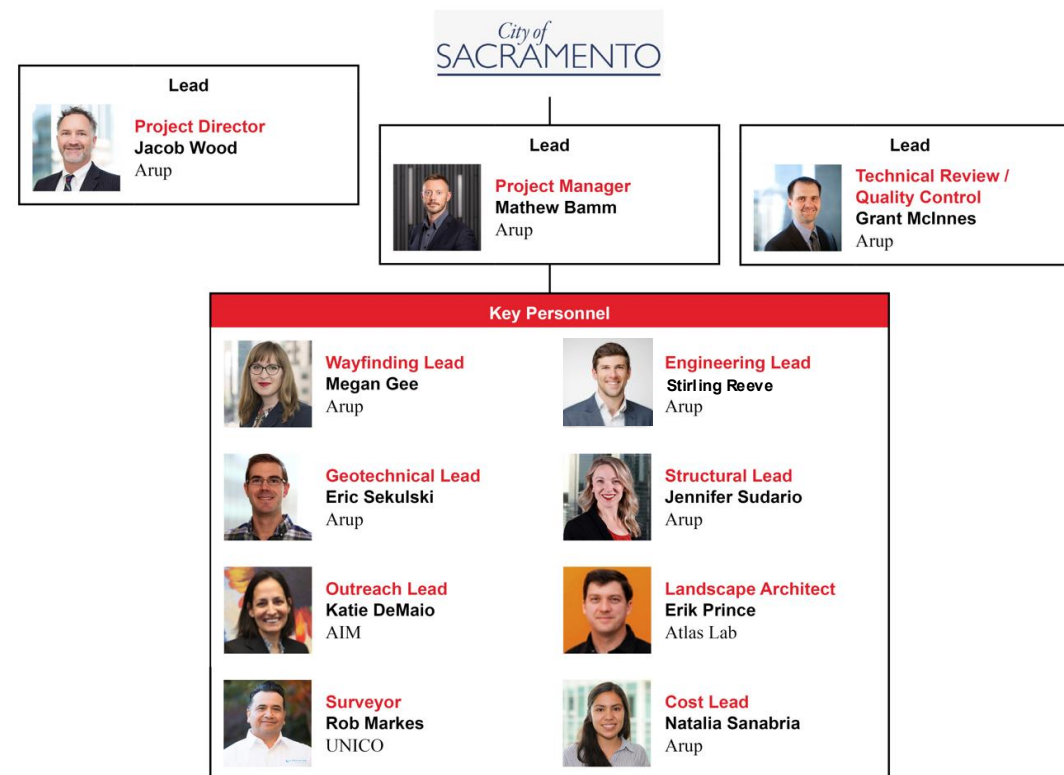

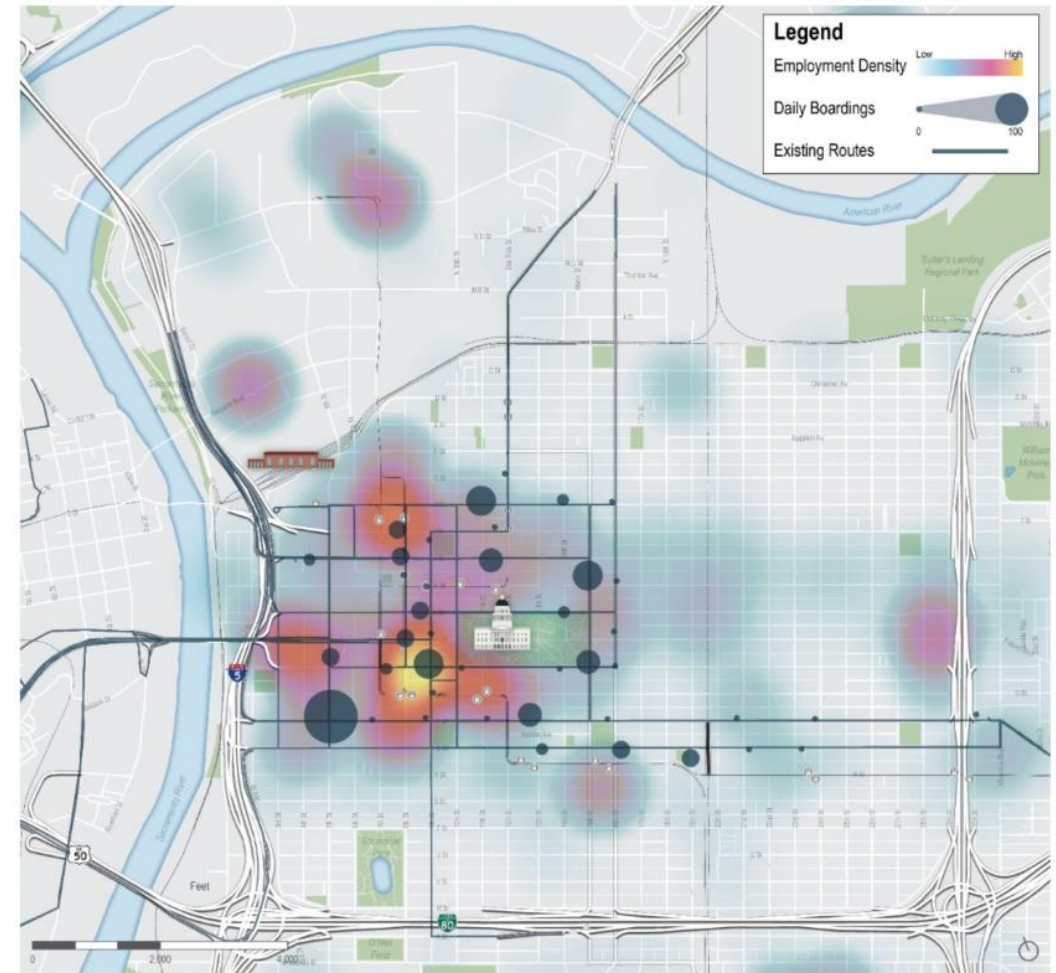
# Project Summary and Purpose

## Context

- **SACOG Downtown Transit Integration Study** completed in 2022
  - Existing bus stops in Sacramento are spread, inconsistent with minimal amenities
  - Study identified the benefit for condensing 34 bus stops to 17 bus stops

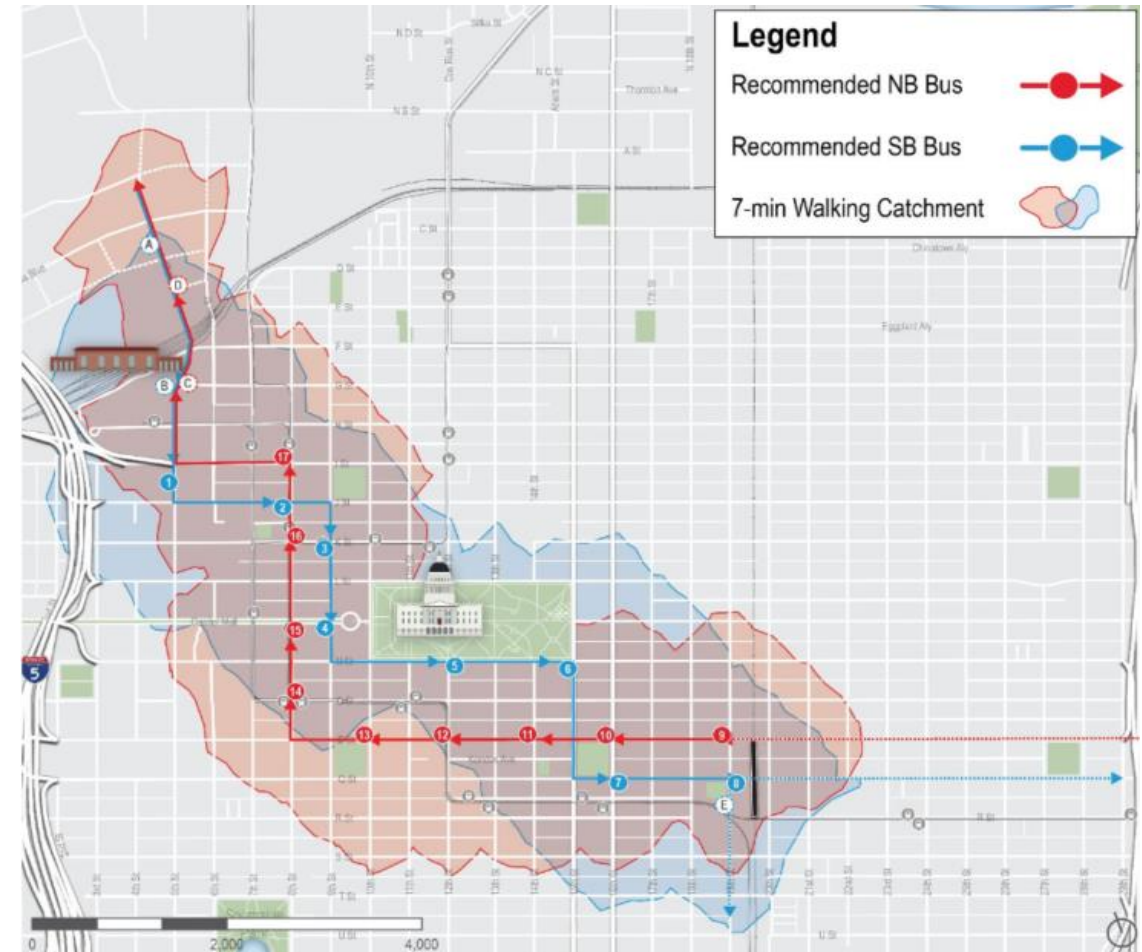
## Purpose

- Provide a more reliable and efficient experience for daily commuters
- Improve bus accessibility for all passengers, including seniors and those with disabilities
- Ensure smoother transfers between different modes of transportation



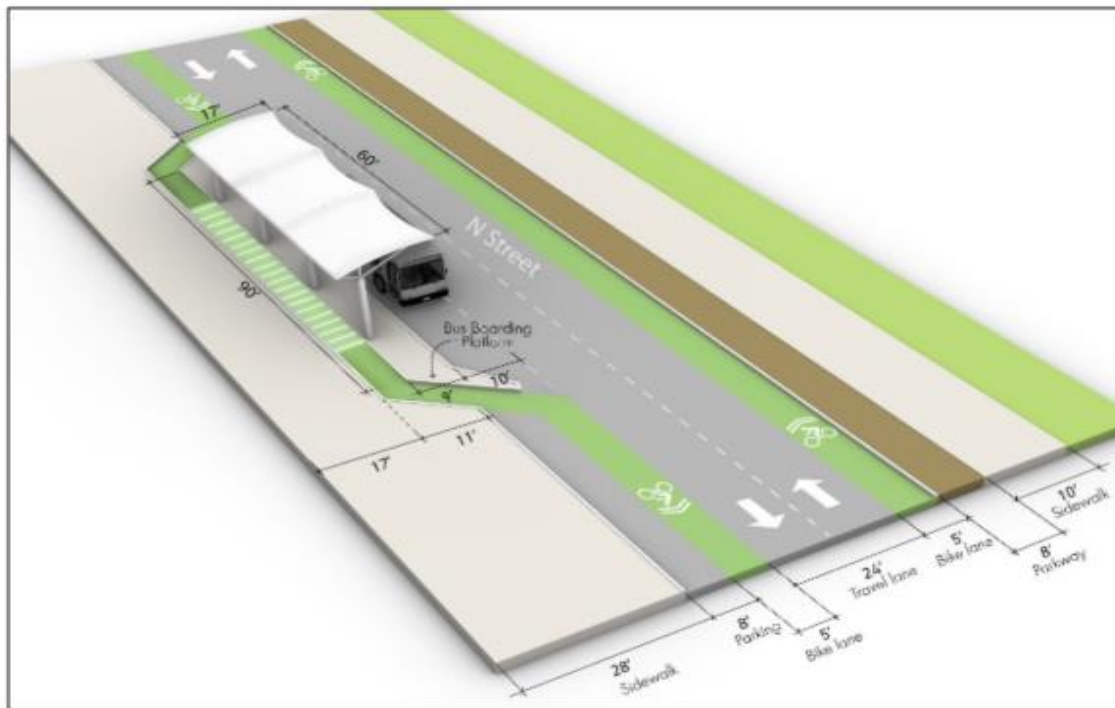
# What's being proposed?

- **Bus stop relocations** for better access and connection to trains and light rail.
- **17 consolidated bus stops** with better connectivity, safer access and amenities
- **Improved accessibility** with shelter, lighting and digital bus information displays
- **Bus priority** with stops in the traffic lane prioritizing the efficiency of bus schedules in heavy traffic



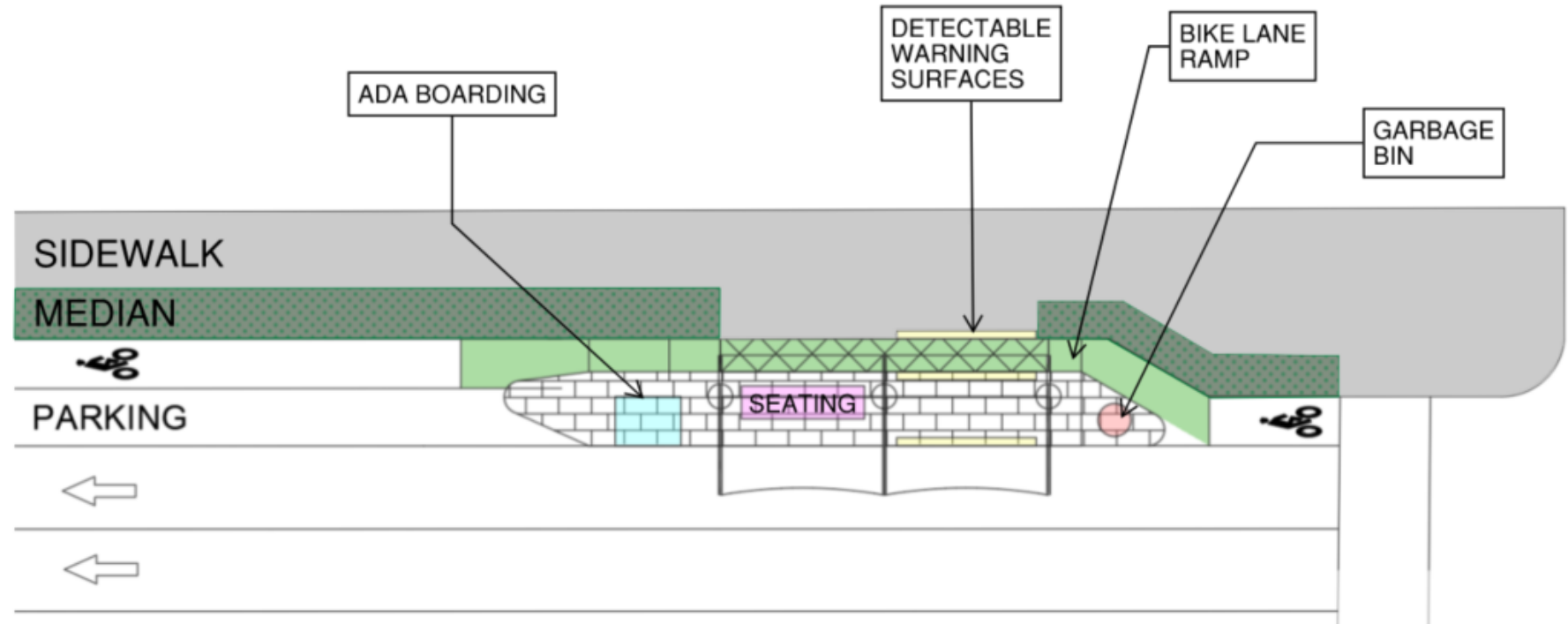

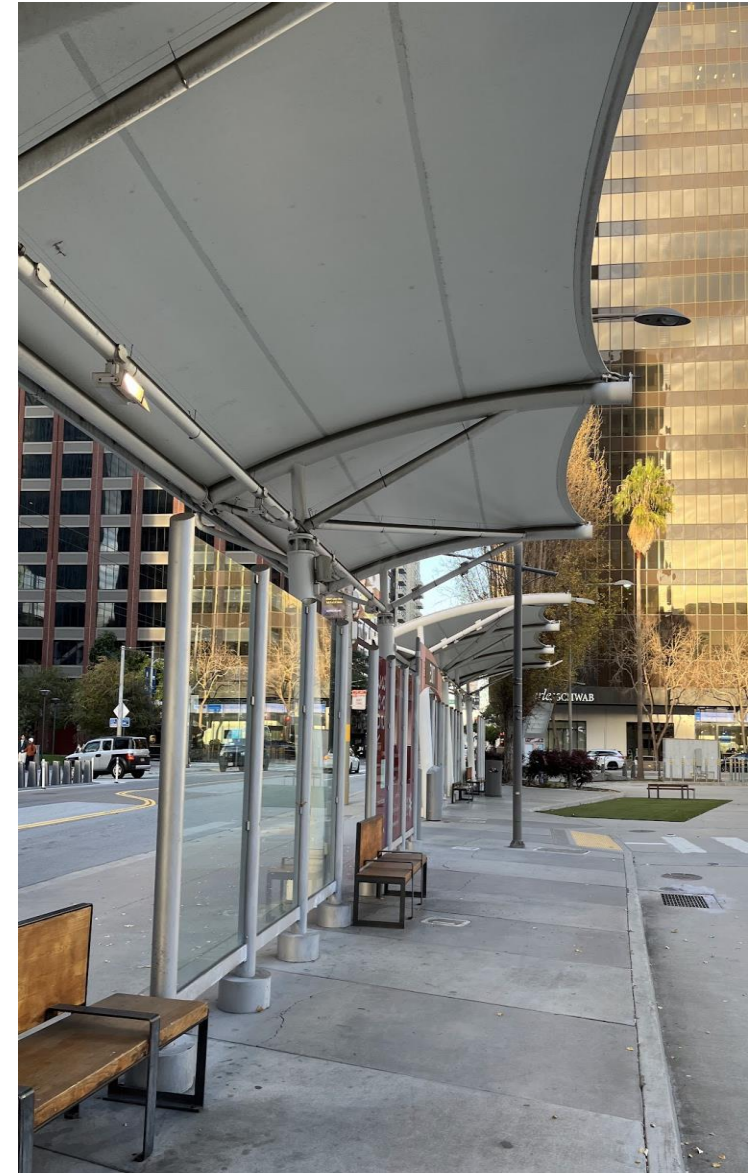
2022 SACOG Study Concept (For review)



Bus Stop side elevation

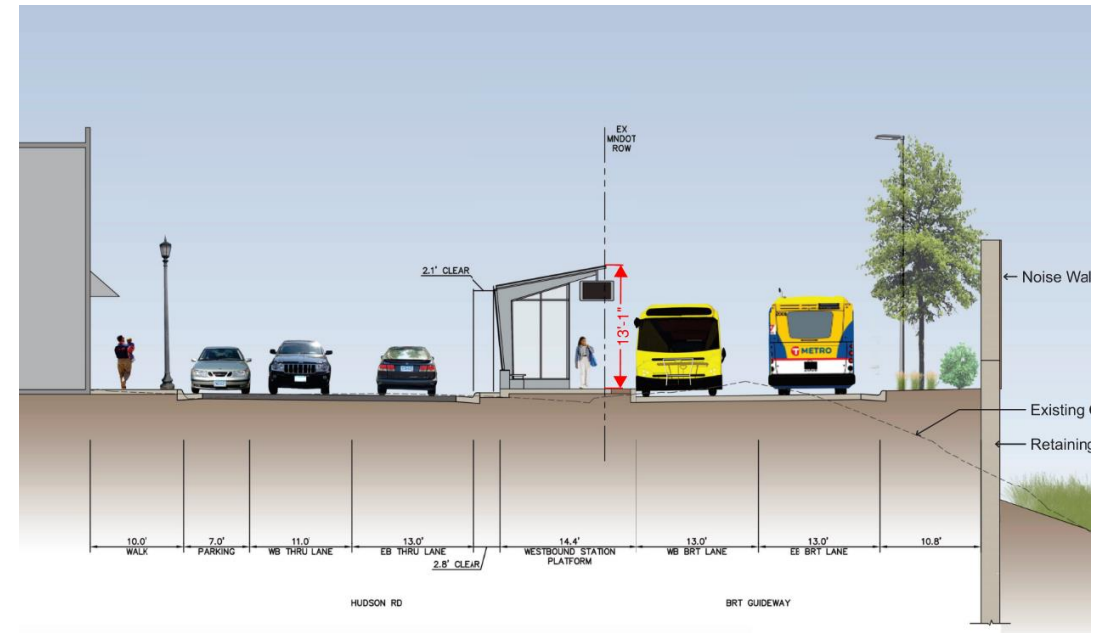
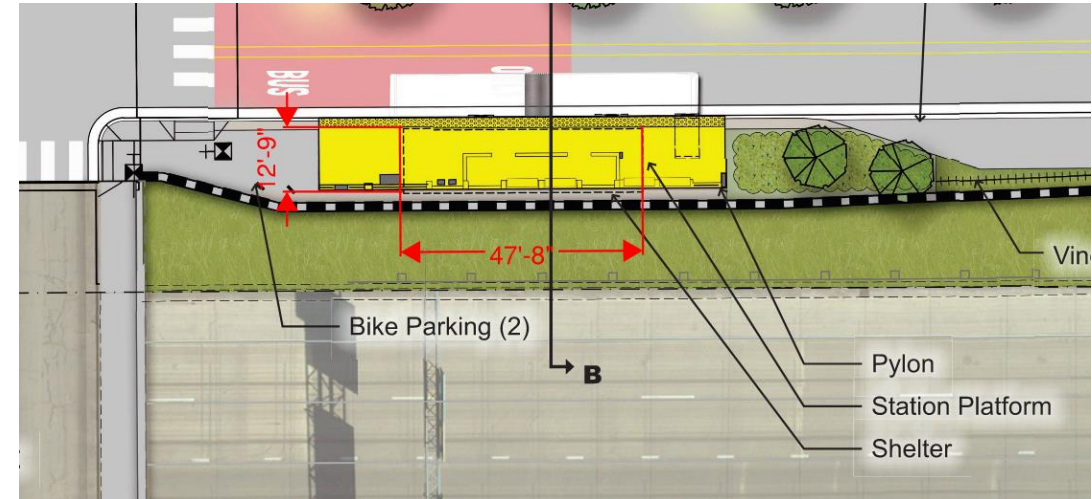

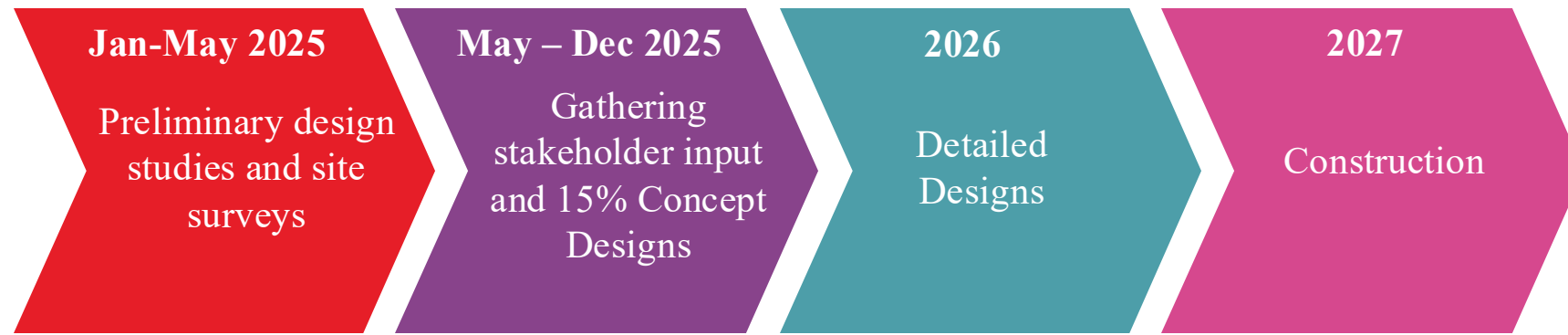
