Incident Summary:

On January 5th, 2025, at approximately 1743 hours, Detective Mohammad (1E41) and Officer Teurn (SCT432) were assigned to the DOCO Plaza to assist with monitoring the guest check-in area at the Rod Wave Concert. While stationed in front of the entrance doors to the arena, they were hailed by Golden One Center security staff regarding an intoxicated subject physically fighting with security staff near the guest check-in lines.

Per Detective Mohammad's observations, he observed a subject (later identified as Tyrece Shelton) actively assaulting a security guard by swinging both arms with closed fists. Officer Teurn also described the same assaultive behavior of Shelton by stating in his observations that he saw Shelton swinging his right fist at two security guards. Both Detective Mohammad and Officer Teurn ran to assist the security guards. As both officers physically intervened to stop the assault, Detective Mohammad stated "Police" three times while Officer Teurn also stated "Police" three times.

Detective Mohammad grabbed hold of Shelton's left arm while Officer Teurn grabbed his right arm in an attempt to utilize control holds and place him in handcuffs. Both officers ordered Shelton to place his hands behind his back. As the officers brought Shelton's arms behind his back, Shelton tensed his arms

and pulled them forward, away from the officers. Detective Mohammad was able to place Shelton's left arm into a rear-wrist lock while Officer Teurn attempted to maintain control of Shelton's right arm. Detective Mohammad reached across to Shelton's right wrist and applied a single handcuff. Shelton yelled "I have a hurt arm" four times and pulled his right arm away from the officers when they attempted to place the other handcuff on Shelton's left wrist. Shelton pivoted his body clockwise and pulled his handcuffed right arm from Officer Teurn's grasp. Detective Mohammad stated in his observations, "I placed my right leg in front of the male and used his momentum and guided his body to the ground". Per the security camera footage of the struggle, Shelton can be seen planting his left hand to the ground prior to Detective Mohammad falling on top of him.

Detective Mohammad, Officer Teurn, and Shelton went to the ground together. Officer Teurn broadcast via the radio that they were "fighting with one out front" and they needed additional. Officer Teurn stated in his observations that when they fell to the ground, his right kneecap struck the concrete causing a minor injury to himself. Both officers continued struggling with Shelton when Officer Simpson arrived. Detective Mohammad gained control of Shelton's left arm and placed it in a rear-wrist lock. Detective Mohammad was unable to place the handcuff onto Shelton's left wrist due to a black wrist brace. Detective Mohammad and Officer Simpson removed the wrist brace and were able to secure the handcuffs.

Detective Derrick, Detective Boyd and Officer Whitcomb, who were working interior supplemental employment for the Rod Wave Concert, also responded to the scene to assist the officers. Detective Mohammad assisted Shelton to his feet by sitting him in an upright position and pulling him up using Shelton's right shoulder. Detective Mohammad grabbed ahold of Shelton's right hand and elbow in the position of escort and advised Shelton he was going to walk to their patrol vehicle. Officer Whitcomb had placed his hand underneath Shelton's left armpit to assist with escorting him to the patrol vehicle. Officer Whitcomb stated in his observations, "Due to Officer Simpson alerting me to the possibility of a pre-existing condition and/or injury to S-Shelton's left wrist, I took great care not to further worsen that injury. I did not use the departmentally approved rear-wrist lock for this reason."

Detective Mohammad and Officer Whitcomb began escorting Shelton to the front of the Sawyer Hotel where a patrol vehicle was parked. Shelton continued to yell and dropped to his knees causing the officers to stop. Detective Mohammad told Shelton multiple times that he needed to walk however Shelton refused. Detective Mohammad and Officer Whitcomb picked Shelton up by his arms and continued the escort.

Shelton again fell to the ground at which point, Detective Boyd and Detective Derrick each grabbed a leg of Shelton's to carry him. The four officers carried Shelton briefly until Shelton began kicking his legs at officers, stating he would walk. The officers dropped his legs and allowed Shelton to walk on his own while still being guided by Detective Mohammad and Detective Derrick. Detective Derrick detailed in his observations, that he originally grabbed Shelton's left fingers when escorting him until Shelton stated his hand was injured, at which point Detective Derrick shifted his grip to the back of Shelton's jacket.

The officers made it to the patrol vehicle parked in front of the Sawyer Hotel on J Street where he was searched and placed into the backseat. Sergeant Ratcliffe arrived and was briefed on the incident. The Sacramento Fire Department responded to the scene to evaluate Shelton's complaint of pain to his left

wrist. Detective Mohammad made the decision to transport Shelton to Sutter Sacramento for medical treatment.

Shelton was medically cleared and transported to Sacramento County Jail where he was booked for 242 PC and 148 PC.

Injuries:

Per Tyrece Shelton's medical records, Doctor [REDACTED] of Sutter Sacramento diagnosed Shelton as having a minimally displaced scaphoid fracture to his left wrist. Per Doctor [REDACTED] conversation with Detective Mohammad, he was adamant that due to the soft tissue swelling around the scaphoid bone he believed it was a new fracture. He also explained to Detective Mohammad that the scaphoid fracture was in a different area than Shelton's previous ulnar fracture.

Use of Force:

Per SPD General Order 580.02 (Use of Force), the circumstances for the use of control holds detailed below in Detective Mohammad's observations include but are not limited to the following:

- Detective Mohammad had seen Shelton actively fighting security guards just outside of the metal detectors.
- Detective Mohammad stated that it was unknown at the time how or why the physical altercation was taking place and it concerned him that it was unknown if security staff had stopped Shelton due to noticing any sort of weapons or if he had attempted to enter without being scanned for weapons.
- Based on the male actively resisting arrest and not knowing if he was armed with any sort of weapons at the time, Detective Mohammad believed it was the most reasonable and safest action to guide Shelton to the ground where he would not have a stable platform to continue his violent behavior and could safely be taken into custody.

Per SPD General Order 580.02 (Use of Force), the circumstances for the use of control holds detailed below in Officer Teurn's observations include but are not limited to the following:

- Officer Teurn observed Tyrece Shelton actively swinging his right fist at two security guards near the metal detectors.
- Officer Teurn stated that he and Detective Mohammad grabbed onto Shelton's arms in order to

stop him from further assaulting the security guards.

- Officer Teurn believed that based on his observations of Shelton's violent actions, he felt it necessary in order to stabilize the scene and that it was in the best interest of the officer's and public's safety.

Summary:

On 01/06/2025, at approximately 0001 hours, the Force Investigation Team was notified of a potential use of force incident in the area of 5th Street / J Street. Due to the time it took to receive a medical opinion on the type of injury, the incident briefing did not occur until 1300 hours on 01/06/2025.

On 01/05/2025, at approximately 1743 hours, Detective Mohammad #780 (1E41) and Officer Teurn #403 (SCT432) were hailed by Golden One Center security officers at the front entrance of the Golden One Center, just south of 5th Street / J Street, regarding an intoxicated subject physically fighting with security officers. Both officers observed the altercation occurring and responded to assist.

Detective Mohammad and Officer Teurn each grabbed an arm of the suspect and utilized control holds in an effort to place him in handcuffs. The suspect tensed his arms and began pulling away from the officers. Both the officers and suspect fell to the ground as they struggled to detain him. Officer Teurn had broadcast they were fighting with a suspect in front of the Golden One Center entrance. Additional officers arrived to assist with detaining the suspect. During the struggle, the suspect stated multiple times he had an injured arm. Officers had to remove a brace from the suspects left wrist in order to place him in handcuffs.

Once handcuffed, Detective Mohammad, Detective Derrick, and Officer Whitcomb escorted the suspect to the patrol vehicle on J Street. The suspect had refused to walk when asked to do so and dropped to the ground multiple times while he was being taken to a patrol vehicle. During the walk to the patrol vehicle, the suspect told officers he was going to be having surgery on the injured arm. Once placed in the patrol vehicle, the suspect was identified as Tyrece Shelton. The Sacramento Fire Department responded to the scene to evaluate Shelton's complaint of pain to his left wrist. Officers transported Shelton to Sutter Sacramento for medical treatment.

Sutter Sacramento Doctor J. [REDACTED] advised Detective Mohammad that the radiologist who viewed Shelton's X-Rays believed there was a scaphoid fracture to the left wrist. Doctor [REDACTED] advised he could not see the fracture in the X-Ray however there was swelling around the injury. Shelton was medically cleared and transported to Sacramento County Jail where he was booked for 242 PC and 148 PC.

Officer Teurn sustained a minor injury to his right knee during the incident.

On 01/05/25, at approximately 1745 hours, I, Officer Anderson #582 contacted [REDACTED] outside the Golden One Arena (500 David J Stern Walk) and obtained her statement. My body camera was activated during the conversation. [REDACTED] stated the following in summary:

Yes, I am okay.

My guards called me over because an individual was coming through the mags woozy or tipsy. I told the individual to step back behind the mags, so that I could talk to him out there. He wouldn't budge or move.

He put his hands on me and pushed me. I told him not to touch me. He then stepped over to the side and tried to force his way past me. My other officer grabbed him, and he (suspect) began tussling from there. I was trying to help him control the individual and he kind of threw me to the ground.

I was standing behind the suspect during the tussle. As the guy was flailing around, I went to the ground. I wouldn't say that that he threw me to the ground, but I did get thrown to the ground.

When he pushed me, it was with one hand. I was just trying to talk with him off to the side.

The reason we stopped the individual was because he was either intoxicated or too high. He was slurring and couldn't even walk straight through the mag.

I am okay. I don't want to press charges against the suspect.

I don't have any injuries. Yes, the person I was talking about was the same individual that officers had on the ground.

I was there to attend the Rod Wave concert. Yes, I purchased a ticket to attend the concert. I was there with my brother. He was not there yet, he was coming in later. So once I entered through the security check-point, they said you have to wait, but I already had all my stuff on the belt scanner. I responded by saying okay well let me just grab my stuff and they would not allow me to. That's when I tried to go and grab my stuff and multiple security guards tried to grab me and I said "Get the fuck off of me".

No, I did not punch the female security guard. I pushed her. That was when another security guard came and I pushed him too. I didn't punch anybody.

I, Detective M. Mohammad #780, have been employed by the Sacramento Police Department as a Police Officer since 2016. I am currently assigned as a Detective with the Homicide Unit, in the Office of Investigation. My primary duties are to investigate homicides, suspicious deaths, Officer Involved shootings, and in custody deaths within the City of Sacramento.

On 01/05/2025, I was dressed in full Sacramento Police Department uniform and operating a fully marked Sacramento Police Department patrol vehicle. I was working uniformed patrol in the Southern portion of Sacramento as 1E41.

At approximately 1700 hours, Sacramento Police Sergeant Ratcliffe #3110 requested my assistance. Per Sergeant Ratcliffe, there was a staffing shortage in the downtown Sacramento area, specifically the Golden-1 Center. I was notified that the Golden-1 Center had a scheduled concert with an artist by the name of Rod Wave. Sergeant Ratcliffe wanted additional Police presence during the entry to ensure public safety.

It shall be noted that the additional Police presence was necessary for this event due to an incident at a prior event for the same artist, at the same venue that I responded to on 10/25/24.

PRIOR INCIDENT SUMMARY 24-298713:

On 10/24/2025, at approximately 1800 hours Rod Wave was scheduled to perform at the Golden-1 Center, located at 500 David J Stern Walk. However, due to unforeseen circumstances, there was a delay on the performance which prevented many of the guests from entering the venue.

At approximately 2057 hours the guests were all still in line outside of the Golden-1 Center. Det. Maclean #1010 and I, were at K and 4th Street, which was just West of the Golden-1 Center. We observed a large group of individuals running towards our patrol vehicle and advising that shots were being fired. Based on that information, officers responded to towards the Golden-1 Center for an active shooter. However, it was quickly determined that an individual ignited fireworks in the middle of the crowd, causing the crowd to believe they were gunshots. During this time, SPD was notified that at least one individual discarded a firearm which was located by staff. Furthermore, the crowd attempted to force their way into the venue and had to be stopped for safety purposes.

Based on the circumstances, the show was canceled and the area was cleared.

END OF SUMMARY FOR PRIOR INCIDENT

Based on the prior incident, Sergeant Ratcliffe wished to provide additional Police presence in the area, specifically outside of the arena to prevent any similar incidents and increase the safety of the public.

At approximately 1730 hours, I arrived at the Golden-1 Center where I met with Officer Teurn #403. We both parked our patrol vehicles and stood outside of the Golden-1 Center near the security checkpoint. The security checkpoint consisted of exterior security staff, and walk through metal detectors and metal detector wands. The guests were being granted entry once the security staff ensured that the guests were not armed with any weapons.

At approximately 1742 hours, Officer Teurn and I, were standing near the metal detectors when an unknown individual advised us that there was a fight. I looked to my right and observed a male black adult, wearing a green colored jacket actively assaulting security. I observed the male swinging with both arms at the security officer with what appeared to be closed fists. The male black adult, appeared to be approx. 6'00 FT tall, and appeared to be between 225-250 pounds. As I approached the male, I identified myself as Police by stating "Police, Police, Police". The male at this point placed his arms up, I grabbed his left arm, and Officer Teurn grabbed a hold of his right arm. I removed my handcuffs to place the male in handcuffs. I was able to place the male's right arm in handcuffs, however, he immediately pulled away both of his arms.

At this point of the contact, I personally observed the male physically assaulting security, and I noticed that he was stopped just outside of the metal detectors after entry. This was concerning based on the fact that it was unknown at this time how or why the physical altercation was taking place with security. It was unknown if the male was stopped due to the security staff noticing any sort of weapons on the person or if the individual was attempting to enter the venue without being properly scanned for weapons. Based on that information, the male actively resisting arrest, and not knowing if he was armed with any weapons at this time, I believed the most reasonable and safest action would be to guide the male to the ground where he did not have a stable platform to continue his violent behavior and safely place him in custody. I placed my right leg in front of the male and used his momentum and guided his body to the ground. I pulled his left arm out from underneath him. The male had a black colored Velcro wrist brace. In order to place the handcuffs around his wrist, we removed the brace and placed him in handcuffs without any further incident. At this point numerous SPD Officers responded to assist.

Once we placed the male in handcuffs, I stood him up, however, he continued to drop his body weight down to the ground and refused to walk. The male was asked and ordered to walk, however, continued to refuse. He continued to drop his body weight to the ground, and refused to walk. Officer Teurn at this point notified me that he sustained an injury as a result of the incident. Refer to Officer Teurn's supplement.

At this point I was standing on the right side of the males body and had control of his right arm. Officer Whitcomb #647 was controlling the left side of the male. Based on the fact that the male refused to walk on his own, I wrapped my hand around the males right bicep area and right wrist. Officer Whitcomb

wrapped his hand around the males left bicep and we lifted him up. Det. Derrick and Det. Boyd #230 assisted by lifting the lower portion of the males body off the ground. The four of us had to carry the male out of the area based on the fact that he refused to walk on his own. Once we were near 5th and J Street, the male complied and agreed to walk on his own. We place him down and allowed him to walk towards my patrol vehicle. Det. Derrick and I, stood the male against my patrol vehicle where we began searching his person incident to arrest. A search of his person yielded misc. personal items. During the search, the male continued shouting, I ordered the male to look straight at the patrol vehicle and not towards Det. Derrick who was actively searching his left side. This was to prevent Tyrece from attempting to strike Det. Derrick with his head.

We ultimately placed the male in the backseat of my SPD patrol vehicle where he then began striking his own head against the rear and kicking in the backseat. He was given an admonishment that if he continued his behavior, he would be placed in max restraints to prevent him from causing injury to himself. The male ultimately discontinued his behavior while in the backseat.

I removed the male CA driver's license from his wallet and positively identified the male as the following:

- **TYRECE SOLOMONSTP SHELTON, X-██████████, 07/02/2001, 23, M, B, 5'11, 227 lbs, BLK, BLK, ██████████**

A records check of Tyrece Shelton resulted with Tyrece having a single arrest in Sacramento County for resisting arrest (148(A)-PC). The arrest was made on 10/28/2024, and he had a scheduled court appearance on 01/16/2025. The arresting agency was noted to be Galt PD (Galt PD RP 24-2291).

In addition to the above, it shall be noted that Tyrece appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. I smelled an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person, and he was slurring his speech at times.

Officer Omogun #844 responded and assisted. I requested Officer Omogun to standby with Tyrece while I responded back to the original scene. I returned to the original scene and learned that Det. Anderson #582, Officer Pitts #990 and Officer Cunningham #971 contacted and obtained statements from the involved parties. I was notified that the security staff did not wish to press charges for the assault. Furthermore, I learned that prior to the incident, security stopped Tyrece due to appearing overly intoxicated. Refer to supplements for further detail.

Officer Powell #532 contacted Golden-1 Center and requested their exterior surveillance footage of the incident.



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Officer Omogun advised me that he attempted to obtain Tyrece's Mirandized statement, however, he refused to provide a statement and stated he was in pain. Officer Omogun advised me that he requested the Sacramento Fire Department after Tyrece requesting SFD. The Sacramento Fire Department ENGINE-2 arrived on scene, and due to Tyrece notifying SFD that he felt pain to his wrist and wished to be transported, the Fire Department advised they can transport Tyrece or I can. Based on the fact that Tyrece was in Police custody, I transported him to Sutter Medical, located at 2801 L Street.

We arrived to Sutter Medical where he was treated by Medical Doctor [REDACTED].

At approximately 1930 hours, Tyrece had since calmed down and was becoming more cooperative. I re-read Tyrece his Miranda rights verbatim via my issued SPD Miranda card and obtained his Mirandized statement. See statement for further.

At approximately 2243 hours, Doctor [REDACTED] provided with an update. Per Doctor [REDACTED], the radiologist believed the scaphoid fracture to Tyrece's left wrist was new (Same wrist that Tyrece had the brace on). Doctor [REDACTED] stated he could not really see it, however, the radiologist believed it was new. Doctor [REDACTED] stated that there was swelling around the injury, which caused them to believe it was new. Doctor [REDACTED] stated that they will splint his wrist and consider him fit for incarceration.

I contacted Sergeant Burnham and notified him of the injury update I received from medical staff. Sergeant Burnham requested that I obtain consent from Tyrece to have his medical records for this incident released to the Sacramento Police Department.

At approximately 2306 hours, I contacted Tyrece and obtained consent from him to receive his medical records and attach it to this report. Tyrece granted me with consent. Sutter Staff brought over a Authorization For Use And Disclosure Of Health Information form that Tyrece signed. Sutter Medical staff provided me with a copy of the authorization form and the medical records. I later hand wrote the SPD case number 25-4015 on the documents and placed it in the records tray at the SPD JERPF station.

At approximately 2340 hours, I transported Tyrece to Sacramento County jail where we met with SPD Forensic Investigator Block #6378 and Bueno #6376 (F/U CALL 25-42550). The CSI unit took overall photographs of Tyrece.

Tyrece was ultimately booked at the Sacramento County jail for 242 PC and 148 PC.

On 1/5/2025 at approximately 1700 hours, I (Det. Derrick #342) was working security as ARNA62 at a Rod Wave concert. The concert was being held at the Golden 1 Center. I was in full SPD uniform. At approximately 1744 hours, I was inside the main entrance to the arena when I heard on the radio the report of a fight outside of the arena. As I walked outside the arena, I activated my BWC. The subject involved in the fight was already taken into custody by other SPD Officers and was being escorted away from the arena.

At approximately 1746 hours, I overheard a Golden 1 Center Security Guard inform another SPD Officer that SPD Officers were struggling with the same subject who was taken into custody for fighting. I walked over to the SPD Officers who were trying to gain control of the handcuffed subject. I observed the subject was actively struggling with officers as he laid on his stomach. Detectives M. Anderson and M. Mohammad were trying to pick up the subject from the ground as he continued to yell and actively resist by moving his body back and forth, kicking his legs, and dropping his body weight towards the ground. Due to the subject actively kicking his legs, I held onto the subject's left pant leg and his left belt loop area to further prevent him from resisting by kicking his legs. Detectives Anderson, Mohammad, Boyd, and I carried the subjects towards a marked patrol vehicle parked in front of the Sawyer Hotel. As we carried the subject, he would repeatedly yell and kick his legs. The subject managed to kick his legs free from our grasp as he yelled "fucking let me go" and briefly struggled with officers.

I grabbed hold of the subject's left arm and placed him in a rear wrist lock to prevent him from further resisting. I held onto the subject's left fingers with my right hand while holding onto the subject's left side of his jacket with my left hand. I verbally told the subject to "just walk." I overheard the subject stating to stop hurting his hands. Again I told the subject to continue walking. Due to subject stating his hands hurt, I released my grip from his left fingers and held onto the back of his jacket while continuing to prevent him from breaking away from my grasp. We continued to walk the subject towards the Sawyer Hotel.

When arrived to the patrol vehicle, I searched the subjects left side for contraband with negative results. The subject continued to yell at officers and fail to comply to officers simple demands.

During my contact with the subject, I could smell an odor of alcohol coming from his person and clothing. He also had slurred speech and continually failed to comply with officers simple demands. I later learned that the same subject was arrested in October of 2024 for 148 PC.

On Sunday, 1/5/25, at approximately 1743 hours, Officer Teurn #403 was working off duty uniformed supplemental employment within the city and county of Sacramento. I was assigned as SCT432. My duties included but was not limited to checking on specified businesses within Old Sacramento and multiple other businesses along J St/ K St/ L St to 15th St. At this time, I was dressed in a full police uniform and driving a marked patrol car.

3SM3 (Sgt. Ratcliffe # 3110) contacted me to re assign myself and Officer Mohammad #780 (1E41) to the DOCO area. There was a "Rod Wave" concert scheduled for this evening. Our duty was to monitor the exterior of the arena during guest check in.

While standing near the barricade near the front entrance, I heard a security yelling to us that a guest was fighting them. I observed S-1 (later identified as Tyrece Shelton DOB: 7-2-01 CDL# [REDACTED]) swinging his right fist at two unidentified security guards who were attempting to grab and control S-1.

We ran up to S-1 yelling that we were the "Police! Stop!" Officer Mohammad and I grabbed onto S-1's arms to stop him from attacking the guards. We ordered him to put his hands behind his back in order secure him in handcuffs. Based on our observation of S-1's violent actions, I felt that this was necessary in order to stabilize the scene and that it was in the best interest of officer's and the public's safety. S-1 refused to comply. I was trying to control his right arm. S-1 tensed up, twisted his arm, and pulling it away in an attempt to defeat my attempt to secure his hands behind his back.

We repeatedly ordered S-1 to stop resisting us and to put his arms/hands behind his back. S-1 refused to comply. Officer Mohammad was able to put one handcuff on S-1 right wrist while we were still standing. We continued struggling to secure control S-1's arms. During the struggle, we all fell down to the ground. I fell down causing my right knee cap to strike the concrete pavement. S-1 was laying stomach down on the pavement with Officer Mohammad on top of his back. I held onto the handcuff which was secured on S-1 right wrist. I activated a radio broadcast that that we were fighting with S-1 in front of DOCO.

Additional police units responded to assist. Officer Mohammad and Officer Simpson was able to help me control S-1's left hand so that I could successfully apply the other half of the handcuff to the left wrist.

Officer Mohammad and other officers took custody of S-1 and brought him to their patrol car. I updated Sgt. Ratcliffe on my injury. I returned to the station to complete worker's compensation document.

On 1/5/2025 at approximately 1800 hours, I (Officer Cunningham #971) was working security as ARNA57 at a Rod Wave concert. The concert was being held at the Golden 1 Center. I was in full SPD uniform. I was just inside the main entrance to the arena when I heard on the radio the report of a fight outside of the arena. Subject Tyrece Shelton was on the ground and in the process of being detained by officers. I contacted witness [REDACTED] who stated the following in summary:

The subject that was detained by officers attempted to come through the metal detectors earlier in the night. He was very intoxicated and was turned away by security staff. I saw the subject return and this time he tried to push his way through security. He was pushing through with his arms out.

On 01/05/25 at approx. 1700 hours, I (Ofc. Whitcomb #674) was working Supplemental Employment (B05) at the Golden One Center located at 500 David J Stern Walk. I was assigned as an interior security unit for the Rod Wave concert. I was wearing full police uniform and my unit identifier was ARNA 55.

At approx. 1745 hours, I was inside the arena closest to the northwest entry/exit doors monitoring the ingress of the crowd attending the concert. There, I was hailed by private arena security staff advising there was a subject just outside the northwest doors inside the Downtown Commons (DOCO) plaza fighting with private security staff.

I responded to the area to find Ofc. Mohammad #780 (1E41), Ofc. Teurn #403 (SCT432), and Ofc. Simpson #951 (ARNA61) already handling the situation. When I arrived, the suspect, later identified as S-Tyrece Shelton was prone on the ground in the process of being handcuffed. Several additional officers responded to the scene to assist.

Ofc. Simpson handed me a black wrist guard advising that it had been taken off of S-Shelton's left wrist in order to be placed in handcuffs. This wrist guard was presumably worn due to a pre-existing condition and/or injury.

Due to Ofc. Teurn #403 being injured while taking S-Shelton into custody, I assisted in escorting S-Shelton to a patrol car located in front of the Sawyer Hotel (500 J St).

During my interaction with S-Shelton, he was extremely belligerent. S-Shelton would not follow officers repeated commands to stand up and walk to the patrol car and continued to yell at officers. When S-Shelton was stood up, he would use his weight to break free of control holds and sit and/or lie back down on the ground. During this time, I additionally observed the odor of an alcoholic beverage upon his person. This observation, in conjunction with the the above described behavior led me to believe that S-Shelton was under the influence of alcohol and no longer able to exercise care for his own safety or for the safety of others.

Due to Ofc. Simpson alerting me to the possibility of a pre-existing condition and/or injury to S-Shelton's left wrist, I took great care not to further worsen that injury. I did not use the departmentally approved rear-wrist lock for this reason.

While determining S-Shelton's level of compliance to see if he would walk to the patrol car, I initially grabbed his arm proximal to his left elbow and began walking him forward. After he refused to walk and sat back down on the ground, I picked S-Shelton up from under his armpit and again began walking him to the patrol car. Eventually, additional officers arrived and we began carrying S-Shelton to the car. I grabbed a hold of his sweatshirt proximal to his left shoulder and the belt to the pants he was wearing and began carrying him to the car. During this time, S-Shelton began kicking at officers that were carrying his legs.

Eventually, S-Shelton was compliant with walking and another officer escorted him the remaining distance to the patrol car. There S-Shelton was placed inside the backseat.

I returned to my Supplemental Employment duties and took no further action on this call.

On 01/05/24 at approx. 1750 hours, I Officer Pitts #990 responded to the front of the Golden 1 Center (500 David J Stern Walkway) regarding officers fighting with one subject. Once on scene I contacted a witness ([REDACTED]) and obtained his statement. My body worn camera was activated. [REDACTED] stated the following in summary:

Today I was working at a security check point scanner. Earlier today we refused to allow the male subject that officers fought with come into the concert due to him being too intoxicated. The same subject attempted to get back in line to gain access inside of the concert. When my co-worker [REDACTED] and other security officers tried to pull the subject to the side, he ended up pushing [REDACTED] and he pushed me. He was trying to get past us.

I ended up tussling with the subject outside of the front doors. As I was trying to restrain the subject, he also pushed [REDACTED] to the ground. The officers that were working came by and tried to restrain the subject. The subject kept resisting Officers even though Officers gave the subject commands to stop resisting. The Officers had to take the subject to the ground to control him.

The subject that pushed [REDACTED] is a light skinned male that is approx. 6'00" tall. He is approx. 250 lbs and has long curly hair. He was wearing a gray shirt and tan colored pants. If I saw the subject again I would be able to identify him.
