During my review of this incident, I did not observe any areas of concern. The full incident report is attached.

NOTE: I observed that the suspect sustained two contusions to his body consistent with bean bag rounds. One contusion was to the subject's left bicep, and the other was to his lower back on the left side. As there were three bean bag rounds fired, we are unable to determine which round is responsible for the corresponding injury. Therefore, both officers who fired bean bag rounds were shown as being responsible for both injuries to the suspect.

I read S-OSEGUERA his Miranda rights verbatim from my department issued Miranda card (SPD 133). S-OSEGUERA responded "yes" that he understood each of the Miranda advisement questions that I asked him. My body worn camera was activated for his statement. S-OSEGUERA stated the following in summary:

I always carry a knife in my hand straight up. I was holding it up against my forearm. I am a so I carry a knife. Once I see Police badges I black out. I could care less about seeing the Police cars. I have always had bad encounters with law enforcement. I don't want to be around law enforcement. Even when I have cooperated in the past, I get the short end of the stick.

It was up to you guys whether I would have stabbed one of you or not. I was not going to turn around and cooperate with you guys at all. I was going to keep moving. If you guys threatened me in a physical way I might have tried to stab one of you, I don't know. It was a black out moment. I don't know if I heard any commands. It was a black out moment like I said.

On 08/06/2021 I, Ofc. Schraer #1038 (1C29) was working routine patrol in the Del Paso Heights area of Sacramento. I was wearing my Sacramento Police Department patrol uniform affixed with a silver, seven point star police badge. I was driving a fully marked Sacramento Police Department patrol vehicle affixed with SPD logos on the front doors and red and blue light bar on the top of the vehicle. My body worn camera was activated for the following incident. Several other SPD patrol units were on scene to assist. To the best of my knowledge, all SPD Officers on scene had their body worn cameras activated. I observed the following in summary:

On 07/19/2021 S-OSEGUERA was issued a felony warrant for 417.8 PC and 69 PC. The warrant information is as follows:

Warrant No: SA 3415221 // Report No: 21-189289 // Docket: 21FE012226 // Bail: \$20,000.00 // Judge: James McFetridge // Responsible LEA: CA0340400 - SACRAMENTO POLICE DEPARTMENT // Issued: 7/19/2021 // DOJ FCN: 4302120201646 // Charges: PC 417.8, PC 69.

At approximately 1623 hours, myself and several other SPD patrol units responded to Grand Ave. We spoke with S-OSEGUERA's family members at the house. S-OSEGUERA's family stated that S-OSEGUERA was not home and consented to Officers checking the inside of the residence. SPD Officers confirmed he was not inside. While clearing the last bedroom, Ofc. Vidales #983 (1C21) broadcast that he was observing S-OSEGUERA walking towards his residence on S-OSEGUERA was wearing a red 49ers jersey, black gym shorts, and white shoes.

I observed S-OSEGUERA walking west along the north curb line of Grand Ave. S-OSEGUERA was in front of Grand Ave when I saw him. I yelled at S-OSEGUERA to put his hands up. S-OSEGUERA ignored this command. After seeing SPD Officers walking towards him, S-OSEGUERA turned around and started walking east on Grand Ave and across Vern St.

When he got to the northwest corner of Grand Ave/ Vern St, I saw S-OSEGUERA turn back towards Officers and take a black knife out of his right shorts pocket. After taking the knife out of his pocket, S-OSEGUERA switched the knife to his left hand and took a fighting stance with it while he was facing several Officers.

I grabbed a less lethal shotgun and pointed it at S-OSEGUERA while he was holding the knife. I gave S-OSEGUERA verbal commands to drop the knife, which were ignored. SPD Officers attempted to de-escalate the situation and have S-OSEGUERA surrender peacefully. S-OSEGUERA continued to hold the knife and was approximately 15-20 feet away from Officers. I heard S-OSEGUERA make several statements about wanting Officers to "kill him" and that he would "stick the dog", referring to the SPD K9 dog that was on scene, if the K9 was deployed.

(3SM2) Sgt. Lannom provided Officers on scene direction about plan based on S-OSEGUERA actions and that if S-OSEGUERA walked away with the knife or towards Officers with the knife, the use of less lethal weapons systems would be authorized.

After approximately 5 minutes, S-OSEGUERA turned around and started to walk away from Officers towards Norwood Ave. Based on S-OSEGUERA actions and the imminent threat of serious bodily injury if he was apprehended at a later time, I discharged one round from the less lethal shotgun at S-OSEGUERA's lower back area. The less lethal round I fired was a Super Sock Beanbag Round. I was approximately 20 feet away from S-OSEGUERA when I discharged the less lethal shotgun. Because of the rapidly evolving incident and the possibility losing sight of S-OSEGUERA behind a truck parked next to him, I did not voice a verbal warning prior to discharging the less lethal shotgun.

After I discharged the less lethal shotgun at S-OSEGUERA, an SPD K9 was deployed at him as well. See the other supplemental reports regarding Officer's observations, statements, and uses of force.

Myself and other Officers moved in on S-OSEGUERA and he was handcuffed and taken into custody. While taking S-OSEGUERA into custody and black and silver fixed blade knife was located next to him. I recovered the knife off the ground.

Officers on scene requested the Sacramento Fire Dept code 3 and provided medical care to S-OSEGUERA until SFD Engine and Medic 20 arrived on scene. S-OSEGUERA was transported to the UC Davis Medical Center (2315 Stockton Blvd) for treatment to his injuries.

I responded to UCDMC and observed the following injuries to S-OSEGUERA:

- One 2" laceration, due to a K9 dog bite, on the left side of his head.
- Approximately 4-6 puncture wounds on the left side of his abdomen.
- 1 circular shaped contusion on his left bicep.
- 1 circular shaped contusion on the left side of his lower back.
- Abrasions on both of his knee caps.
- Abrasions on his left knuckle.

I obtained a Mirandized statement from S-OSEGUERA at UCDMC. See suspect statement.

S-OSEGUERA received nine total sutures for his injuries. Eight of the sutures were for the K9 dog bite injury on his head and one suture was needed for one of the puncture wounds on his left side. While receiving initial treatment, a nurse at UCDMC accidentally discarded a Taser prong that was in S-OSEGUERA into a locked sharps container. The Taser prong could not be booked as evidence because of this.

S-OSEGUERA was cleared by UCDMC medical staff and deemed fit for incarceration.

S-OSEGUERA was charged and booked on his active warrant and the following fresh charges:

- 417.8 PC (Brandishing a knife at a Peace Officer)
- 21310 PC (Concealing a dirk/dagger)
- 148(a) PC (Willfully resist, obstruct, or delay a Peace Officer).

Ofc. Kuna later booked the knife S-OSEGUERA had as evidence at the Kinney Police Facility. The knife was black and silver in color. The knife was 7" in total length and the blade portion was $3\ 3/4"$ in length.

Ofc. Kuna also booked my less lethal shotgun round casing as evidence. The casing was not collected by CSI on scene due to the casing not ejecting from the chamber after I discharged the round.

(3SM2) Sgt. Lannom was on scene and apprised on the details of the call.

On Friday 8/6/2021,I, Ofc. Flure #942 was assigned to patrol as 1C15. I was wearing a full Police uniform and was driving in a marked Police vehicle. I was wearing a body worn camera which was activated during this incident.

At approx. 1602 hrs, I responded to Grand Ave regarding a attempt pickup for a subject with a felony warrant. The subject was identified as Sergio Oserguera and showed to have an active felony warrant for 417.8 PC.

Sgt. Lannom requested that I respond to assist with crisis negotiation skills as the subject was known to have several undiagnosed mental health issues as well as being known to be assaultive towards PD.

We arrived on scene at TIME and announced our presence at the front door of the residence. Sergio's mother, came to the front door and advised that Sergio was not at home. We requested for all occupants of the residence to exit so that we could ensure that Sergio was not inside the home hiding.

Ofc. Schraer, Ofc. Ricci, and myself announced our presence again and proceeded to clear the residence which yielded negative results.

While still inside of the home, units advised that they observed a subject matching Sergio's description walking south on Vern Street towards Grand Avenue. As officers approached Sergio, units advised that he was armed with a knife and not compliant with commands.

I responded to Sergio's location and began attempting to de-escalate the situation using department approved techniques of communication. While speaking with Sergio, he advised that he would not be going back to jail and advised units to shoot him if they wanted to. I explained to Sergio that he had an outstanding warrant for his arrest and urged him to comply with our commands.

While engaging in dialogue with Sergio, he suddenly picked up his Slurpee that was at his feet and began walking west on Grand Avenue towards Norwood Avenue.

Due to his violent history and knowledge that he was walking away from officers with a knife in his hand towards members of the public, less lethal force was utilized to subdue Sergio. Officers were able to taking him into custody moments later.

As officers were taking Sergio into custody, members of Segio's family began sprinting towards Sergio in an effort to come to his aid. This was after I previously advised that family to stay back and allow officers to talk to Sergio in order to gain compliance as well as a peaceful surrender. I advised Sergio's mother that failure to listen to my orders would result in a detention for 148(a) PC.

We detained and her younger son, (), without incident. Both and were later released after the scene had stabilized.

The Sacramento Fire Department responded and assessed Sergio for his injuries.

On 8/6/2021 at approximately 1627 hours, I, Ofc. Bruce #711 and Ofc. Hancock #831 responded to Grand Ave to assist Officers with an Attempt Pickup Warrant Service. My Body Worn Camera was activated and recording during this incident. I observed the following in summary:

Officers on scene advised that a possible suspect was observed walking south on the street west of the target residence.

I observed a MHA with long black hair and wearing a red jersey. I positively identified the subject as the suspect (S-1), Sergio OSEGUERA (Xref:) per a Sacramento County Known Person Finder booking photograph (03/19/2019).

I assisted Officers conduct a felony stop on S-1 in the area of Grand Ave and Vern St and drew my duty weapon.

S-1 stood on the N/W corner of the intersection on the sidewalk and immediately drew what appeared to be a silver in color knife, holding it with both hands down in front of his waist. S-1 asked Officers multiple times to shoot him.

I broadcasted the information over the radio as Officers attempted to speak and reason with S-1.

S-1 then turned west, showing his back to Officers, and began to walk away from Officers.

Officers deployed combined less lethal options, striking S-1.

S-1 was on the ground and continued to struggle with a Sacramento Police Department K9. Officers successfully deployed a CED that I observed strike S-1 in the back area.

I holstered my duty weapon and attempted to place S-1 in handcuffs. While grasping S-1's right arm, I felt a jolt of electrical current throughout my right arm that was sustained from a SPD CED deployment. I was prevented and unable to place S-1 in handcuffs. I again attempted to detain S-1 in handcuffs and again felt a jolt of electrical current to my right arm.

Eventually through a physical struggle, Officers were able to detain S-1 in handcuffs. During the struggle, I struck my right knee on the hard concrete surface while attempting to gain control of S-1 and place him into handcuffs. I felt intense and sharp pain, swelling, and a throbbing sensation afterward. I later completed a first report of injury and submitted it to 3SM2 (Sgt. Lannom).

I assisted Officers roll S-1 into the recovery position, which consisted of placing him on his side and ensured he had a pulse and was breathing. Sacramento Fire was started to provide medical attention to S-1.

Sacramento Fire arrived on scene and began to provide medical attention and transported him to UCD. I rode in Sacramento Fire Medic to UCD to provide over watch and security while S-1 was being treated.

At UCD, I was relieved by Ofc. Schraer #1038 and Ofc. Kuna #499.

On Friday, 8/6/2021, at approx. 1531 hours, I, Officer Terman #879 and my Police K9 "Ranger" responded to Grand Ave for an attempt pick up/warrant service. I was driving a marked SacPD K9 SUV and I was wearing a full Police uniform. K9 Ranger was wearing a Sacramento Police K9 badge and a tactical collar with "POLICE" printed in bold reflective lettering across it. I observed the following in summary:

My in car camera and body worn camera were activated for this incident

Prior to my arrival at Grand Ave, I attended a field briefing with District 2 patrol Officers as well as Sgt. Lannom (3SM2). The attempt pick up/warrant service was for Sergio OSEGUERA (X-GRAND). OSEGUERA had a felony warrant for 417.8 PC (brandishing a deadly weapon with the intent to resist arrest or detention).

The warrant stemmed from an incident on 7/6/2021 where Officer Schraer #1038 had attempted to stop OSEGUERA who was riding a bicycle. OSEGUERA fled on his bicycle to the front yard of Grand Ave, subsequently producing a knife while in close proximity to Officer Schraer. Officers tactically retreated and eventually left without arresting OSEGUERA. A warrant for his arrest was later obtained.

Officers established a tactical plan for contacting OSEGUERA and his family at and taking OSEGUERA into custody. Sgt. Lannom authorized the use of K9.

Officers responded to Grand Ave, making contact with several subjects in addition to family members of OSEGUERA who advised they were not sure if he was home or not. Officers were clearing the residence when a perimeter unit advised that OSEGUERA was on foot walking SB to the west of Grand Ave. He was described as wearing a red 49ers jersey.

I drove WB Grand Ave towards Vern St, I observed OSEGUERA walking WB Grand Ave at Vern St away from Officers and their patrol vehicles. I activated my overhead red lights. I utilized my PA and advised OSEGUERA "Sergio don't run, you're gonna get bit by a Police dog?don't run you're gonna get bit by a Police dog?Sergio get on the ground you're gonna get bit by a Police dog?Sergio get on the ground you're gonna get bit by a Police dog."

OSEGUERA was holding a drink in his left hand and digging his right hand into his pocket. There was an unidentified male Hispanic adult subject walking EB Grand Ave approaching OSEGUERA. At the northwest corner of Vern St/Grand Ave, OSEGUERA and this subject stood next to each other as OSEGUERA turned around, removed his hand from his pocket and was holding an

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approx. 3-5 inch fixed blade knife in his right hand at his side. It was apparent the subject and OSEGUERA were associated. The subject was ordered out of the area. He complied and crossed the street southbound away from OSEGUERA. OSEGUERA stood in place with an assaultive stance. I exited my vehicle as I brought K9 Ranger to a heel by my side. I ordered OSEGUERA to the ground once more and warned him he would be bit then stating "Sergio drop the knife, you're going to get bit by a Police dog, I don't want to hurt you."

An approximately 4 minute long standoff ensued, during this time OSEGUERA continued to stand in an assaultive/combative stance. His stance was bladed, his chest/shoulders were flexed and he held the knife in a manner consistent with having it prepared to violently assault Officers and K9 Ranger with it. His demeanor was aggressive as he made numerous statements yelling at Officers to shoot him and that he would stab K9 Ranger if I sent him. He aggressively waved his arms several times and beat his chest. He both verbally and physically displayed an intention to assault Officers/K9 Ranger and verbally/physically signaled an intent to avoid being taken into custody. He was given numerous commands to drop the knife and comply with Officers. He made no attempt to comply or surrender, neither verbally nor physically. It should also be noted that a Crisis Negotiation Team Officer (Officer Flure #942) was present and attempting to de-escalate, as I also stated multiple times to OSEGUERA that we did not want to hurt him. During the standoff, Sgt. Lannom, myself and the contact team coordinated individual responsibilities for Officers on the contact team as well as our reactive authority. Sqt. Lannom clarified that if OSEGUERA were to flee from Officers combined less lethal force including K9 would be deployed in an effort to safely apprehend OSEGUERA.

After approx. 4 minutes of negotiations, OSEGUERA picked up his drink with his right hand, moving the knife over to his left hand as he turned away from Officers and began walking WB Grand Ave away from Officers. OSEGUERA still had the knife in his left hand as he fled WB Grand Ave away from Officers.

I gave K9 Ranger his command to pursue and apprehend OSEGUERA based on the following facts and circumstances that were known to me at the time of the incident:

- OSEGUERA had a violent felony warrant for 417.8 PC
- OSEGUERA had a fresh want for 417.8 PC
- OSEGUERA was armed with a 3-5 inch fixed blade knife. OSEGUERA physically/verbally signaled an intent to utilize this deadly weapon against Officers/K9 Ranger if he was approached.

- OSEGUERA physically/verbally signaled an intent to assault Officers/K9 Ranger and physically/verbally signaled an intent to avoid or prevent being

- OSEGUERA was wearing shorts with pockets and had not been searched for additional weapons.
- OSEGUERA was armed with a deadly weapon and fleeing into a heavily populated residential area where if allowed to continue to flee would pose an extreme threat to the community.
- Using a Police K9 to apprehend OSEGUERA would greatly enhance officer safety and diminish OSEGUERA's opportunity to continue to flee into the neighborhood and endanger the community and Officers.

K9 Ranger sprinted towards OSEGUERA as he walked WB Grand Ave. Moments before K9 Ranger made contact with OSEGUERA he began turning to face K9 Ranger. Other Officers fired approx. 3 less lethal bean bag rounds at OSEGUERA as K9 Ranger contacted OSEGUERA, in a combined less lethal effort to assist in overcoming OSEGUERA's high level of resistance. K9 Ranger contacted OSEGUERA on his left arm, knocking him to the ground. K9 Ranger continued to engage OSEGUERA as I moved up with my contact team. OSEGUERA was laying down on his right side facing away from Officers. I moved

towards OSEGUERA's front side. As I was facing OSEGUERA, I was initially unable to see whether OSEGUERA still had the knife in hand or not. I ordered OSEGUERA to drop the knife twice. I was subsequently able to see that OSEGUERA's hands were clear of any weapons. OSEGUERA appeared to be surrendering. I took positive control of K9 Ranger and gave him his command to release OSEGUERA. K9 Ranger immediately released OSEGUERA. Additional Officers took OSEGUERA into custody, his knife was located in close proximity to where he was taken into custody (see supplements).

I coordinated immediate medical care for OSEGUERA as well as requesting Fire Paramedics to respond code 3 for OSEGUERA's injuries.

Fire Paramedics transported OSEGUERA to the UC Davis medical center where he was treated for his injuries in the Emergency Department.

CSI documented the scene as well as OSEGUERA's injuries.

A use of force canvass was conducted in the area of the incident (see supplements).

I responded to the UC Davis Medical Center where I contacted OSEGUERA who had been Mirandized and did not invoke his Miranda rights. OSEGUERA stated that he "blacked out" and did not recall details regarding the incident. Officer Schraer (1C29) obtained his Mirandized statement (see supplement).

I observed OSEGUERA's K9 related injuries to include rakes, punctures and evulsions to the left side of the back of his head, left side of his stomach and left arm.

On 08/06/2021 at approx 1627 hours, I, Ofc Hancock and Ofc Bruce #711 were dispatched to assist with an attempt warrant pick-up service for Sergio Oseguera XREF# (S-Oseguera at Grand Ave. Per the text of the call, an officer safety clause stated that S-Oseguera had a history of attempting to harm himself with hammers, knives and has been confrontational with law enforcement and family members. My body worn camera and in-car camera were activated and recording for the duration of the call. I observed the following in summary:

Upon my arrival, I parked my vehicle in front of Grand Ave on the south side of the residence. As Officers attempted to make contact at the front door, I grabbed the ballistic shield located in the trunk of my patrol vehicle. I set up, with the ballistic shield, just west of the front door. Ofc Bruce #711 and I, moved towards the north side of the residence to hold the backyard. As units cleared the house, it was determined that S-Oseguera was not inside the residence. I then placed the ballistic shield in the back of my patrol car.

At this time, Ofc Vidales #983 broadcasted over the radio that a possible suspect was seen walking south on Vern St just west of Grand Ave. As I observed the possible suspect, he was a male hispanic adult (MHA) with long black hair, wearing a red football jersey. He was walking eastbound towards the residence on Grand Ave. Once he saw officers, he immediately turned around and started to walk away from the residence traveling westbound Grand Ave.

Officers conducted a felony stop on the suspect, on the North/West curbline of Grand Ave and Vern St. The suspect was later identified as Sergio Oseguera XREF#

As I was exiting my patrol vehicle, I saw S-Oseguera facing officers holding a silver-like object with what appeared to be a knife. I drew my service weapon and took cover behind my patrol vehicle door. S-Oseguera was approx 20 yards away from officers. Officers continued to create conversation with S-Oseguera, yet he still continued to be non-compliant.

K96 (Officer Terman) voiced to me to get less-lethal options. I transitioned to a department issued 12-Gauge beanbag shotgun (Serial#D507719M) and remained behind cover of my patrol vehicle. Officers continued to voice verbal commands to S-Oseguera to drop the knife.

3SM2 (Sgt. Lannom) was on scene and verbally authorized the lines of demarcation to all of the officers on scene. Sgt. Lannom stated that if S-Oseguera walked towards the patrol vehicles with the knife or walked away from the patrol vehicles, with the knife, that overwhelming less-lethal and the use of canine was authorized.

S-Oseguera proceeded to walk away from officers travelling westbound on Grand Ave, west of Vern St. I discharge two impact rounds from a department issued 12 gauge beanbag shotgun (Serial#D507719M), both rounds striking S-Oseguera in the lower back area.

I assisted officers in detaining S-Oseguera into handcuffs.

It shall be noted, while I was attempting to gain control of S-Oseguera's left arm I felt a shocking sensation in my right arm from officers deploying their CED. The shocking sensation lasted approx 1-2 seconds.

Ofc Bruce #711 rode in Sacramento Fire Medic #20, with the suspect, transported to UC Davis Medical Center. I followed Medic #20 in my patrol vehicle.

At approx. 1617 hrs, we arrived on scene, activated our ICC and body-worn cameras, and I observed the following in summary:

Officer Dethlefs and I arrived at Morrison Ave Grand Ave Aly and obtained a perimeter spot just northeast of Grand Ave.

At approx. 1639 hrs, I observed a Hispanic male adult with long black hair with a distinct center gray stripe, approx 5'9", 180 lbs, wearing a 49ers Jersey who I recognized to be S-OSEGUERA. S-OSEGUERA was walking southbound on Kern St with another Hispanic male subject and had just passed the aly. Via radio, I broadcasted the sighting S-OSEGUERA and his direction of travel.

Officer Dethlefs and I drove our patrol vehicle to Kern St / Grand Ave and located S-OSEGUERA walking away from officers while holding a knife in his right hand.

S-OSEGUERA stopped on the northeast corner sidewalk of Kern St / Grand Ave as officers ordered him to stop. I held S-OSEGUERA at gunpoint as officers gave him verbal commands to drop the knife. Due to the amount of officers on scene, I transitioned to my TASER 7 as a less lethal option.

Officers continued to give verbal commands in attempt to de-escalate S-OSEGUERA and have him drop the knife. S-OSEGUERA refused to comply with commands. S-OSEGUERA advised that he is not listening and told officers to shoot him. S-OSEGUERA remained holding the knife in hand and advised that he is not going to put the knife down.

At this time, S-OSEGUERA began walking westbound on Grand Ave away from officers while holding the knife in hand. Due to a fence line, I lost visual of S-OSEGUERA as he continued to walk away from officers.

Officers deployed less lethal beanbag rounds at S-OSEGUERA and K9 Officer Terman #879 deployed his K9.

When I regained visual of S-OSEGUERA, he was laying on his right side with his back facing me. The K9 had a bite on S-OSEGUERA'S left side/torso. I was unable to see his hands and if he was still armed with the knife.

At this time, officers yelled commands for S-OSEGUERA to drop the knife and to put the knife down. Based on S-OSEGUERA'S felony warrant, failure to comply with officers commands, and imminent threat to officers being armed with a knife, I deployed my TASER 7 (Serial #X4000E9AM) after yelling, "Taser taser taser!"

The two probes from the first bay (Serial #X4920A10N) of TASER connected by impacting S-OSEGUERA'S upperback and buttocks. Officers attempted to gain custody of S-OSEGUERA as he continued to resist with his right arm underneath his body. Due to S-OSEGUERA continued resistive behavior, I introduced an additional TASER cycle by pressing the trigger which the second bay accidentally discharged and was shot into the ground (Serial #X4920AA5W).
