Existing Building Electrification Strategy



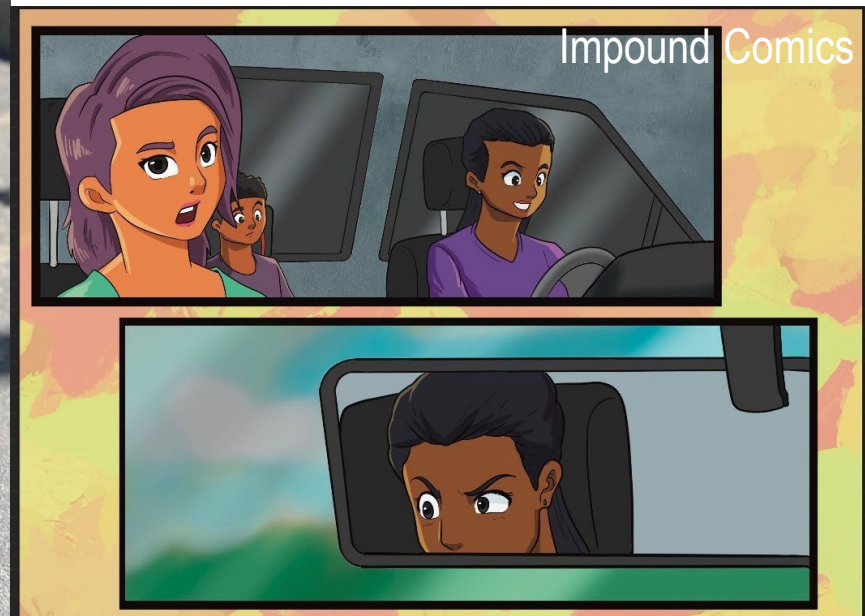
