Incident Summary

I reviewed all related reports and Body Worn Camera footage of the UOF incident. Lt. Chan and I were also present when UOF occurred. Overwhelming less lethal was authorized. I believe the overwhelming use of UOF was justified and consistent within SPD policy for a 245 suspect with a knife, who refused to comply after hours of communicating (with no progress) with CNT. This subject also displayed symptoms associated with drug induced behavior and mental health.

On 10/01/2019 I, (Officer Korzeniewski #783) contacted Witness [REDACTED] at Front St / L St at approximately 0700 hours. I obtained his statement in summary. My body worn camera was activated during the course of my investigation.

I was leaf blowing by the 2 Grand Saloon (200 K Street) and then I turned around towards the Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory (1039 2nd Street). While facing the Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory, a white male wearing all black ran towards me with a knife. This man aslo had a thin build, short brown hair, and was wearing a baggy zip up sweat shirt. I turned up the power on my leave blower and began to spray him in the face with air. The white male kept approaching me with the knife. Then he began to circle around me.

In order to protect myself I, removed the leave blower from my back and swung it at the man with the knife. I also used the leaf blower as a shield. The man did not want to approach me when I had the leaf blower in my hand. Everything was happening so fast I can't remember if he swung the knife at me. The man with the knife began to walk away from me, but as he did he was yelling and cursing at me.

When I felt that it was safe to do so I used my work radio and called for help. A white van started to drive towards me. I ran up to the van and I told the driver what happened. I pointed to the man with the knife. The man was not close to me or the van at that point. I asked the driver if she would stay with me because I did not feel safe. As I was talking to the driver the man with the knife walked away some where and I could no longer see him.

While I was waiting with the van a couple of random pedestrians came walking up from the tunnel in "Old Sac." When I was no longer alone I, felt safe again. My coworkers met up with me and called the police. The lady in the van drove off. I do not know her, so I did not get any of her contact information. I did not get the contact information from the people who were walking through the tunnel either.

The knife was approximately 6 inches long with a silver blade. I was scared for my life. I feel that I could recognize him if I saw him again. I would

On 10/01/2019 I, (Officer Korzeniewski #783) was dispatched to Front St and L Street at approximately 0651 hours. Per the text of the call I was responding to a suspect who is running around with a knife. The same suspect also used the knife to threaten someone. Notes on the call advised that the suspect was a thin white male adult with short brown hair, all black clothing, and a baggy sweater. I arrived on scene at approximately 0700 hours. I observed the following in summary. My body worn camera was activated during the course of my investigation.

When I arrived on scene I contacted Victim [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and obtained his statement (See Victim Statement). (1B35) Officer Baker #756 advised over a radio broadcast that she has located the suspect at the docks. I acknowledged Officer Baker's #756 message and met up with her at the docks. The location I met Officer Baker #756 was by 1210 Front Street (Joe's Crab Shack). (1B33) Officer Jennings #269 accompanied Officer Baker #756 and myself at the docks.

While at the upper portion of the walk way that leads to the docks I, observed a white male that matched the suspect description. The suspect was near the bottom of the walk way. The walk way to the to the river is a multi level structure with approximately 5 foot high hands rails. The hand rails contain the pedestrian to only travel up and down the walk way.

Officer Baker #756, Officer Jennings ##269 , and I proceeded down the walk way to the suspect. Officers were on the second to last straight away before the walk way made a 90 degree turn to that lead to the water front of the dock. Officers gave the suspect verbal commands and the suspect would not obey them. The suspect began to advance towards officers holding what appeared to be a box cutter in his left hand. The suspect continued to disobey the officers commands and proceeded towards them. Officer Jennings #269 fired two "Bean Bag" rounds at the suspect (Refer to Officer Jennings #269 Supplemental Report).

After being struck, the suspect sat in the corner of the walk way. Officers told the suspect to drop the box cutter and comply with the commands given. The suspect would not listen to commands and continued to sit in the corner. The officers on scene had multiple weapon systems pointed at the suspect to include lethal, less lethal shotgun, and a conducted energy



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device ("Tazer"). The suspect would not provide his name to officers on scene. The suspect placed the suspected box cutter inside his front left jacket pocket.

As the suspect sat in the corner of the walk way. The Crisis Negotiation Team, SPD K9, Sac PD Marine Unit, State Park Ranger, and Sac Fire were requested at the scene. Multiple officers from various units tried to gain verbal compliance with the suspect. The suspect would not listen. The suspect would yell, curse, and spit at officers on scene. Officer Glynn #821 took a photo of the suspect and sent it to the Sac PD Mental Health Unit (Refer to Officer Glynn's #821 Supplemental Report). The SPD Mental Health Unit used face recognition technology and identified the suspect as [REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED]. Officers used Web KPF to confirm the suspects identity. Suspect [REDACTED] was on informal searchable probation until 10/09/21 for 148(A)(1) PC (Resisting Arrest). Suspect [REDACTED]'s probation status was confirmed by using Web KPF.

Suspect [REDACTED] made a comment about jumping into the river. I was instructed by (PEER1) Sergeant Chesterman to leave my position as the lethal force option on the contact team 1. I was told to meet up with the Sac Fire Boat Unit. My task while working with the Sac Fire Boat unit was to recover the suspect if he jumped into the water. My boat assignment removed me from the main scene to approximately 200 feet south of it. While waiting with the Sac Fire Boat Unit, from approximately 200 feet away. I saw officers use overwhelming less lethal force on the Suspect [REDACTED] Suspect [REDACTED] fell to the ground and multiple officers held him down, searched him, and placed him in handcuffs.

After the Suspect [REDACTED] was in hand cuffs I approached the scene. One of the arrest team officers located an approximate 6 inch silver fixed blade knife that was concealed on his person.

Suspect [REDACTED] was transported to the UC Davis Medical Center by Sac Fire. Suspect [REDACTED] sustained multiple injuries from the less lethal weapon systems. CSI arrived on scene to photograph the evidence. I collected the spent "Bean Bags" from the less lethal shotgun, the "Tazer" doors, spent 40mm case, and the colored paper circles from the spent "Tazer" cartridge.

Victim [REDACTED] returned to the scene after the suspect was taken away by ambulance. I asked Victim [REDACTED] some questions to clarify his statement. I also asked Victim [REDACTED] if he would be willing to do an In Field Show-up. Victim [REDACTED] agreed to do the show up.

I told Victim [REDACTED] to meet me at the UCD Medical Center to do the



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field show up. At the hospital I read to Victim [REDACTED] verbatim my issued SPD 605 (Field Show-up Admonishment Card). Victim [REDACTED] agreed to understanding the instructions given to him. Victim [REDACTED] was brought to the hospital room where Suspect [REDACTED] was staying. Victim [REDACTED] took an up close view of Suspect [REDACTED] Victim [REDACTED] believed that Suspect [REDACTED] was the man who earlier attacked him with a knife (See Victim Statement).

Suspect [REDACTED] had to stay at the hospital for multiple hours because of the injuries he sustained. Suspect [REDACTED]'s injuries also included a broken arm. While awaiting medical treatment Suspect [REDACTED] was still aggressive towards officers. Officers on scene had to used "Max Restraints" on Suspect [REDACTED] due to his uncooperative and violent behavior. While I was going to use my "Max Restraints" on Suspect [REDACTED] he, spit on me (Officer Korzeniewski #783). The spit ended up landing on my lip and mouth. A "spit mask" was used on Suspect [REDACTED] to prevent further spitting. Multiple officers had to be present to transport Suspect [REDACTED] from his hospital room to a patrol car.

Suspect [REDACTED] was transported to The Sacramento County Main Jail. At the "Sally Port" in the jail multiple deputies where awaiting his arrival as a precautionary measure do to his violent behavior. Suspect [REDACTED] was arrested and booked for assault with deadly weapon, possession of a concealed dirk or dagger, resisting arrest, and probation violation (245(A)(1) PC, 21310 PC, Two Counts of 148(A)(1) PC, and 1203.2 PC.).

I booked the spent less lethal ammunition as evidence at property. Suspect [REDACTED]'s personal property was booked at property for safe keeping. I completed a SPD Red Boarder form and First Report of Injury form. I called Victim [REDACTED] to ask additional questions about the report.

This call for service required support from multiple officers on scene. The reference of numerous supplemental reports is advised. The list of Officers that responded to he scene can be referenced by using SPD Call # 19-319300.

On 10-1-2019 at approx. 0652 hours, Ofc. Korzeniewski and I responded to 2nd and K Street regarding a subject that had just threatened a city worker with a knife. We were hailed by the worker who stated that the male, white with a black jacket and black pants, ran south to L Street and then went towards Joe's Crab Shack. Officers arrived onscene and searched the area for the subject.

Officer Jennings raised us over the air and stated that the subject was down on the docks by the river. Officer Korzeniewski and I responded to Joe's Crab Shack and met up with Officer Jennings and Officer Baker.

We looked down toward the dock on the rivers edge and observed a subejct dressed in all black clothing, that matched the description of the suspect. We went down the ramp to the dock and contacted the subject. The subject was verbally aggressive towards us and refused to give us his name. We attempted to talk with the subject and he would talk with us but he didn't make any sense and he seemed to ramble during the entire encounter.

We requested additional units to respond to assist. I observed, what appeared to be a box cutter type of instrument in his left hand. The subject refused to show us what was in his hand and he refused to follow commands that were being given.

The subject became increasingly aggressive and started to walk towards Officer Jennings, Baker and Korzeniewski. Officer Jennings deployed the bean bag shotgun at the subject, striking him in the upper torso. The subject refused to follow commands and sat down on the ground in the corner of the walkway. I attempted to talk to the subject and try to get his name. The subject refused to give his name and he continued to speak in a very confused manner.

Additional units arrived as well as our CNT officers.

Lt. Chan was on scene and he gave the command that when the subject lit a cigarette, then we would deploy less lethal weapons at him. I had my CED deployed and I realized that the battery was at about half power. I took Officer Kimble's CED (serial # xoo-567724) and had it at the ready to deploy with less lethal force. I was positioned about 15 feet away from



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the subject on a raised platform of the dock. I had a red bead on the subjects chest and I observed a clear shot with nothing blocking my CED probes line of travel.

The subject lit the cigarette and I heard the bean bag shotgun round fire. I deployed the CED to the center mass of the subject as the arrest team made their way up to detain the subject. I ran the CED through a full 5 second cycle and when it was complete, I removed the CED cartridge from the Taser as the probes were still on the subject.

I threw the CED cartridge to the ground as officers were taking the subject into custody.

I rode in the ambulance with the subject ([REDACTED]) to the UCD Medical Center.

On 10/01/2019 at approx. 1000 hours I, Ofc. Robinet 520, met with witness [REDACTED] [REDACTED] inside the "Joe's Crab Shack" at 1210 Front St. and obtained his statement. He stated the following in summary.

I saw the whole event, from the time the first group of four officers contacted him on the ramp to the time all the officers took him into custody.

Other than hearing the guy ([REDACTED] yell and scream, you couldn't really hear much from inside the restaurant. From the outside patio, I could hear the guy yelling crazy stuff and could see how he was being aggressive with you guys. You could definitely hear him yelling "fuck you" a lot. I couldn't hear what you guys were saying to him. I could also see how he was smoking something that looked like marijuana from the way he was packing the pipe.

On Tuesday, 10-1-19 at approx 0738 hrs I, Ofc Duink (BIK3) along with Ofc Martinez (BIK2) were requested by Sgt Bui (BIK10) to respond to the area of Old Sacramento to assist with a combative subject who was on the docks. Ofc Martinez and I arrived in Old Sacramento at approx 0749 hrs.

Upon arrival we activated our body worn cameras. I made contact with Sgt Bui at the dock entrance between the Rio City Cafe and Joe's Crab Shack. She advised me that a subject was on the docks who was wanted for an assault with a deadly weapon. I was requested due to my training with the Crisis Negotiation Team (CNT).

I walked down the catwalk for the docks to the river level and met up with Ofc Schwertfeger who is also on the CNT team. He was standing on the metal catwalk looking down approx 6 feet to bottom level of the dock. On the bottom level was a MWA wearing all black clothing including a heavy jacket, hood, and some sort of harness. The MWA was cornered at a portion of the dock that was surrounded by water. Two arrest/ contact teams were positioned along the dock nearby. The MWA was in a sitting position.

Ofc Schwertfeger and I attempted to talk to the MWA for several minutes without getting much response. When the MWA did respond he was angry and made comments about going to hell and burning. His demeanor was angry and

his words were vulgar and full of racial expletives. Ofc Schwertfeger and I were able to communicate with the MWA who someone identified as [REDACTED]

Our communications with [REDACTED] varied. [REDACTED] did not appear to like Ofc Schwertfeger, but he would talk to me. His demeanor would change rapidly and he would start yelling nonsense at us and ordering us to do things while he stated that he was god. [REDACTED] was now in a standing position and would yell and spit at us often. It appeared that he was either in mental crisis or under the influence of a controlled substance or both. [REDACTED] would often pull out a pair of lighters and small metal pipe and smoke from it. The pipe appeared to be similar to a marijuana pipe, but it was unknown what he was smoking from it. Ofc Schwertfeger was relieved by Ofc Gomez, who was also unsuccessful with getting [REDACTED] to cooperate.

After attempting to talk with [REDACTED] for a long period of time (estimated to be an hour) it was apparent that there was no chance of having a rational conversation with him. Attempts to have him surrender and cooperate with the police department were unsuccessful. I advised him numerous times that he needed to cooperate with the police department and that we were trying to help him and he was going to have to go with us.

Finally Lt. Chan and Sgt Chesterman told me to toss down a cigarette and lighter to [REDACTED] so that he would be distracted and the arrest would be effected. I threw down the cigarette and lighter. When [REDACTED] picked them up several less-lethal devices were used to overwhelm [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was handcuffed and my interactions with him were completed.

On 10/1/19, I Ofc Martinez #400 was on duty as a fully marked bike unit, BIK2, working with Ofc Duink, BIK3. At approximately 0717 hrs, we responded from 300 Richards Bl to the area of Front and L St regarding a subject with a knife.

We walked just north of Joe's Crab shack at 1210 Front St, via a metal walkway that descended to the river. Sgt Bui (BIK10) and Sgt Basquez (2SM3) were on the upper part of the walkway, and there were numerous SPD officers at the bottom of the walkway area, standing near a subject sitting near a corner of the walkway, wearing black clothing.

Ofc Duink walked down to the other officers, and I stayed momentarily with Sgt Bui. I heard officers on scene advise there was a good 245 PC want on the suspect. Sgt K. Vu walked to the upper part of the walkway, and had a pepperball gun on his person. Sgt Vu handed me the pepperball gun, and asked me to assist SPD officers at the bottom of the walkway.

I walked down the metal walkway, to where Ofc Duink was located. Ofc Duink was speaking to the male subject dressed in black. I recognized the male as I had a few previous contacts with him near I St and 2nd St. The male white was later positively identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

Ofc Beth Glynn (1B31) was standing near Ofc Duink. Ofc Glynn asked me to stand with a second group of officers that were standing at the very bottom of the metal walkway.

I walked over a metal railing as there was a locked gate, and I continued to the second group of officers. I stood by Ofc Castro (GRN35) who was holding a black "POLICE" shield, and Ofc Robinet and Ofc Bret Meyer (2B34).

I stood to the right side of Ofc Castro, and stood by with the pepperball gun.

Sgt Basquez advised officers on scene that they could use less lethal force should [REDACTED] charge officers. With that in mind, I kept the pepperball gun either pointed down, or at [REDACTED] for the both the protection of officers on scene, and to affect an arrest if needed.

[REDACTED] continued to yell at officers, and cuss as he sat and stood in the same corner area of the metal walkway for the duration of time that I was on scene.

After officers on scene were trying to de-escalate the situation with [REDACTED] for a very long time with no sign of [REDACTED] obeying officers commands, I received word from the other officers that a K9 dog was coming on scene.

The K9 unit came on scene, and [REDACTED] still did not listen to officers and surrender peacefully.

I heard officers communicate that they would officers would offer [REDACTED] a cigarette, and that less lethal force would be used at that time so that [REDACTED] could be arrested.

I stood by with Officers Meyer, Robinet, and Castro, and walked a few feet closer to [REDACTED] Officers threw a cigarette and a lighter towards [REDACTED] before officers used a taser and a 40 MM on [REDACTED] At that time, I shot two pepperball rounds at [REDACTED]'s feet, to assist in affecting the arrest, and for the safety of officers on scene.

Several officers ran to [REDACTED] and placed [REDACTED] in handcuffs. I stood by with the pepperball gun as officers detained [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was placed onto an SFD gurney by officers and SFD firemen.

On 10/1/2019 at 0744hrs, I Sgt R Chesterman was advised by dispatch that Officers working in the Old Sac area where needing assistant from any on duty negotiators.

I advised the dispatch over the radio to please put me on the call that I was enroute. I have worked as a negotiator for over 10 years. As I was enroute to the call I began calling other negotiators and asking them to respond to the call.

I then called Sgt M Basquez who was the downtown Sergeant and ask him what kind of a call he had that he needed negotiators for. Sgt Basquez he said had a possible 5150 person who was armed with a knife and had a fresh PC want for assault with a deadly weapon (245 A-1 PC). Basquez further stated that the suspect (later identified as [REDACTED] was down on the boat dock area along the Sacramento River just below Joe's Crab Shack. Basquez said that Officer Schwertferger was currently trying to negotiate with [REDACTED] Schwertferger is a trained negotiator.

At 0804hrs, I arrived onscene. I activated my body worn camera. I made contact with Sgt Basquez and Lt Chan. I then made contact with Schwertferger to see how the negotiations were going. While I was speaking with Schwertferger [REDACTED] kept talking but whatever he was saying made no sense.

At one point during the negotiations [REDACTED] ask for a Sprite. We got some Sprite but he refused to drink it because he thought we were trying to poison him. [REDACTED] looked at Officer Duink and said "you drink that, you guys are going to poison me". Officer Duink took a drink of the Sprite to try and show [REDACTED] that it was not poisoned but he still would not drink it.

We continued to try and negotiate with [REDACTED] but it was to no avail. A little later on during the negotiations [REDACTED] indicated he wanted a cigarette. We as a negotiations team carry cigarettes with us. So we got the cigarettes and showed them to [REDACTED]. He demanded a cigarette. Knowing that [REDACTED] was armed with a knife we told him the only way he was getting that cigarette was to prone himself out so we could take him into custody, then he could have his cigarette. [REDACTED] refused to cooperate. We even tried lighting a cigarette in front of [REDACTED] and letting it burn. We had hoped this would encourage him to surrender.

[REDACTED] continued to talk in circles and we could not make any inroads with him at all.

I advised Lt Chan that we were not getting anywhere with [REDACTED] after over two hours of trying to negotiate with him.

Lt Chan then came up with the plan of having our negotiators give [REDACTED] a cigarette and a lighter. The plan was to deploy less than lethal weapons towards him while he was lighting the cigarette. Lt Chan said that if [REDACTED] is using two hands to light the cigarette we will know he does not have a weapon in his hands.

This conversation took place on the walk way above [REDACTED]'s location. I told Chan that I would go down and tell the negotiators the plan and I would also tell both contact team that were on the dock as well.

[REDACTED] was standing in the corner of the dock area that had a three foot high railing behind him so he could not fall into the water.

We also had a SFD boat in the water as well as the Police departments boat just in case [REDACTED] was to jump into the water.

After I had given both contact teams and the negotiators the plan, Lt Chan who had come down to the same level of the dock that [REDACTED] was on told me to give [REDACTED] the cigarette. I direct the Negotiating Officers to give [REDACTED] the lighter and cigarette. I then walked over next to the two contact teams. As soon as Chan saw [REDACTED] trying to light the cigarette he looked at me and said "now". I directed both contact teams to deploy their less than lethal weapons. As the less than lethal weapons were deployed [REDACTED] immediately went to the ground and he was taken into custody without any further incidents.

SFD then brought their gurney down to the level that we were on and loaded [REDACTED] onto the gurney so he could be transported to the hospital.

I made contact with Officer Glynn on 2nd St / L St, who advised that the subject armed with the knife was described as a male, white, adult, dressed all in black and was last seen heading westbound on L St, toward Joe's Crab Shack (1210 Front St).

While searching for the subject in the area on Front St/ L St, a truck driver for Challenge Butter advised that a subject was down by the dock and

I deployed my taser and Officer Jennings deployed the less-lethal bean bag shotgun. The subject talked non-sensically and acted quite angry. He cursed at officers on a continuum and refused to comply with directed commands to drop the weapon in his hand. He remained in his position on the dock.

We maintained our position on the dock as the suspect remained at the end of the dock, where it had a downward bend in the ramp that went to the water level.

Officer Korzeniewski, advised that the crime elements for 245 PC/Assault with a Deadly Weapon - Non-Firearm, were present.

I requested any CNT resources as our attempts to gain compliance with the suspect were unsuccessful. I requested any SPD/SFD boats that may have been in the water to respond to our location, as the suspect made comments about jumping into the river.

Additional officers were requested to assist.

While standing by for additional officers, the suspect yelled out hostilities and took steps toward the dock ramp leading toward me, Officer Jennings, and Officer Korzeniewski, still armed with the weapon in his left hand. Based on the distance between me and the suspect, who was still approx. 40-50' away, a taser force option was not viable for me to discharge.



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Officer Jennings immediately discharged two less-lethal bean bag rounds and the suspect appeared stunned and fell to the ground temporarily. I observed redness to the front of his bare chest, where it was apparent that one of the bean bag rounds had struck him. He was wearing a velcro-style black wrap around his waist. The wrap had straps that criss-crossed on the upper portion and over his shoulders under his jacket. He was bare chested under the wrap. Over that, the suspect wore a black jacket that was not closed in the front and a vest-type garment over the jacket, he was also wearing black pants, and black/white tennis shoes. After the discharge of the less-lethal bean bag rounds, they were ultimately ineffective, as the suspect still, would not comply with commands to drop the weapon and get on the ground. He stood back up.

A continuing dialogue was maintained with the suspect as we awaited further officers to respond onscene.

I provided updates via radio.

The suspect continued to ramble hostilities toward officers, did not comply with further commands, and eventually put the weapon (possible box cutter) in his left jacket pocket.

The suspect retrieved a smoking pipe and lighters from his pockets and began to smoke whatever was loaded in the small metal pipe. He spit many times toward officers as well as in the area around him on the dock. As he moved in his position on the dock, I observed a long sheath protruding from under his jacket on his right rear waist area. I could not see if there was a knife in the sheath.

Sgt. (Basquez/3146-2SM3) arrived onscene.

After CNT officers arrived and engaged in a lengthy attempt to gain compliance from the suspect to get on the ground for safe handcuffing, again, the suspect did not comply. He sat down and stood up on occasion, and would yell out loudly toward the CNT officers, and others onscene. The suspect spit toward several officers many times.

Other officers arrived onscene to assist. Continued efforts to gain physical compliance by the use of direct commands to the suspect met with negative results.

Officer (Ray/766-2PL3) arrived onscene and provided me with an SPD less-lethal, 40mm impact round weapon, that I was trained to operate.



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After continued negotiations with the suspect to comply failed, the Game Plan order was provided to me via Sgt (Chesterman/3088-PEER1).

At the time the suspect was to be provided a cigarette, and made an overt effort to light the cigarette, the order was to deploy overwhelming less-lethal weapon's systems in attempts to safely detain/search the suspect.

The suspect was provided a cigarette by a CNT officer and began to light the cigarette, at which time I discharged one 40mm impact round to his upper body, as other officers discharged their less lethal systems. The suspect fell to the ground, at which time officers safely approached and disarmed the suspect of a knife, and safely handcuffed him without further incident.

I observed a silver colored fixed blade knife that was retrieved from the suspect during the active detention.

SFD personnel who were standing by during this incident, responded to the area where the suspect was taken into custody and rendered any possible medical needs.

The incident was concluded and I had no further responsibilities on this call.

On 10-01-19 at approx. 0821 hours, I arrived to 1210 Front Street (dock area below Joe's Crab Shack) to a call in progress where officers were in a standoff with a suspect who had made threats to people with a knife. My body worn camera was activated upon arrival.

I was directed to take a position on the dock ramp with other officers and be part of an arrest team. Upon my arrival, negotiators had been talking to the suspect for a while and he appeared defiant by yelling often nonsense at them. See their observations for details.

I was assigned to be a the "Lethal" part of the arrest team (Team #1), there were 2 arrest teams formed, meaning I was to have my pistol at the ready. This is a part of an arrest team due to other officers having other less lethal options out and may be at a disadvantage if the suspect came suddenly at us with a knife.

After a while of negotiations not working at approx 0935 hours; due to the suspect's mental state, the plan to give the suspect a cigarette and overwhelm him with less lethal was passed along those of us who were on the arrest teams. The less lethal options were to stun the subject as he lit

his cigarette.

I holstered my weapon and transitioned to be "hands" along with Detective Freeman who was beside me.

Officers fired bean bag rounds, CED, 40mm and pepper ball at the suspect. The less lethal options were effective and the suspect turned toward the railing of the dock ramp and yelled in pain away from us. I approached him from behind, pulled him to the ground and placed his right hand into a twist lock. Det Freeman took control of his left arm. I placed him in handcuffs and assisted with handing him over to firemen when they arrived.

On 10/01/19 at approximately 0800 hours Det. Mayden and I (Det. Freeman #934) were dispatched to the area of Front Street and L Street to assist with crisis negotiations as Det. Mayden is currently assigned as a crisis negotiator. I observed the following in summary:

We responded code 3 to the scene and activated my body worn camera. Det. Mayden assisted with crisis negotiations while I was assigned to a contact team in the event the suspect (██████████) was to be arrested.

I received information from Sgt. Chesterman that ██████████ had a knife concealed in his right pocket, was wanted for violation of 245 PC and would be arrested.

I stood on the ramp leading from the waters edge up to Old Sacramento along with 5 other officers. My assignment on the team was to be "hands on" and I did not activate or use any less lethal equipment. I observed ██████████ to be acting very erratic and angry throughout the incident. A second contact team was positioned on the lower ramp to prevent ██████████ from fleeing.

While negotiators spoke with ██████████ I observed him to be wearing some kind

of harness under his clothing which appeared to have a hard plastic sheath attached to it. [REDACTED] was resistive to negotiators and did not comply with any of the instructions given.

After more than an hour of negotiation Sgt. Chesterman advised that the negotiation team did not feel they were making progress. Sgt. Chesterman advised officers would use overwhelming less lethal force to detain and disarm [REDACTED]

After a command was given officers on both contact teams used less lethal force to prevent [REDACTED] from fighting or fleeing. I approached [REDACTED] took hold of his left arm, and assisted in bringing him to the ground. I used control holds to assist in placing [REDACTED] in handcuffs.

After [REDACTED] was successfully detained I assisted officers in conducting a search of his person and observed a fixed blade "pearing" style kitchen knife which was removed from one of his pockets. I noted the harness I observed earlier was actually some kind of back brace.

I assisted in lifting [REDACTED] off the ground and placing him on a medical gurney so he could be transported to a hospital. Once [REDACTED] was removed from the scene Lt. Chan gave the order for all body worn cameras to be deactivated. I deactivated my body worn camera and took no further actions.

On 10-1-2019, approx. 0650 hours I responded to the area of Front St/L St regarding a subject threatening the caller with a knife. Upon arrival 1B31 (Ofc. Korzeniewski) advised that the subject was last seen heading towards "Joe's Crabshack". My Body Camera was on and recording. I began to check the Old Sacramento area for the subject with negative results. Approx. 0710 hours Myself and Ofc. Baker were hailed down by a delivery truck driver in a Challenge Butter truck (not identified). The driver advised us that the subject we were probably looking for had walked down the boat docks below "Joe's Crabshack". The driver also told us "Good Luck" as the subject was acting crazy or high.

Ofc. Korzeniewski and Ofc. Glenn joined us at 1210 Front Street in an attempt to make contact with the subject. They advised us that it was a good brandishing of a knife and attempt AWDW. Because the subject appeared to be acting irrational and agitated (per witnesses) I brought the less than lethal shotgun for the contact.

At approx. 0717 hours we located the subject at the end of the boat docks below Joe's Crab Shack. He was acting extremely agitated and had what appeared to be a silver knife or box cutter in his left hand. We

immediately began giving him commands to drop the knife which he ignored. He continued cursing and acting irrational and agitated.

The subject continued yelling and began coming towards us up the ramp disregarding orders to stop and get on the ground. I deployed two rounds from the less than lethal shotgun striking the subject in the chest with both rounds. The subject began yelling and screaming as he fell to the ground bent over. Due to the subject still having the knife we did not approach but continued to give voice commands. Eventually the subject put the knife in his left front jacket pocket but refused to put the knife on the ground.

Sgt Basquez, Sgt Vu and Lt. Chan responded to the scene. HNT officers also responded and attempted to negotiate with the subject. After hours of negotiating we were told to deploy less than lethal including shotgun, 40MM, taser and pepperball. The subject was struck numerous times (including two more less than lethal shotgun rounds) which allowed officers to move in and take the subject into custody. SFD transported the subject to Sutter for treatment.
