8/3/21: I, Sayles, spoke to ██████ via phone call (██████████). ██████ claims she was pulled over by gunpoint and accused of going over 90 MPH. I advised ██████ her complaint was being investigated and I would add her additional comments to her current complaint.

Captain Green,

On 7-27-21, the Internal Affairs Division received email correspondence regarding an allegation made from complainant [REDACTED] (hereinafter referred to as C-[REDACTED] / see attached SPD 330). The allegation was regarding C-[REDACTED]'s interaction with Ofc. Anstess during a traffic stop on 7-27-21 (21-210461). The complaint alleged Ofc. Anstess lacked patience and professionalism during contact, directed C-[REDACTED] to sit on a curb after citation issuance, and that Ofc. Anstess denied C-[REDACTED] a supervisor when requested. The complaint additionally states a 914S was generated regarding the event, however attempts to recontact C-[REDACTED] were negative (21-210482). On 8-3-21, C-[REDACTED] contacted the Internal Affairs Division via phone and provided further information regarding the complaint (see attached audio).

I reviewed the associated complaints, CAD calls, Report, and Body Worn Camera / Fleet Video to better familiarize myself with the incident. Based upon my review, I learned the following in summary.

On 7-27-21 at 0531 hrs., Ofc. Anstess (1A61) conducted a traffic stop on CA # [REDACTED] at 3333 Fruitridge rd. Prior to the vehicle stop, Ofc. Anstess' AXON Fleet video shows him pacing the above stated vehicle s/b HWY 50 at over 80 MPH (AXON Fleet 0000-0030). Ofc. Anstess makes contact with the sole occupant, C-[REDACTED]. Ofc. Anstess' removes his firearm and holds it behind his right thigh during initial approach. Ofc. Anstess advised C-[REDACTED] that she was driving about 90 MPH. During this initial conversation, C-[REDACTED] sees Ofc. Anstess' removed firearm and states she is "in fear for her life." An argument ensues over the displayed firearm and Ofc. Anstess raises his voice while explaining the vehicle code violation and questioning C-[REDACTED]'s attitude (AXON BWC / Anstess1 0205). C-[REDACTED] states she moved to California from Illinois and provides a CA ID card only.

Ofc. Anstess returns to his vehicle and conducts an associated records check. A DMV records check determined the following:

- C-[REDACTED]'s listed mailing address was [REDACTED] Sacramento [REDACTED] as of 11-10-20
- C-[REDACTED] had an other mailing address of [REDACTED] Sacramento as of 5-1-17
- C-[REDACTED]'s CA ID card was mailed 11-20-20
- C-[REDACTED]'s license status was None Issued
- C-[REDACTED] had a previous 12500A CVC citation on 2-4-20 with a 3-5-21 conviction date

Ofc. Anstess completes a citation for 22350 CVC and 12500 CVC and recontacts C-[REDACTED] at her vehicle. Ofc. Anstess asks C-[REDACTED] to turn her car off and provide him her keys, further advising her car is going to be towed (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1515). Ofc. Anstess advises he is going to be conducting a vehicle inventory and asks C-[REDACTED] to leave her belongings in the car. Ofc. Anstess and C-[REDACTED] continue to argue the citation fact pattern outside the vehicle. Ofc. Anstess briefly raises his voice again in apparent frustration (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1750). Ofc. Anstess explains the associated citation and C-[REDACTED] signs the citation and is provided a copy.

Ofc. Anstess advises C-[REDACTED] to sit on the curb pending inventory search (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1830). C-

█ stands approx. 35 ft. from the vehicle during search. At the conclusion of search, C-█ complains that Ofc. Anstess was "rude from jumpstreet" and asks for his badge number. Ofc. Anstess replies "on the ticket" (AXON BWC / Anstess1 2345). C-█ begins complaining about the entirety of the stop and asks for a supervisor. Ofc. Anstess replies "no." C-█ states "I asked for a supervisor, I have a right to a supervisor." Ofc. Anstess responds "no you don't" (AXON BWC / Anstess1 2430). This argument continues for approximately one minute with Ofc. Anstess refusing a supervisor multiple times.

Ofc. Anstess returns to his vehicle to finish the tow form. Five Star Towing arrives on scene at tow's the associated vehicle for 22651(p) CVC (see SPD 188). Ofc. Anstess turns off his BWC as C-█ has left the area. C-█ returns as her vehicle is in the process of being towed and Ofc. Anstess' BWC is again activated. C-█ again asks for a supervisor, alleging discrimination (AXON BWC / Anstess2 0030). Ofc. Anstess and C-█ continue to argue and C-█ alleges "if you don't like black people, just say that." Ofc. Anstess again refuses to contact a supervisor when requested multiple times over. Ofc. Anstess returns to his car and asks C-█ if there "is there anything else I can help you with." C-█ again asks for a supervisor and is again denied (AXON BWC / Anstess2 0225).

The call was cleared with "No" report expected, "Police matter resolved on scene", with the remarks of "1 FBA 27, stopped for 22350 (90 in a 65)...cited for 22350 / 12500 (Cit #1348460)."

Sgt. Faria,

I have completed a review of this incident and the associated materials. I reviewed the SPD 332 and added additional allegations based upon the overall complaint as well as the conduct observed during my review of the BWC. The allegations now include: Conduct Unbecoming, Discrimination, Improper Search and Seizure, Discourtesy, Neglect of Duty and Traffic.

Here is a summary of my finding for each allegation:

Discrimination (Not Sustained) - Based on my review of the available materials, and due to the fact that Ofc. Anstess is no longer employed by SPD and as such we are unable to obtain a compelled statement to gather additional information and his perspective, I am unable to determine if discrimination played a role in the actions or misconduct of Ofc. Anstess.

Improper Search and Seizure (Sustained) - Ofc. Anstess prevented the driver from removing any personal belongings from her vehicle until the completion of a tow inventory. Per existing case law: If the vehicle is going to be inventoried, but the driver or other occupant requests possession of some object, such as a tote bag or jacket, you may check the object for weapons for your own safety before handing it over, for example, by patting it down or, if necessary, by looking inside. (Needham (2000) 79 Cal.App.4th 260, 266.) Additionally, Ofc. Anstess, following the completion of the citation, directed the driver to sit on the curb while he completed the tow inventory which unlawfully continued the detention of the driver. Ofc. Anstess should have, at the completion of the citation, allowed the driver to remove any requested belongings (having first checked them for his safety) and then advised the driver that she was free to leave.

Discourtesy (Sustained) - Ofc. Anstess was rude, unprofessional and impatient during his contact with the driver. Ofc. Anstess' communication and actions toward the driver were in fact discourteous.

Neglect of Duty (Sustained) - Ofc. Anstess failed to request or even advise his sergeant following the driver's multiple requests for a supervisor at the scene.

Traffic (Sustained) - Ofc. Anstess drove on the freeway at 81 MPH (speed limit 65 MPH) without activating his lights or siren while attempting to catch up to the vehicle.

Conduct Unbecoming (Sustained) - The totality of Ofc. Anstess' conduct on this call, to include but not be limited to the discourtesy, violation of both policy and law with regard to his driving, the failure to request, or even notify, a supervisor following repeated requests from the driver, and the improper seizure of the driver and her property, could all bring discredit upon the department.

Due to the fact that Ofc. Anstess is no longer an employee, no disciplinary action can be taken at this time. If you have any additional questions please contact me directly.

Anstess, following the completion of the citation, directed the driver to sit on the curb while he completed the tow inventory which unlawfully continued the detention of the driver. Ofc. Anstess should have, at the completion of the citation, allowed the driver to remove any requested belongings (having first checked them for his safety) and then advised the driver that she was free to leave.

**Discourtesy (Sustained)** – Ofc. Anstess was rude, unprofessional and impatient during his contact with the driver. Ofc. Anstess' communication and actions toward the driver were in fact discourteous.

**Neglect of Duty (Sustained)** – Ofc. Anstess failed to request or even advise his sergeant following the driver's multiple requests for a supervisor at the scene.

**Traffic (Sustained)** – Ofc. Anstess drove on the freeway at 81 MPH (speed limit 65 MPH) without activating his lights or siren while attempting to catch up to the vehicle.

**Conduct Unbecoming (Sustained)** – The totality of Ofc. Anstess' conduct on this call, to include but not be limited to the discourtesy, violation of both policy and law with regard to his driving, the failure to request, or even notify, a supervisor following repeated requests from the driver, and the improper seizure of the driver and her property, could all bring discredit upon the department.

Due to the fact that Ofc. Anstess is no longer an employee, no disciplinary action can be taken at this time.

Captain Green,

On 7-27-21, the Internal Affairs Division received email correspondence regarding an allegation made from complainant [REDACTED] (hereinafter referred to as C-[REDACTED] / see attached SPD 330). The allegation was regarding C-[REDACTED]'s interaction with Ofc. Anstess during a traffic stop on 7-27-21 (21-210461). The complaint alleged Ofc. Anstess lacked patience and professionalism during contact, directed C-[REDACTED] to sit on a curb after citation issuance, and that Ofc. Anstess denied C-[REDACTED] a supervisor when requested. The complaint additionally states a 914S was generated regarding the event, however attempts to recontact C-[REDACTED] were negative (21-210482). On 8-3-21, C-[REDACTED] contacted the Internal Affairs Division via phone and provided further information regarding the complaint (see attached audio).

I reviewed the associated complaints, CAD calls, Report, and Body Worn Camera / Fleet Video to better familiarize myself with the incident. Based upon my review, I learned the following in summary.

On 7-27-21 at 0531 hrs., Ofc. Anstess (1A61) conducted a traffic stop on CA # [REDACTED] at 3333 Fruitridge rd. Prior to the vehicle stop, Ofc. Anstess' AXON Fleet video shows him pacing the above stated vehicle s/b HWY 50 at over 80 MPH (AXON Fleet 0000-0030). Ofc. Anstess makes contact with the sole occupant, C-[REDACTED]. Ofc. Anstess' removes his firearm and holds it behind his right thigh during initial approach. Ofc. Anstess advised C-[REDACTED] that she was driving about 90 MPH. During this initial conversation, C-[REDACTED] see's Ofc. Anstess' removed firearm and states she is "in fear for her life." An augment ensues over the displayed firearm and Ofc. Anstess raises his voice while explaining the vehicle code violation and questioning C-[REDACTED]'s attitude (AXON BWC / Anstess1 0205). C-[REDACTED] states she moved to California from Illinois and provides a CA ID card only.

Ofc. Anstess returns to his vehicle and conducts an associated records check. A DMV records check determined the following:

- C-█'s listed mailing address was █ Sacramento █ as of 11-10-20
- C-█ had an other mailing address of █ Sacramento as of 5-1-17
- C-█'s CA ID card was mailed 11-20-20
- C-█'s license status was None Issued
- C-█ had a previous 12500A CVC citation on 2-4-20 with a 3-5-21 conviction date

Ofc. Anstess completes a citation for 22350 CVC and 12500 CVC and recontacts C-█ at her vehicle. Ofc. Anstess asks C-█ to turn her car off and provide him her keys, further advising her car is going to be towed (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1515). Ofc. Anstess advises he is going to be conducting a vehicle inventory and asks C-█ to leave her belongings in the car. Ofc. Anstess and C-█ continue to argue the citation fact pattern outside the vehicle. Ofc. Anstess briefly raises his voice again in apparent frustration (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1750). Ofc. Anstess explains the associated citation and C-█ signs the citation and is provided a copy.

Ofc. Anstess advises C-█ to sit on the curb pending inventory search (AXON BWC / Anstess1 1830). C-█ stands approx. 35 ft. from the vehicle during search. At the conclusion of search, C-█ complains that Ofc. Anstess was "rude from jumpstreet" and asks for his badge number. Ofc. Anstess replies "on the ticket" (AXON BWC / Anstess1 2345). C-█ begins complaining about the entirety of the stop and asks for a supervisor. Ofc. Anstess replies "no." C-█ states "I asked for a supervisor, I have a right to a supervisor." Ofc. Anstess responds "no you don't" (AXON BWC / Anstess1 2430). This argument continues for approximately one minute with Ofc. Anstess refusing a supervisor multiple times.

Ofc. Anstess returns to his vehicle to finish the tow form. Five Star Towing arrives on scene at tow's the associated vehicle for 22651(p) CVC (see SPD 188). Ofc. Anstess turns off his BWC as C-█ has left the area. C-█ returns as her vehicle is in the process of being towed and Ofc. Anstess' BWC is again activated. C-█ again asks for a supervisor, alleging discrimination (AXON BWC / Anstess2 0030). Ofc. Anstess and C-█ continue to argue and C-█ alleges "if you don't like black people, just say that." Ofc. Anstess again refuses to contact a supervisor when requested multiple times over. Ofc. Anstess returns to his car and asks C-█ if there "is there anything else I can help you with." C-█ again asks for a supervisor and is again denied (AXON BWC / Anstess2 0225).

The call was cleared with "No" report expected, "Police matter resolved on scene", with the remarks of "1 FBA 27, stopped for 22350 (90 in a 65)...cited for 22350 / 12500 (Cit #1348460)."
