


Survey Results: Dog Ownership














Survey Results: Park Use Frequency 2






Survey Results: Park Use Frequency 3









If the City were to install a dog park to city development and safety standards at Sierra 2, would you use the other amenities more often?








Sierra 2 is not large enough to accommodate both a dog park and a sports field. Which would you prefer at Sierra 2?


