Safe Place Program

12-17-2025

The Sacramento Police Department is partnering with local businesses and community organizations to build trust, strengthen community relationships, and reduce unreported crime.

Participating businesses will display a "Safe Place" decal at their entrance, signaling that victims of crime will be respected, protected, and given a safe space to shelter. Staff at these locations are trained to contact law enforcement and provide refuge until help arrives.

Each participating location will have a premise history on file, so dispatchers and officers know to add a comment on the call indicating "Safe Place Program" when responding to these bias-motivated incidents or hate crimes. Officers shall handle the call for service in accordance with the department's General Order (GO) 524.04 Bias-Motivated Crimes.

All hate or bias-motivated crimes including threats, violence, property damage, harassment, or intimidation are treated as serious, high-priority incidents. Once confirmed, officers will follow GO 524.04 and notify a supervisor.
