- ¹ The interest and investment revenue reported for FY25 includes further recovery of unrealized losses of fixed income securities in the City's Pool A portfolio reported in FY22. The figure also includes FY25 Pool A interest apportionment for the Water Fund, which is invested in the City's Pool A portfolio.
- ² Miscellaneous Revenue of \$11,710 includes Rents and Concessions of \$54 plus Miscellaneous of \$7,414 plus Revenue from other agencies of \$4,265 and minus amortization of bond prepaid insurance of (\$23).
- ³ The Water Fund receives Water Impact Fees that are deposited into a separate account; however, the Water Impact Fees are restricted and can only be used to cover eligible costs specified in the Sacramento City Code.
- ⁴ The voter approved general fund tax is equal to 11% of the collected utility rate revenue. See "General Fund Tax on Water System Revenues." These figures are net of uncollected Water System charges or bad debt.
- ⁵ The variance in operating costs from Fiscal Year 2023/24 to Fiscal Year 2024/25 - specifically the Employee Services line item due to 7 position filled in FY25 that were vacant in FY24.
- ⁶ The SRF Loan Reserve is maintained at \$8.2 million, which reflects the maximum annual debt service of the current amortization schedule of the final loan amount of about \$139.2 million. The SRF Loan Reserve Requirement will begin to decrease beginning in FY31.
- ⁷ Existing payments by the Water Fund to the City's General Fund to cover existing General Fund debt for water-related facilities associated with the City's Master Lease Revenue Bond Program. The Water Fund revenue is utilized, but not directly pledged, to make debt service payments.
