Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: What is Break Camp?

A: Our seasonal break camps provide a safe, active, and fun environment for children during holidays. Rooted in recreation and guided by play, explore a balance of structured and free-choice activities, including sports, games, arts, and indoor and outdoor adventures.

Daily registration allows families flexibility, making it easy to fit camp into their schedules.

A healthy snack is provided each day, ensuring campers stay energized and ready for fun. Beyond the activities, our camps focus on building community — creating a sense of belonging where every child feels included, valued, and connected.

Q: Where is camp held?

A: Break camps are located at community centers across the City of Sacramento.

Q: Who can participate?

A: Youth ages 6-12 are eligible to register for Break Camps.

Q: What activities are included?

A: Break Campers enjoy a variety of activities, including: Outdoor games and sports, Arts and crafts, Team-building exercises, STEAM and educational activities, and themed activities.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: Break Camps are a fee-based program, with daily registration at \$10 per day. **Scholarships** are available for qualifying families, and we recommend applying early.

Q: How do I apply for a scholarship for my child?

A: To apply, visit our <u>Youth Program Scholarship Fund website</u>. You may apply online or inperson through your local community center. If you don't qualify, financial hardship scholarship may be available.

Q: How long is a session?

A: Break Camp is offered four times a year, following the school district calendar.
