

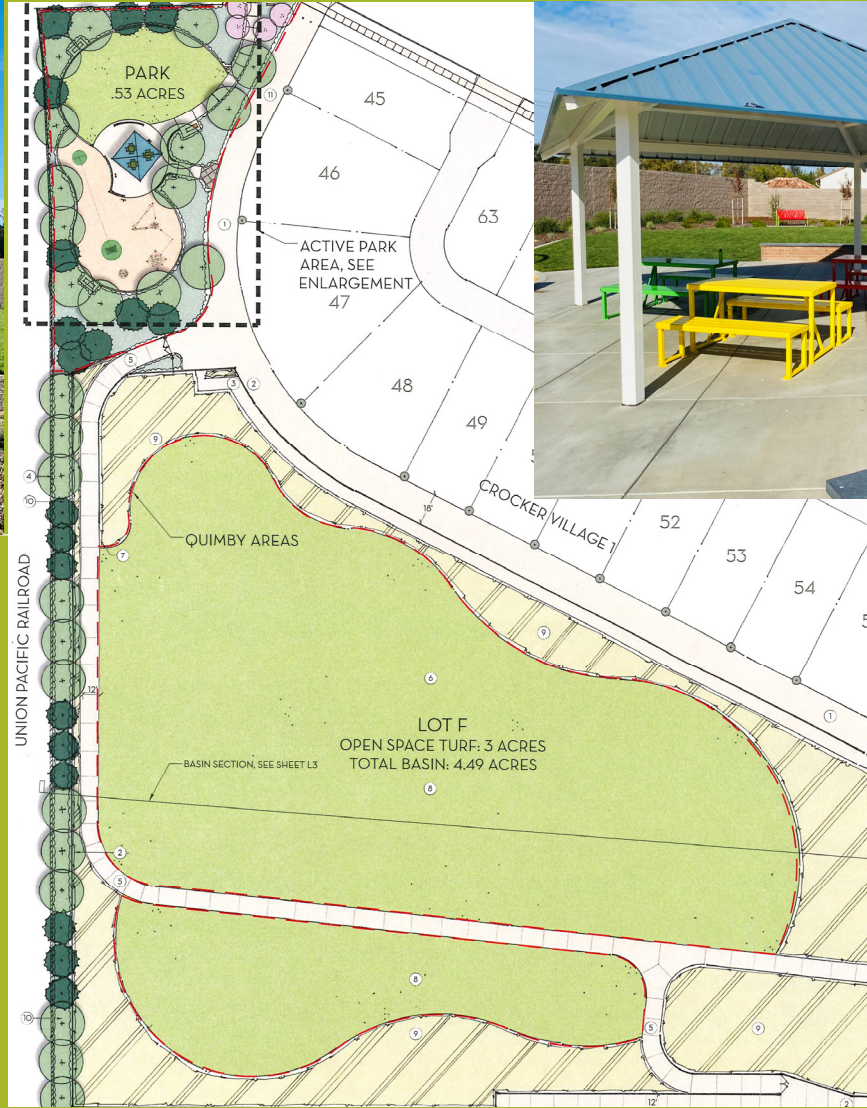
Ray Eames Park (October 2024)

The 6.5-acre park at Crocker Village is a joint-use detention basin and neighborhood park, built by the Developer as a turnkey project. The park includes an adventure playground, a small group picnic area with a shade structure, three tables with a BBQ grill, a seat wall, concrete walkways, large canopy shade trees, site furnishings, a drinking fountain, and a park sign. The detention basin covers a 3-acre open space turf area for field play. The larger detention basin has walkways, benches, and open turf for playing fields.
