

Marysville Blvd Vision Zero Safety Project FAQ

What is the Vision Zero initiative?

Vision Zero is a traffic safety philosophy that aims to eliminate all traffic fatalities and serious injuries, recognizing that these incidents are preventable. The City of Sacramento adopted this approach to ensure the safety of all community members on our roads.



Why is Vision Zero important for Sacramento?

Sacramento has experienced a significant increase in traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries, with an average of over five such incidents occurring weekly. Vision Zero's goal is to address and reduce these incidents through a collaborative, data-driven approach.

What is the Marysville Blvd Vision Zero Safety Project?

This project focuses on enhancing road safety along Marysville Boulevard between Arcade Boulevard and North Avenue. It was identified as a priority in the City's Vision Zero Top 5 Corridors Plan due to a high number of crashes resulting in fatalities or severe injuries.

What improvements are planned for the Marysville Blvd corridor?

Improvements include a road diet, the addition of protected bike lanes, sidewalk enhancements, pavement repair, new pedestrian signals, and upgrading unsignalized intersections to controlled crossings.

What are the key issues the project aims to address?

The project targets issues such as aggressive driving, high speeds, and insufficient pedestrian crossings, which have contributed to a history of severe crashes along the corridor.

How can the community get involved?

Residents are encouraged to participate in community meetings, complete online surveys, and sign up for email updates to stay informed and provide feedback on the project.

Who is leading the design and implementation of the project?

The city has partnered with Wood Rodgers, a professional engineering firm, to manage the preliminary engineering, environmental clearance, final design, public outreach, and construction support.
