The following is a summary of events based on my review of the general offense report, viewing of the officer's Body Worn Cameras, In Car Camera and from the verbal face-to-face debrief that Officer Hur gave me at the scene. On Saturday January 20th, 2018 at approximately 1953 hours Officers Juan Rodarte and Daniel Tatenko (2C31) and Officer Drake Walker (1C32) were dispatched to a disturbance at D St / 8th St. The complainant advised that there was a female standing in front of his vehicle refusing to leave. Officers responded and arrived on-scene at approximately 2000 hours. Officer Hur (1C35) responded with the above units but was not initially placed on the call. Officer Rodarte made contact with a male and female in the driveway of 8th St (later identified by began approaching the officers as and officers patrol vehicle at which time Officer Rodarte gave repeated commands for her to stand back from the vehicle while he conducted his records checks. continued to disobey commands at which time she was detained in handcuffs by Officers Hur and Rodarte. Officers Walker and Tatenko contacted and detained him without incident. Officer Hur led to the front of Officer Rodartes UV patrol vehicle and had her lean on the driver side of the vehicle near the front tire.

Officer Hur approached advised Officer Hur that she wanted to sit on the "floor" instead. and grabbed her left arm to assist her to the ground and placed his right At this time appears to make a kicking motion towards officer Hur hand in the middle of her back. At this time (as seen on Officer Rodartes body camera). Officer Hur advised in his report that he placed direct pressure left shoulder and spun her body in a counter-clockwise motion, pulling her off balance and taking her to the ground (consistent with what can be seen on Officer Rodartes body camera). During the take down because she remained handcuffed. Officer Hur then applied a twist-lock on left arm and held her on the ground. Officer Hur can be heard saying "Don't try and fucking kick me." At this time officers observed the injury and requested fire to respond. Officers then assisted the push bar bumper of the patrol vehicle. Officer Hur noted in his report that he observed a 1/2" vertical laceration on nose which was later diagnosed by medical staff as a broken nose. I, Sqt. Thompson arrived on-scene and spoke with Officer Hur regarding the contact. I observed that was bleeding profusely from her nostrils and upper bridge of her nose. I observed a small pool of blood (approximately 3" in diameter) in the center of the roadway where had struck the ground. I reviewed all four officers body worn camera video on-scene, along with the ICC systems that had been activated. Only officer Rodartes BWC captured a part of the take down of Fire Engine 14 and Medic 1 arrived on-scene and rendered first aid to her injuries did not require an ambulance ride to the hospital so Fire personnel advised that was transported by Officer Hur to for medical clearance. Officers Rodarte, Walker, and Tatenko conducted a neighborhood canvas and obtained statements from the original complainant and was cleared medically at with a broken nose and later booked for 647(f) PC

Based on my response and review of the report, ICC Video and BWC video, I believe the use of force was justified and within the Policy of the Sacramento Police Department. The suspect was intoxicated, not obeying officer's commands, and attempted to strike an officer which led to the use of force. In compiling this after action report I noticed two issues and later discussed them with officer Hur. Officer Hur did not have his Body Worn Camera activated during his initial contact with the suspect. As such the incident was not captured on his BWC. Officer Hur and I met and discussed this issue along with reviewing GO 525.07 and specifically when the BWC requires activation. Officer Hur used profanity in his contact with the suspect stating "Don't try and fucking kick me." Officer Hur and I met and discussed community perception when officers use profanity as well as maintaining professionalism before, during, and after an incident.
