Comments: After reviewing the dispatch audio recording, reading the report and CAD calls and reviewing pertinent ICC and BWC, I find the Level 2 UOF was justified and within policy.	
Of note: 1. There was some delay in putting the suspect into handcuffs after he was rendered unconscious by the carotid, instead Ofc. Del Dotto continued to lay on the suspect until additional officers arrived. 2. Ofc. Del Dotto's BWC clip was knocked from his BWC and turned off during the struggle.	
Ofc. Del Dotto will be attending CPT during April and will benefit from the carotid refresher training.

In my opinion, there was justification for rear handcuffing to be reasonably delayed as the officers ascertained if the handgun was in suspect's back-pocket. Placing suspect in a rear handcuffing position too soon may have given his hands access to a gun.

On 01-10-2020 at approximately 0259 hours, Officer Del Dotto #992 and I, Officer Maclean #1010, were conducting patrol in the area of Arcade Blvd / Marysville Blvd. Officer Del Dotto and I were in driving a marked SPD patrol car with overhead emergency lights. We were also wearing full SPD uniform. Our body worn cameras and in car cameras were activated during this call.

I observed a Blue Scion 4 door vehicle (██████████) driving southbound on Marysville Blvd. The vehicle had a blue 2019 registration sticker, leading me to believe that the registration on the vehicle was expired. Officer Del Dotto conducted a records check of the vehicle which showed that the vehicle's registration expired on 09-22-19 and was suspended on 4-11-2019 in violation of 4000a VC. The vehicle crossed from the number 2 straight lane of southbound Marysville Blvd into the left turn lane in violation of 22107 VC. The vehicle then crossed the limit line before coming to a stop of the eastbound turn lane of southbound Marysville Blvd while the light was red in violation of 21453 VC.

I activated our overhead emergency lights to conduct an enforcement stop for the above violations.

The Scion stopped just east of Marysville Blvd on Arcade Blvd.

I contacted the driver of the vehicle, later identified via WebKPF photograph as ██████████.

Officer Del Dotto contacted the passenger of the vehicle, later identified as ██████████. (See Officer Del Dotto's observations for further)

██████████ was advised for the reason for the stop. When asked if there as any marijuana in the vehicle, ██████████ advised that there was 1 bud of marijuana in a medicine bottle. I asked ██████████ if he could hand me the marijuana. I opened the bottle and observed 1 bud of marijuana.

Officer Del Dotto also located a bottle of unlabeled narcotic pills in ██████████'s possession during a consent search of ██████████'s backpack. The narcotic pills were later found to be 17 Hydrocodone pills.

Due to the unlawful possession of narcotic pills and █████'s consent of the vehicle I asked █████ to step out of the vehicle so a search could be conducted.

I conducted a terry pat search for weapons of █████ with negative results.

I asked █████ to sit on the front of my patrol car and was advised that he could smoke a cigarette.

Officer Del Dotto had █████ step out of the vehicle. When █████ stepped out of the vehicle and twisted his torso to the right to get out of the Scion I observed the hand grip of a silver revolver slightly protruding from his left rear pants pocket.

I gave █████ a command to sit on the curb and walked to the passenger side of the Scion to assist Officer Del Dotto in detaining █████ in handcuffs.

I took control of █████'s left arm while Officer Del Dotto took control of █████'s right arm. As soon as I took control of █████'s left arm he began to tense up the muscles in his arm making it difficult for me to continue to move █████'s left arm into a control hold position.

████ then immediately began to pull his arm forward toward his chest. █████ then spun his body to the right and broke free from Officer Del Dotto's and my control hold.

████ began to run southbound into the front yard of █████ Arcade Blvd.

I advised SPD dispatch that we had a subject fleeing from officers with a handgun.

In the most southern part of the driveway of █████ Arcade Blvd in front of a parked vehicle Officer Del Dotto and I struggled with █████ and █████ and I fell onto the front steps of █████ Arcade Blvd, causing injury to my right knee.

I turned and grabbed █████ by the legs causing him to fall. █████ then got back up and attempted to run again. I grabbed █████ by the sweatshirt which █████ removed in order to continue to flee.

██████ was on his hands and knees still trying to get up.

At this point I had given ██████ no less than 5 commands to get on the ground and no less than 3 commands to stop resisting.

Knowing that ██████ was armed with a handgun and due to ██████ actively resisting officers, I began to fear for my life and the life of my partner. I believed that if ██████ was not immediately detained he would be able to gain access to the handgun in his pocket and shoot Officer Del Dotto or myself.

I conducted approximately 5-10 pugilistic hand strikes to the right side of ██████'s head and face. The pugilistic strikes were not effective and ██████ still continued to actively resist officers. While conducting the pugilistic hand strikes I continuously gave ██████ commands to stop resisting.

I was able to get my left arm into a a position for a carotid restraint control hold. I applied the carotid restraint control hold and once I felt ██████ no longer actively resisting, leading me to believe that ██████ had lost consciousness, I released the carotid restraint control hold. I brought his right arm backward to the small of his back so he could be detained in handcuffs.

At this point numerous additional officer arrived on scene and were able to assist in detaining ██████ in handcuffs.

I requested the Sacramento Fire Dept respond code 3 to medically treat ██████

Officer Del Dotto and I conducted a check of ██████'s rear pockets and did not locate the revolver. I checked the area for the revolver.

In the planter where ██████ was first taken to the ground near the front porch steps I located a .32 caliber silver H&R Revolver (Serial # ██████). Officer Del Dotto cleared the firearm and found that it was unloaded.

A records check of the revolver showed that it was not registered.

During a search incident to arrest of ██████'s person Officer Del Dotto located a methamphetamine pipe and 2.07 grams of methamphetamine. The

On 01/10/20 at approx. 0323 hours, I, Ofc. Tsverov #893 contacted [REDACTED] in the back seat of a patrol vehicle regarding a vehicle stop where a passenger of his vehicle resisted officers. My body worn camera was activated during this investigation. [REDACTED] stated the following in summary:

About two to three minutes before the traffic stop, I was at the Quick Stop on Marysville Blvd and Los Robles Blvd. I observed the guy ([REDACTED]) get in a fight with someone on Los Robles Blvd. He fought a male black adult. During the fight, he was knocked to down to the ground. As he layed on the ground, he was hit about seven times. He lost the fight.

On 1/10/2020 at approx. 0259 hours, I Ofc. Del Dotto #992 and my partner Ofc. Maclean #1010 and I were on routine patrol in the area of Marysville blvd and Arcade blvd. We were in a fully marked patrol vehicle and in full police uniform. We conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle LP# [REDACTED] (see ofc. Macleans observations for further). The vehicle yeilded to the left on Arcade blvd and I observed the following in summary:

Upon exiting our patrol vehicle, I approached on the passenger side of the vehicle and contacted the passenger (later positively identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] DOB: [REDACTED] by his WEBKPF booking photo). The passenger window was initially rolled up, I tapped on the window and SUSPECT [REDACTED] rolled down the window.

I asked S-[REDACTED] if he had an ID on him which he advised he did not. I then asked S-[REDACTED] what his last name was and he provided the last name of [REDACTED] I then asked S-[REDACTED] what his date of birth was and he verbally provided [REDACTED].

While conversating with S-[REDACTED] I asked him if there was anything illegal in the car or on him such as guns, knives, drugs, marijuana or bombs. S-[REDACTED] failed to answer and stated "I am not on probation or nothing sir.

I noticed that S-[REDACTED] would look away during questioning and was able to see the rise and fall of his chest which appeared to be heavy and irregular. I know that subjects that area commonly lying or nervous show these types of behavior.

I observed that there was a backpack on the passenger floor bored between S-[REDACTED]'S feet. I again asked S-[REDACTED] if there was anything illegal in the backpack such as guns, knives, bombs, bazooka or marijuana. S-[REDACTED] shook his head side to side signaling no.

With out requesting S-[REDACTED] asked me if I wanted to check the backpack. I know that subjects will commonly hide or stash drugs, guns and other contriband in backpacks. So to possibly illiminate a potential threat I obliged and conducted a search of the backpack.

During the search of the backpack I located a orange colored pill bottle with a white cap. Inside the bottle where multiple white pills with "M367"

stamped on the pill. I know that from my training and experience that this pill is Acetaminophen/hydrocodone. I know that Hydrocodone is a schedule 2 controlled substance that requires a perscription by a doctor. At the time I located the bottle there was no perscription label or identifying information on the bottle.

I know that hydrocodone and schedule 2 controlled substances are commonly used and highly addictive. I also know that hydrocodone is commonly sold on the streets for \$5-\$10 a pill.

S-█████ advised that it wa motrin, I then advised Ofc. Maclean of my illegal narcotic findings.

At this time Ofc. Maclean had the driver exit the vehicle (see his observations).

I asked S-█████ if he had anything on him that was going to stick, poke or hurt me. S-█████ did not answer the question and advised that, "I am not on probation or nothing, and I am not trying to be searched."

I explained to S-█████ that I was going to have him exit the vehicle and I was going to be conducting a pat down search of his person. S-█████ continued to seem that he was misunderstanding and I continued to advise him the I was going to do a pat down search, to make sure he does not have any guns, knives or objects that can hurt me.

I then advise S-█████ that he was not under arrest and gave him commands to inner lace his hands behind his head and lean forward at the waist. I then opened the passenger door and gained control of S-█████ hands and had him exit the vehicle. Once out of the car I could feel S-█████ begin to tense up trying to seperate his hands.

Ofc. Maclean then came around the vehicle to assist in detaining S-█████ At this time S-█████ began to continue to resist and pulling away. S-█████ began to escalate and attempted to flee on foot while pulling away from Ofc.s. I maintained contact with S-█████ and continued to struggle with him while attempting to over come his resistance to now affect an arrest.

Ofc. Maclean and I where able to get S-█████ to the ground were he continued to resist multiple commands. I could hear Ofc. Maclean give him multiple commands to stop resisting.

Once I observed the substance I knew based on my trainin and experience that it was crystal methamphetamine. Also located in his pocket was a clear glass pipe with a rounded bulb at the end of the stem.

I know this pipe to commonly be used for the smoking of crystal methamphetamine.

Ofc.s located the handgun in the immediate area, where S- [REDACTED] was resisting. At this time a cleared the handgun which was unloaded.

During the initial part of the investigation my in car camera and body worn camera was activated. While attempting to affect the arrest on S- [REDACTED] my body worn camera clip was broke and my body worn camera was shut off. Once I later notice it was off I reactivated it.

My body worn camera was located on the grass where we detained S- [REDACTED] and the clip was confirmed broken.

It should be noted that S- [REDACTED] is a Valley High Pyru gang member based on admission of being apart of the gang and that he still commonly associates with known gang members.

I observed that on S- [REDACTED] right forarm was the numbers 78. I know this represents the 7800 block of Mack and Center Pkwy. S- [REDACTED] also stated that is what it represents and why he obtained the tattoo. S- [REDACTED] also had South tattooed on the top of his right hand and area on the top of his left hand. I know it is common for gang members to tattoo the area they represent and claim on there bodies.

I also observed that S- [REDACTED] had the letter AOB tattooed on his chest which is commonly associated with blood gang members. Based on contacts with subjects it has been stated that AOB stands for all on a bitch.

It should also be noted that S- [REDACTED] has had prior firearm charges, burglary charges, possession of stolen vehicle and stolen property charges.
