EXPANDING ACCESS TO RELIABLE HIGH-SPEED INTERNET

The City of Sacramento has selected Fidium to install fiber optic broadband internet infrastructure in your neighborhood. Through the Last Mile Broadband Internet Access project, the City is expanding access to reliable, high-speed internet in eligible underserved neighborhoods.

INSTALLATION PROCESS

To expand fiber internet access, the City is installing underground cables (a.k.a. burying lines) along the front edges of properties to connect neighborhoods to the wider network. This stage does not require opting in, as the installation is a City project currently underway.

The underground cables will not be visible. However, the installation will involve boring some utility access holes on the ground outside, and placing small utility boxes within existing utility easements (a small area on all residential properties where utility providers operate essential services) between some homes.

Residents who opt in will see a cable installed underground on their property, from the new utility box to a small box installed on the outside wall of the home. This prepares the home for future fiber internet service. Fidium currently offers plans starting at \$30 per month (as of summer 2026).

HOW RESIDENTS CAN OPT-IN

The City will install fiber infrastructure and, if you opt in, connect it to the outside of your home at **no cost**.

Opting in does not commit you to use fiber internet nor subscribe you to Fidium services, but it prepares your home for future fiber service while potentially increasing its value.

INSTALLING NOW VS. LATER

Home installation is available at no cost during the City of Sacramento's fiber internet installation in your neighborhood.

Want more time to decide? You may choose to connect later once your neighborhood is set up for fiber, but at that time, there may be an extensive waitlist for Fidium or a third-party contractor to connect your home, and potentially a cost to you.

Opting in now helps avoid future installation delays or costs if you decide to activate fiber service later.

Fiber is being installed in eligible neighborhoods, providing residents the ability to subscribe to reliable high-speed internet service.



PERKS OF FIBER INTERNET

Reliable fiber internet helps residents apply for jobs, take online classes, work at remote jobs, access telehealth appointments, find information, stay connected with loved ones, use smart devices, play online games, engage with their communities, and stream entertainment — at faster speeds and often lower costs than traditional internet service.
