



Plan Legend

- ① Central plaza with compass rose in paving and raised planter with specimen tree
- ② Group picnic area (two 26'x30' shelters, 10 tables, group grill and serving tables)
- ③ Primary pathway with decorative aeronautical timeline history panels and runway-themed lighting
- ④ Play area (2-5 year old) with non-traditional play equipment, fiber paving and shade canopy
- ⑤ Play area (5-12 year old) with non-traditional play equipment, fiber paving and shade canopy
- ⑥ "Rainbow Road" resilient paving access path separating 2-5 and 5-12 year old play areas
- ⑦ Enhanced tree plantings with bark mulch only
- ⑧ Raised planting area with specimen tree
- ⑨ Multi-game court (36' x 69') with 3' tall fencing or Futsal court
- ⑩ Existing 6' sound wall by Developer
- ⑪ Park sign
- ⑫ Game tables (Ping-Pong and Cornhole)
- ⑬ Multi-use turf area/meadow area
- ⑭ Secondary picnic areas (two tables and trash receptacles)
- ⑮ Landscape and tree plantings (low water-use, drought tolerant, canopy shade, native oaks, evergreens and accent trees)



Design Intent:

The design intent of Airfield Park is to capture the historical significance of the project site, which previously served as Natomas Park Airfield. Design elements such as the navigational compass rose paving, accent runway lighting and timeline panels along the primary path will be incorporated to reinforce this history. Playground components will take on an aeronautical theme to further the concept.
