of intoxication from [REDACTED]. Officers Walker and Tatenko contacted [REDACTED] and detained him without incident.

Officer Hur led [REDACTED] to the front of Officer Rodartes UV patrol vehicle and had her lean on the driver side of the vehicle near the front tire. [REDACTED] advised Officer Hur that she wanted to sit on the "floor" instead. Officer Hur approached [REDACTED] and grabbed her left arm to assist her to the ground and placed his right hand in the middle of her back. At this time [REDACTED] appears to make a kicking motion towards officer Hur (as seen on Officer Rodartes body camera). Officer Hur advised in his report that he placed direct pressure on [REDACTED] left shoulder and spun her body in a counter-clockwise motion, pulling her off balance and taking her to the ground (consistent with what can be seen on Officer Rodartes body camera). During the take down [REDACTED] hit her nose on the asphalt causing an injury. [REDACTED] was unable to brace herself on the take down because she remained handcuffed. Officer Hur then applied a twist-lock on [REDACTED] left arm and held her on the ground. Officer Hur can be heard saying "Don't try and fucking kick me."

At this time officers observed the injury and requested fire to respond. Officers then assisted [REDACTED] back to the push bar bumper of the patrol vehicle. Officer Hur noted in his report that he observed a 1/2" vertical laceration on [REDACTED] nose which was later diagnosed by medical staff as a broken nose.

I, Sgt. Thompson arrived on-scene and spoke with Officer Hur regarding the contact. I observed that [REDACTED] was bleeding profusely from her nostrils and upper bridge of her nose. I observed a small pool of blood (approximately 3" in diameter) in the center of the roadway where [REDACTED] had struck the ground. I reviewed all four officers body worn camera video on-scene, along with the ICC systems that had been activated. Only officer Rodartes BWC captured a part of the take down of [REDACTED]

Fire Engine 14 and Medic 1 arrived on-scene and rendered first aid to [REDACTED]. Fire personnel advised that her injuries did not require an ambulance ride to the hospital so [REDACTED] was transported by Officer Hur to [REDACTED] for medical clearance. Officers Rodarte, Walker, and Tatenko conducted a neighborhood canvas and obtained statements from the original complainant and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was later released. [REDACTED] was cleared medically at [REDACTED] with a broken nose and later booked for 647(f) PC and 1203.2 PC. Enroute to jail, [REDACTED] repeatedly kicked at windows and other equipment in the back of Officers Hur's patrol vehicle.

Based on my response and review of the report, ICC Video and BWC video, I believe the use of force was justified and within the Policy of the Sacramento Police Department. The suspect was intoxicated, not obeying officer's commands, and attempted to strike an officer which led to the use of force. In compiling this after action report I noticed two issues and later discussed them with officer Hur. Officer Hur did not have his Body Worn Camera activated during his initial contact with the suspect. As such the incident was not captured on his BWC. Officer Hur and I met and discussed this issue along with reviewing GO 525.07 and specifically when the BWC requires activation. Officer Hur used profanity in his contact with the suspect stating "Don't try and fucking kick me." Officer Hur and I met and discussed community perception when officers use profanity as well as maintaining professionalism before, during, and after an incident.

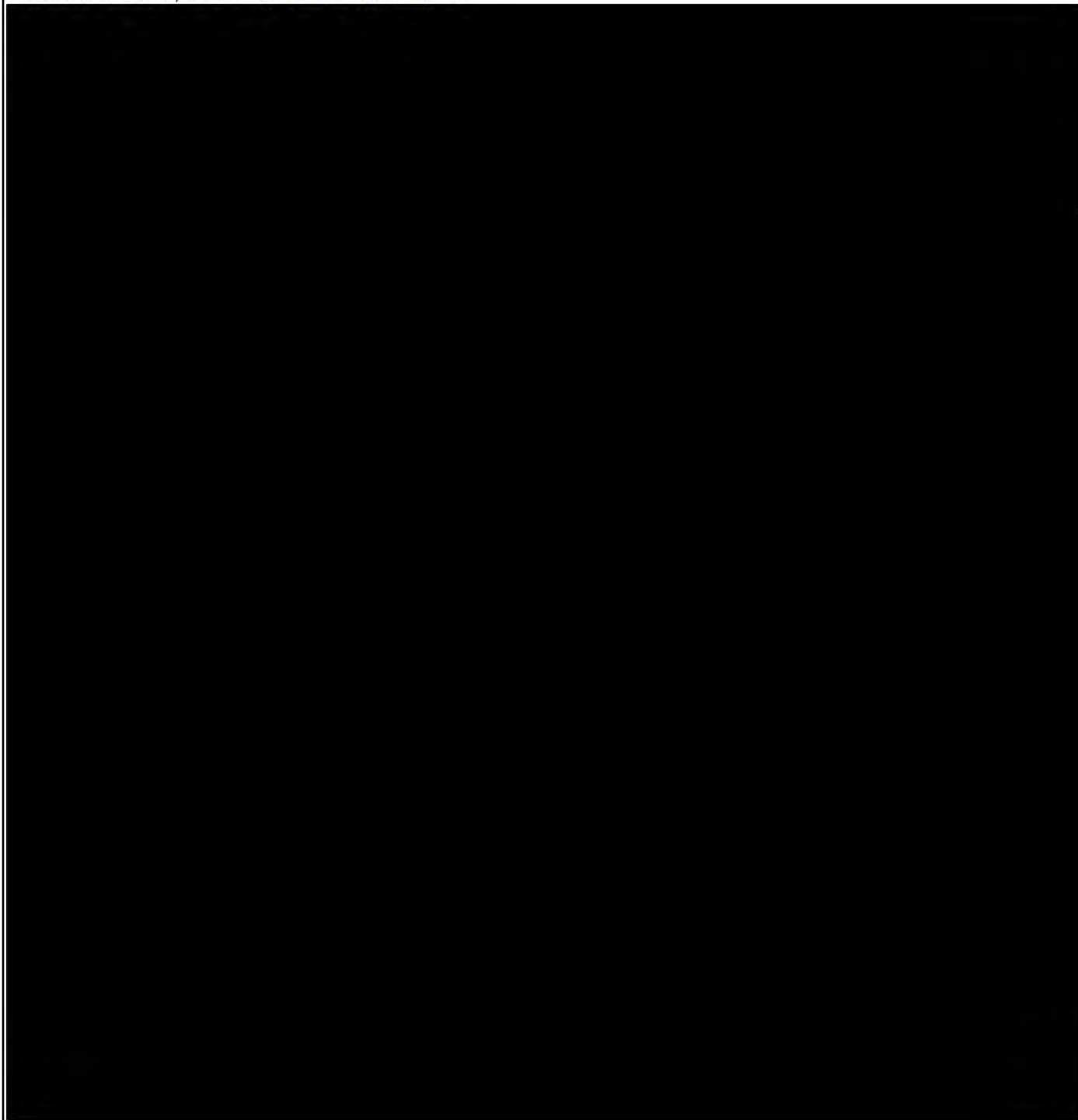

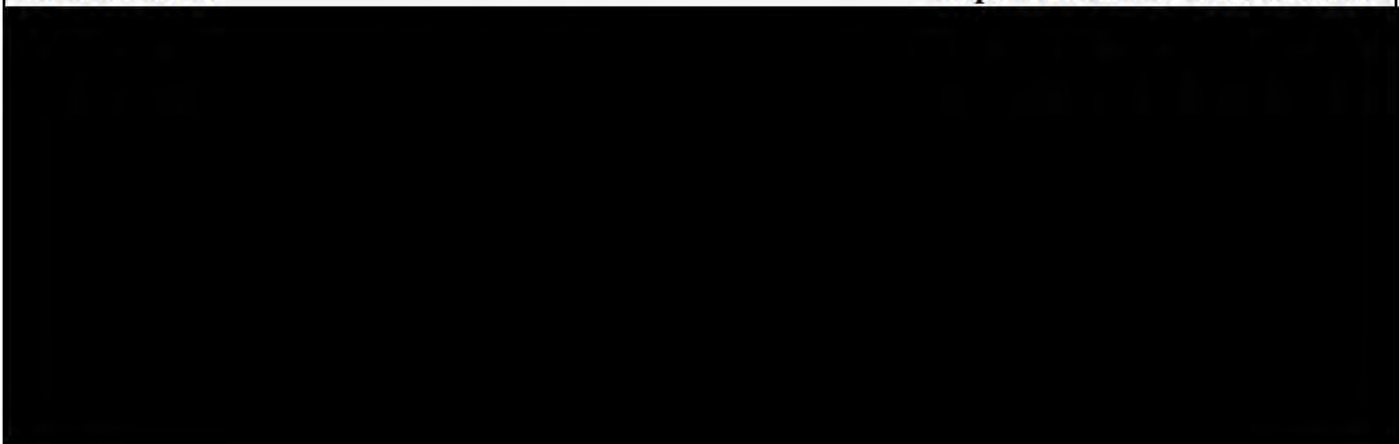

On 01-20-18 at approx. 2003 hours, I, Ofc. Hur #958 was on scene at D St/8th St with 2C31 (Ofc. Rodarte #967 and Ofc. Tatenko #959) regarding a transient female subject that was standing in front of vehicles trying to leave the area. My department issued body worn camera was functioning/recording and I observed the following in summary:

2C31 was contacting a female subject, later identified through her KPF Profile as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was not listening to 2C31 directions when she was told to stop approaching the driver's side door of 2C31's patrol vehicle. I observed [REDACTED] make what appeared to be a sudden movement towards 2C31 after repeated commands to stop approaching the patrol vehicle. Concerned for the safety of myself and 2C31, I contacted [REDACTED] and detained her in handcuffs.

When contacting [REDACTED] I observed [REDACTED] had blood shot/watery eyes and a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was emitting from her breath as she spoke.

A records check revealed that [REDACTED] is currently on I/F Probation until 08-15-18 for 273.5 PC - Domestic Violence. One of the terms of her probation was to obey all laws.

I told [REDACTED] to sit on the front push guard bumper of 2C31's patrol vehicle. [REDACTED] refused to sit down on the bumper and advised me she wanted to sit on the "floor" instead. I approached [REDACTED] to assist her to a seated position on the "floor". As I grabbed [REDACTED] left arm to assist her, [REDACTED] left leg rose off the deck. Her knee/shin made a forward pivoting kicking motion towards my stomach area.

I moved out of the way of [REDACTED] kick and grabbed her by the left upper forearm. I could feel what felt like [REDACTED] attempting to turn and face my direction. Based on my training/experience, I identified it is more difficult to control a combative subject who is in a standing position than if they are on the ground in a prone position. On 01/20/2018, at approximately 2003 hours, I (Officer Walker #835) was dispatched to D/8th St regarding a female standing in front of a persons car and refusing to move. I was in full police uniform and driving a fully marked police vehicle. My body worn camera was activated during the incident. The following are my observations in summary:

I arrived on scene at approximately 2000 hours. Officer Rodarte #967, Tatenko #959, and Hur #958 were already on scene.

All officers were seated in their patrol vehicles when I arrived. Ofc Rodarte was talking to a FBA, later identified as S-██████████. S-██████████ was standing approx 10 feet away from the front driver side door of Ofc Rodarte and Tatenko's patrol vehicle. There was a MBA, later identified as W-██████████, standing near a pile of blankets and bags on the sidewalk.

S-██████████ suddenly stepped towards Ofc Rodarte's door. Ofc Rodarte exited his patrol vehicle. Ofc Hur pulled his patrol vehicle further up the road and Ofc Hur and Tatenko also exited their patrol vehicles.

I also exited my patrol vehicle. Ofc Rodarte and Hur contacted S-██████████ Ofc Tatenko and I contacted S-██████████ S-██████████ advised he was on probation and was a registered 290 PC sex offender. I detained S-██████████ and conducted a probation search of S-██████████ I placed S-██████████ in a "standing modified" search position and conducted my search. This position placed me directly behind S-██████████ (who is approx 6-01 and 190 pounds while I stand approx 5-07 and 140 pounds) which partially obscured my view of Ofc Rodarte, Ofc Hur and S-██████████ I did not locate any contraband.

While I was conducting my search of S-██████████ I observed Ofc Hur handcuff S-██████████ and ask her to sit on the front bumper of a patrol vehicle. I later saw Ofc Hur escort S-██████████ to the ground at the front of the patrol car. Ofc Hur's radio "clipped" once and dispatched attempted to raise him over the air. Ofc Hur then put out on radio we were struggling with one subject and had her detained.

Due to S-██████████ resistance with Ofc Hur, I placed W-██████████ in a pair of handcuffs and escorted him to the back seat of my patrol vehicle without any incident.

On Saturday, 1/20/18, at approximately 1955 hours, Officer Tatenko #959 and I (Officer Rodarte #967) were dispatched to D St and 8th St regarding a transient female causing a disturbance. The notes of the call stated that a transient female was lying on the bumper of the complainant, and refusing to move. The incident was recorded on body worn/in car cameras. We arrived on scene at approximately 2003 hours.

Upon arrival, we contacted the complainant, who pointed us in the direction where the incident had occurred. Upon a search of the area we observed a female matching the description, with an adult black male sitting on a blanket in the driveway of [REDACTED] 8th Street. I also observed two open containers of alcohol.

I asked the female (later identified as [REDACTED] using county webkpf records/photo) to stand to speak to me. [REDACTED] repeatedly attempted to walk up to my car window, in spite of several commands asking her to stay back(while I ran a records check). Because of [REDACTED] repeated furtive movements we detained [REDACTED] in handcuffs. [REDACTED] exhibited objective signs of being under the influence, including: the smell of alcohol from her person, slow speech, and watery/blood shot eyes.

On 01/20/2018, at approximately 1955 hours, Ofc Rodarte #967 and I, Ofc Tatenko #959 (2C31) were dispatched to the intersection of D ST and 8th ST regarding a female subject lying on a subjects vehicle and refusing to leave. We arrived on scene at approximately 2003 hours, I observed the following in summary.

I contacted W- [REDACTED] and obtained his statement regarding the incident, he advised that the female walked away from his vehicle before we arrived.

As we drove away, I noticed a male black adult and a female black adult sitting down with sleeping bags and various other personal items in someone's driveway ([REDACTED] 8th St). The female black adult matched the description of the female that was leaning on the vehicle earlier.

We pulled up near the two subjects to contact them and conduct a records check. The female was exhibiting signs of someone under the influence of alcohol due to her slurred speech and unstable gait. Ofc Rodarte told the female to not get close to our patrol vehicle, she did not listen and continued to come closer. At this point, Officers Rodarte and Hur #958 detained the female subject.

I contacted the male subject a long with Ofc Walker #835 who arrived on scene to provide assistance. The male subject who identified himself as [REDACTED] advised that he was on probation. While contacting [REDACTED] and searching his person due to his probation status, I heard Ofc Rodarte and Ofc Hur dealing with S-[REDACTED]

At one point, I heard Ofc Hur saying something to the effect of "Do not kick me", I then look over and see Ofc Hur applying a department approved take down to S-[REDACTED] I did not see anything happen prior because I was dealing with [REDACTED] I only saw Ofc Hur taking S-[REDACTED] down by twisting his body and rotating her towards the asphalt. I did not see S-[REDACTED] kick Ofc Hur nor did I see Ofc Hur and where his body was in relation to S-[REDACTED] The only part of the event I witnessed was Ofc Hur already in motion using a department approved take down method by which Ofc Hur rotated his hips and used his hands to guide S-[REDACTED] to the ground.

My Body Warn Camera was on during the time, but did not capture the take down.
